READ—

The Reports from the Commissioner in Sind and the Commissioners of Divisions on the administration of the Local Boards in the Bombay Presidency during the year 1903-1904.

RESOLUTION.—In the year under report the number of District and Táluka Local Boards (231) remained unchanged.

2. The population is that of the last census, and the only change of area is in respect to the Mirpur Táluka (Sukkur) in which a slight error has been rectified.

3. Triennial elections were held in the Presidency Proper in the districts of Ahmedabad, Surat, Ahmednagar, Sátára, Ratnágiri and two tálukas of Kánara, and in Sind in those of Karáchi, Hyderabad and Sukkur. In several instances there was no competition. Where there were rival candidates the percentage of electors who went to the poll was lowest (18·7 per cent.) in Málvan and (19·1½ per cent.) in Karáchi, and highest (49·8 per cent.) in Parántij, (50 per cent. and 52 per cent.) in Kumta and Kárwár, and 58·9 per cent. in Modása. The amount of interest evinced varied largely in different parts of the same district.

4. In the Presidency Proper 853 meetings were held during the year as against 789 during the previous year, and in all 47 meetings were adjourned for want of a quorum. The rule as to half-yearly meetings was complied with by all District Local Boards except that of Karáchi, where the failure to hold two meetings is attributed to the prevalence of plague. Nine Local Boards in the Northern Division and six in the Southern Division failed to hold the prescribed number of meetings. There was a slight falling off in the average attendance of members in the Northern Division and in Sind.

5. The total income of the Boards decreased from Rs. 48,00,942 in the previous year to Rs. 48,00,157 in the year under review.

The following statement compares the receipts under the principal heads of revenue with those of the preceding year:—

The principal variations are explained below.

6. *Provincial Rates.*—Of the increase of Rs. 5,53,044, 92 per cent. is found in the Northern and Central Divisions and the remainder in the Southern Division, due partly to the recovery of arrears and partly to an improvement in the Land Revenue collections of the year in consequence of a favourable season. In Sind, however, there was a net decrease of Rs. 3,019 under this head due to the failure of rabi crops in the Northern Districts.

7. *Police*.—The increase of income (Rs. 18,908) under this head was, as in the previous year, due to larger receipts under the Cattle Trespass Act.

8. *Education*.—The net decrease of Rs. 9,379 under this head was due to smaller receipts in the Southern Division principally, where it was necessary to close some of the schools in the Belgaum, Bijapur and Dhárwár Districts on account of plague. In the Central Division a net increase of Rs. 6,585 occurred in two districts, partly due to a transfer of funds and partly to a higher Government grant.

9. *Medical*.—The increase (Rs. 2,117) was mostly contributed by the Northern Division and was due to the transfer of surplus receipts of the Victoria Memorial Fund to the District Local Board of Thána for the establishment and maintenance of a new dispensary at Mokháda.

10. *Scientific and other Minor Departments*.—In the Northern and Central Divisions the fluctuations under this head were nominal. In the Southern Division there was an unimportant decrease of Rs. 1,170. The increase of Rs. 8,466 in Sind was derived from garden receipts in the Sukkur and Thar and Párkar Districts, and sales of minor produce and receipts from fairs in the Hyderabad District.

11. *Miscellaneous*.—The receipts under this head are fluctuating and no special explanation of the increase (Rs. 4,317) is called for.

12. *Civil Works*.—The main sources of income under this head are (1) Tolls on roads and ferries, and (2) Popular contributions. In the Northern Division there was a net increase of Rs. 10,224 under (1) which was shared in by all districts except Broach, and is attributed to the greater prosperity of the year. In the Central Division the realizations under this sub-head decreased by Rs. 15,257, owing partly to the effect of plague on traffic in the Khándesh District and partly to the fact that the realizations in the preceding year in the Poona District were swelled by the recovery of arrears from the road and toll ferry farmers. Popular contributions increased by Rs. 6,593 in the Northern Division and by Rs. 1,236 in the Southern Division. In the former a larger contribution was received from the Surat Municipality, which collects the tolls on the Hope Bridge, and contributions were made by the inhabitants of Bassein for the construction of a suspension bridge at that place.

13. Contributions from Provincial to Local decreased by Rs. 6,55,299. In Sind there was an increase of Rs. 4,629 under this head, due mainly to increases under sand and quarry fees in the Robri Táluka of the Sukkur District. By Government Resolution, Educational Department, No. 1749, dated the 29th August 1903, the limit of aid given by Government to Local Boards on account of primary education was raised from one-third to half of the Boards' expenditure. In the year 1902-1903 grants amounting to 7½ lakhs were made by Government to various Local Boards for educational and medical purposes. Part of the difference of nearly one lakh appears to be due to the higher grants for primary education and part to other causes, such as a large addition to the receipts from sand and quarry fees in the Thána District.

