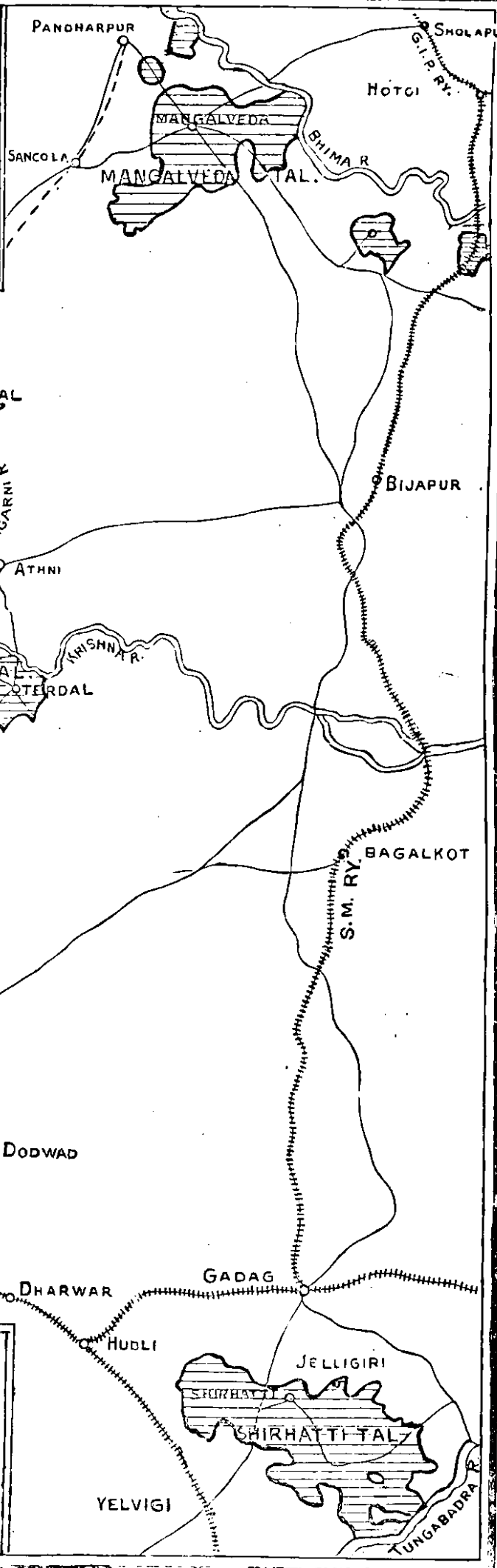


MAP OF SANGLI STATE
