Page 261, para. 189.—The question of the rate of increase had been to some extent cleared beforehand for a revision settlement had just been made in various taluqs of Buldana district which closely corresponded with those now forming Akola district; a considerable discussion had taken place with regard to Maikapur taluq. Major R. V. Garrett conducted revision settlement operations in Akola and Akot taluqs and Mr. F. W. Francis conducted them in the other four taluqs. The new rates came into force in the year 1896-97 in Balapur taluq, the next year in Akola, the next in Akot and the next (1900-01) in Murtizapur; then were applied in Basim and Mangrul in the spring of 1904. The new maximum dry crop rate, the rate on land of standard quality, varied in Basim and Mangrul from Re. 1-2-0 to Re. 1-12-0; in Balapur, Akola, and Murtizapur from Re. 1-14-0 to Rs. 2-10-0; and in Akot from Re. 1-14-0

to Rs. 2-12-0. The rates for land irrigated by means of wells are determined by different principles according to whether the well was dug before or after the first settlement. In the former case, the land is assessed at the maximum dry crop rate fixed for the village; in the latter, at the rate which would have been fixed if there had been no well. The land revenue in the present year, 1911-12, amounts to khalsa villages, Rs. 25,01,313; Jagir villages, Rs. 17,052; the Kamargaon Estate, Rs. 11,104; Izara villages, Rs. 6,247; and a Palamput village, Rs. 1,645; total Rs. 25,37,401. The occupied area, exclusive of *potkharab*, unculturable land in the last year reported 1910-11 was 2,193,272 acres; on combining this with the total of the land revenue it, appears that the average assessment per acre is in fact Re. 1-2½.

Page 269, para. 198 (2).—The words "One Small Cause Court Judge" should be inserted after the words "two District organization. Subordinate Judges" in the third line of sub-para. 198.

Page 272, para. 202.—Criminal justice in the district is largely in the hands of the three Sub-divisional Officers, sitting as Sub-divisional Magistrates, the six Tahsildars, sitting as Magistrates of the 2nd and 3rd Class, and a certain number of Naib-Tahsildars who are invested with third class magisterial powers. The Extra-Assistant Commissioners who do not hold charge of sub-divisions also dispose of a certain amount of criminal work, and there are five Benches of Honorary Magistrates at Akola, Akot, Telhara, Karanja and Risod. The District Magistrate supervises the whole and at times takes original cases himself. The total number of criminal cases disposed of in the district during the year 1911 was 2,846, of which 551 were cognizable. During the five years ending 1911 the average number of persons convicted of offences affecting human life was 1, of robbery and dacoity 2, of grievous hurt 4, of house-breaking 1, and of theft 10. Crime is usually most common in the neighbourhood of the railway line, and criminals from other provinces are fond of exploiting the district.

Pages 273-274; para. 204.—The office of District Registrar is held by an Extra-Assistant Commissioner. The district Registration. contains 16 Sub-Registrars' offices, all of which

are held by salaried Sub-Registrars according to the new reorganization scheme which came in force from 1st November 1910. Before the scheme was introduced only the Rural Sub-Registrars were paid on commission but now the Rural Sub-Registrars' posts are abolished and every Sub-Registrar, in addition to his salary, is paid commission at the rate of annas 3 or 5 per registration according to the status of the respective office where he works. The working of the department during the last three years is given below:—

Page 274, para. 205.—The receipts under the chief heads of revenue are given firstly for the different periods prior to the reduction in the number of Berar districts which took place in September 1905, in order to illustrate general development; and secondly for the district as it is now constituted so as to show present conditions. Some similar tax called *Pandhari* appears to have been previously levied, and from 1862 to 1904 the town fund tax was collected.

GENERAL ADMINISTRATION—EXCISE.

Pages 275 and 276, para. 206.—There has been no change in the system of country liquor. The Madras system has been in vogue from 1905-06. The rates of duty on liquor have been raised and these are as under— :

Rs. 5-15-0 per proof gallon in Akola town.

Rs. 5 per proof gallon in the rest of Akola taluq and the taluqs of Akot, Balapur and Murtizapur.

