In compiling the present volume, it has been found necessary to recast the whole account, and an attempt has been made to arrange it in a more concise form. I am much indebted for their assistance to Mr. R. W. Gillan, I.C.S., the Settlement Officer, who has kindly contributed an account of his assessment; Mr. R. Oakden, I.C.S.; and Mr. A. T. Scott, I.C.S. The early history of the district has been written by Mr. R. Burn, I.C.S., and the rest has been compiled from the old Gazetteer and official records.

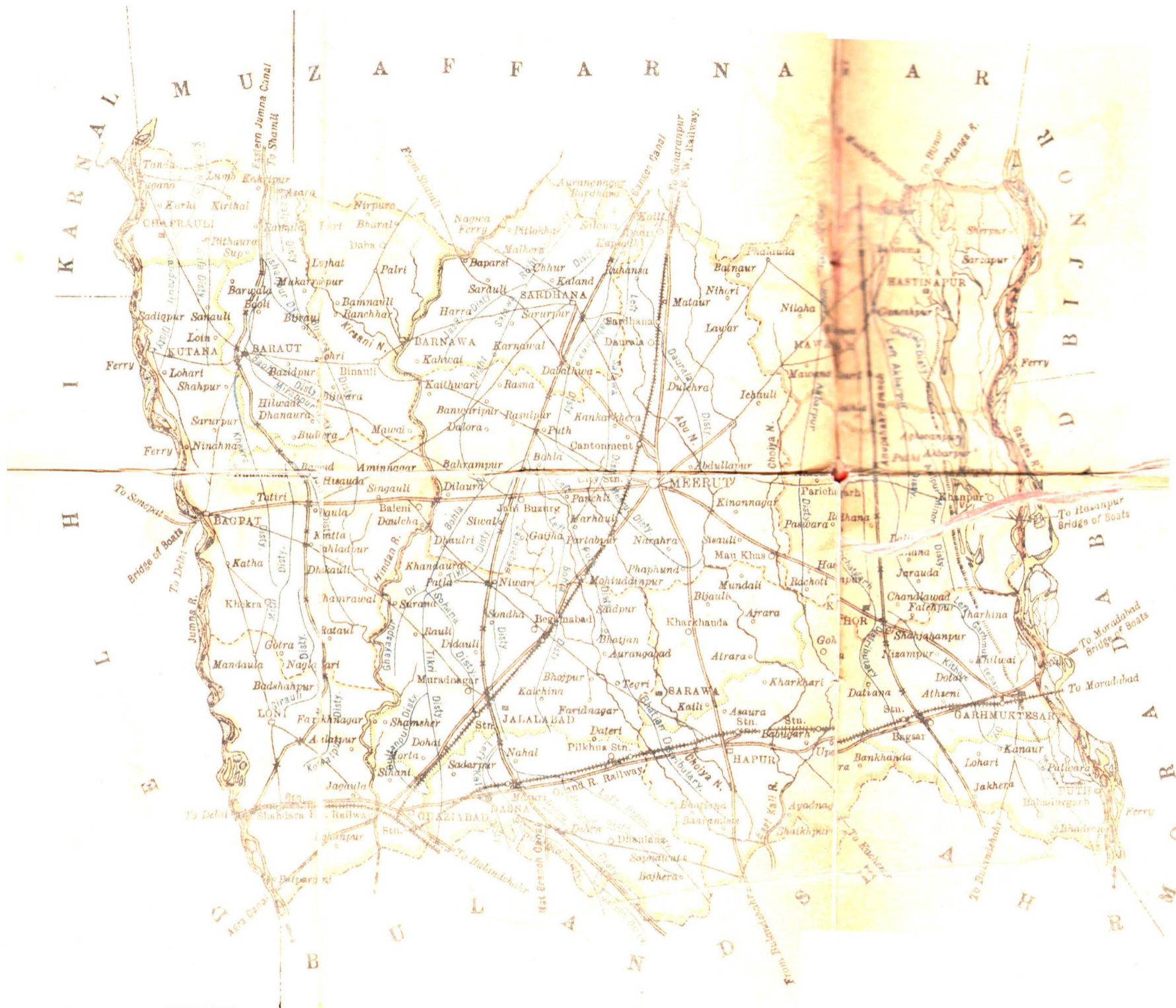
