INTRODUCTORY NOTE

The Library of the Servants of India Society at its headquarters at Poona is considered to be one of the rich libraries in India so far as Social Sciences are concerned. One of its special features is a large number of reports of Committees and Commissions appointed by various governments and other public bodies from time to time.

These reports are on various subjects. A glance at the index given at the end will bring home this fact quite vividly. Out of more than 3,400 reports included in the present list, 150 belong to the nineteenth century and five to the eighteenth century. The earliest report that the Library has was published in the year 1771 (see item no. 640) and is in five volumes.

As it is a common experience that there is always a great demand for such reports, it was thought worthwhile to undertake the compilation of a list of all such reports available in the Library.

In the following pages, along with the reports of committees and commissions, reports prepared by study groups, working parties, missions, delegations, etc. and the reports by 'special officers', awards, etc. have also been listed. Hearings of the subcommittees of the United States Congressional Committees have been included as a special case.

The arrangement of the reports is made according to the Colon Classification system. However, an exhaustive geographical-cum-subject index and an index to the chairmen at the end will solve the problem of all those who are not accustomed with the classification system used here.

The reports of the United Nations and its Specialized Agencies and of the Government of Canada, received on the depository basis, however, are arranged according to their own classification systems.

As this List is confined to reports of committees and commissions appointed on ad hoc basis, the reports of permanent or standing committees do not find place here. That work can best be done in a separate list devoted to that purpose.

The List is brought up to the end of June 1966.

Any suggestions that would add to the utility of this publication are most welcome.

The work of compiling this List was entrusted to Miss Rohini Joag of the Bibliographical Unit of the Library.