Rs. 3-2-0 per proof gallon in Mangrul and Basim taluqs.

The number of shops has been reduced from 193 in 1907-08 to 158 in 1912-13 (in the current year).

Formerly issuable strengths of liquor were 25° U. P. and 60° U. P. but a mild drink of an intermediate strength of 45° U. P. has been introduced.

The consumption of liquor had considerably fallen in 1908-09, but it is steadily recovering. The consumption during the year 1911-12 was 82,900 proof gallons.

No change in the system of tari. Revenue from this source is small. It is procured from Sindi trees which are scarce in all taluqs except Murtizapur where the trade of tari is obtaining popularity.

Opium is imported from Ghazipur by Government as before but it is issued to retailers now at Rs. 27-8-0 per seer instead of at Rs. 23-8-0. There are 78 shops at which opium is retailed.

This drug is imported from the Government storehouse at Khandwa and the wholesale vendors require to pay Rs. 7-8-0 as duty. They have to pay cost also to the cultivators and manufacturers of ganja in Khandwa. Ganja trade is free as before and the licences for the wholesale vend of ganja are issued free of any charges to the respectable persons. The smuggling of ganja from His Highness the Nizam's Dominions has almost stopped.

The prices there are nearly as high as those in this district but the quality is reported to be inferior to that of the ganja on our side. The number of ganja shops is 44. There is only one shop of bhang (*i.e.*, at Akot) and this drug has practically no demand in the district. The Licences only for the sale of foreign liquors are issued, the one is F. L. 1 (Licence for the sale of liquor not to be drunk on premises) and the other is F. L. 2 (Public House licence).

Page 277, para. 207.—The District Board came into existence in 1889. It consists of 44 members, of whom 36 are chosen by a process of double election and the others nominated. The primary electors are cultivators who pay not less than Rs. 100 land revenue, all male adults who formerly paid a certain amount of town fund assessment, and all patels and patwaris. They elect twelve representatives who form, together with six nominated members, Taluq Boards and these bodies each elect six of their number to sit on the District Board. The total actual incomes of the District Board for 1910-11 and 1911-12 are Rs. 2,67,758 and Rs. 2,87,208. It is almost entirely drawn from cesses levied along with land revenue, cattle pound receipts, weekly market receipts, and contributions from Provincial revenues. Until recently fees for education were also received by the Board, but these are now taken by the School Committees. In 1911-12 the actual amounts from each of the above sources were—

Of the last item, Rs. 24,500 were given for Education and Rs. 24,000 for Civil Works. On the 1st of April 1912 the District Board had a balance in hand of Rs. 3,35,847. In 1911-12 the amounts were provided for the various main objects:—

The District Board and Taluq Boards are responsible for the upkeep of roads not maintained by the Public Works Department, primary schools, public wells and tanks, cattle-punds, and local works or measures likely to promote the health, comfort, or convenience of the public, besides being partially responsible for relief works in times of famine or scarcity. In the important towns and villages which have no municipal committees conservancy establishments are maintained out of the Board's funds, and a scheme of arboricultural operations to be carried out by the Board is also now in force. This scheme provides for the planting and maintenance of avenues along the main roads not belonging to the Public Works Department.

Municipalities.

Page 278, para. 208.—The four municipal towns in the district are Akola, Basim, Akot and Karanja.

The Akola Municipality was first constituted in 1868, and the number of members on the committee is 24, of whom 6 are nominated and 18 are elected; the Deputy Commissioner has always been the chairman. The income in 1911-12 was Rs. 84,774 and the expenditure was Rs. 89,497. The town has been extended to the east by acquiring land of the adjacent village, Umri. The new locality is known as Jatar Peth. Proper systems of drainage and an improved water supply are the most urgent wants. A scheme for the former has been lately sanctioned, but cannot be carried out till funds are available. The question of improving the water-supply has made a considerable progress. The Government have sanctioned a grant of Rs. 2,50,000 and private subscriptions have reached a sum of Rs. 82,000. Further sum required will be provided from the Municipal Fund and by a loan from the Government. The Basim Municipality started life in 1869 and has 3 nominated members and 9 elected members on the committee; the town has fallen in importance since the abolition of the Basim district. In 1911-12 the Municipal income was Rs. 22,881 and the expenditure was Rs. 22,568. Akot became a municipal area in 1884. Of the members of the committee 3 are nominated and 9 elected. In 1911-12 the income and expenditure were Rs. 16,032 and Rs. 16,986, respectively. Like Akot, Karanja is a small Municipal town, and the benefits of the municipal rule were extended to it in 1895. The number of the members of the committee is 12, and the electoral system was brought into force in April 1909. The

income in 1911-12 was Rs. 18,885 and the expenditure was Rs. 24,698. All the Municipalities depend for their income on taxes imposed on houses and lands, trades and professions, animals and vehicles, bales of cotton ginned and pressed, scavenging tax, pound receipts, surplus cotton market receipts, and slaughter-house fees. No octroi is in force, but the Akola Municipal Committee have imposed a toll tax on vehicles and animals coming into municipal limits. The main heads of expenditure are:—Establishment, Lighting, Water supply, Drainage, Conservancy, Education and Medical.

Page 279, para 209.—The C. P. Village Sanitation Act, XI of 1902, as applied to Berar, has recently been introduced in 6 important villages in the district, one in each taluq, *viz.*, Borgaon Mauju (Akola), Murtizapur-cum-Mubarakpur, Balapur, T. Thara (Akot), Risod (Basim), and Mangul Pir. Only the tax on houses and land has been allowed to be imposed for the present. Each Sanitation Panchayat consists of 6 elected members besides the working patel or patels.

Page 279, para 210.—For purposes of the Public Works Department Murtizapur taluq was in the East Berar Division but it was taken over to the West Berar Division and the Pusad taluq transferred to that division. An Executive Engineer is stationed at Akola and Sub-Divisional Officers at Akola, Basim and Khamgaon. The district contains 189 $\frac{1}{8}$ miles of metalled road. Among the principal buildings are the District Courts and offices and the jail at Akola. Other buildings include the tahsils, hospitals and dispensaries, inspection bungalows, and police stations. They also include High Schools, Anglo-Vernacular Schools and Marathi and Hindustani Girls' Schools.

Page 280, para. 211.—The sanctioned strength of the Police is 697 officers and men. These comprise one District Superintendent of Police, one Assistant Superintendent of Police, one Deputy Superintendent of Police, one Reserve Inspector, one Prosecuting Inspector, five Circle Inspectors, 37 Sub-Inspectors, 105 Head Constables, 541 Constables and 3 Camel Sowars. The Mahomedan members of the force number about 175 and a large number of men known as Bedars and Pardeshis from Upper India are enlisted. The district contains 25 station-houses and 7 road and frontier posts according to the Re-allocation Scheme introduced since 1910.

Page 280, para. 212.—The District Jail was formerly one of the two Central Jails of Berar and has accommodation for Jail. 465 convicts and 30 undertrial prisoners. The average daily number of prisoners in the last three years has been as below :—

The main industry is stone-breaking the same as before Aloe pounding, twine and rope making and tat-bedding according to the requirement of other jails are also forms of labour and are carried on when material is available.

Pages 280 and 281, para. 213.—A Government High School and two Anglo-Vernacular Schools with one Anglo-Urdu are maintained at Akola. There are also seven municipal schools. Education.

Anglo-Vernacular Schools are to be found at all taluq headquarters except Mangrul Pir and also one at Karanja in the Murtizapur taluq. The District Board is responsible for primary schools in non-municipal towns and villages. Girls' schools are now under the Government. Low caste boys are now exempted from paying fees only on the score of poverty. The American Alliance Mission maintains a small industrial school at Akola where carpentry and kindred trades are taught. The total number of schools in the district is at present 253 exclusive of indigenous aided and unaided schools. Education continues to be popular and a large number of schools lacks sufficient accommodation. There is only one vernacular weekly paper at Akola.