14. *Debt*.—The decrease of Rs. 15,530 in the Northern Division was due to no large deposits having been received as in the previous year, and that of Rs. 5,498 in the Central Division was due to the adjustment of a wrong debit in the Sátára District.

15. The incidence of income per head of population decreased from 4 annas 6 pies to 4 annas 5 pies, while the incidence of taxation increased from 2 annas 2 pies to 2 annas 8 pies.

16. The total expenditure of the Boards amounted to Rs. 45,81,112 against Rs. 44,89,972, showing an increase of Rs. 91,140. In the following statement the outlay under the several heads is contrasted with that of the preceding year :—

The causes of the chief fluctuations are noted below.

17. *Administration.*—The small fluctuations under this head in the Northern, Central and Southern Divisions do not need special mention.

18. *Education.*—In Sind and in all three Divisions there were ordinary fluctuations in the expenditure on school furniture and in the number and pay of masters, which mainly account for the variations noticed in the statement. The following deserve mention. In the Thána District 14 schools for hill tribes and 5 ordinary schools were opened. New schools were also opened in Dhárwár, Kolába and Kánara in the Southern Division and in the Hyderabad, Lárkána and Upper Sind Frontier Districts in Sind where, too, some qualified masters were appointed on higher pay. In the Upper Sind Frontier District Rs. 6,000 were contributed towards a technical school building at Jacobabad. In the Central Division there is a decrease of Rs. 30,211, which amount approximately was spent from the special grants made by Government in 1902-1903.

19. *Medical.*—The increase of Rs. 9,398 under this head occurred mainly in the Northern and Southern Divisions. In the former Division it was due chiefly to the establishment of a new dispensary at Mokháda in the Thána District and to the payment of arrears in the Panch Maháls and Surat Districts on account of medical stores obtained during the previous year. In the Southern Division the increase occurred chiefly in the Dhárwár District and was due partly to the establishment of a new dispensary at Hirekerur and partly to the purchase of furniture and stores for the Hangal Dispensary. In the Central Division also most of the districts show an increase which, however, was more than counter-balanced by a reduction of Rs. 10,616 in plague charges in the Sátára District, the net result being a decrease of Rs. 1,810.

20. *Stationery and Printing.*—No explanation has been given of the increase of Rs. 1,432 in the Central Division. The printing of Local Board Rules in the Dhárwár and Belgaum Districts accounted for the increase of expenditure in the Southern Division.

21. *Miscellaneous.*—The increase of Rs. 15,057 was to a great extent due to the refund by the Hyderabad District Board of a sum of Rs. 12,080 erroneously credited to it during 1902-1903. The increase of Rs. 2,267 in the Central Division has not been explained.

22. The decrease of Rs. 6,058 under Famine Relief requires no explanation.

23. *Civil Works.*—The increase (Rs. 70,981) under this head was general and was highest in the Southern Division (Rs. 41,782) and lowest in the Central Division (Rs. 4,938). The increase in the Northern Division amounted to Rs. 16,855 and that in Sind to Rs. 7,405. The aggregate charge represents nearly 49 per cent. of the total expenditure of the Boards as against 48 per cent. in the previous year. In the following table the charges under the various sub-heads are compared with those of the previous year:—

The figures show that the largest increase was on the construction of original buildings, and that the greater portion (nearly 66 per cent.) of the outlay on Civil Works was devoted to the construction and maintenance of roads. In the three Presidency Divisions approximately 51 per cent. of the expenditure under this head is on repairs to communications, and in individual districts such as Surat, Sātāra and Sholāpur it amounts to as much as 66 per cent. The subject is receiving the attention of Government. In Hyderabad and Thar and Pārkar in Sind new roads, bridges and school-houses were constructed. The fluctuations under other sub-heads call for no remarks. The amount expended on public works carried out by the Local Boards establishments was Rs. 10,93,603 against Rs. 11,31,117 in 1902-1903, while the amount expended on works executed through the agency of the Public Works Department was Rs. 11,28,751 compared with Rs. 10,28,742 in the previous year.

24. *Contributions.*—There was an increase of Rs. 6,821 under this head in the Northern Division, which was very nearly counterbalanced by the decrease in the other Divisions. The increase in the Northern Division was mainly due to the refund to Government by the Ahmedabad Board of sums overdrawn by it in 1899-1900 and 1900-1901. The decrease of Rs. 2,105 in the Southern Division was chiefly noticeable in the Dhārwar and Belgaum Districts, and was due in the former case to smaller grants made to Sanitary Boards and in the latter to the absence during the year of the special contribution to the Athni Municipality on account of repairs to the roads within municipal limits. In Sind the contributions to Provincial increased by Rs. 1,871 and those to other Boards decreased by Rs. 5,860, thus resulting in a total decrease of Rs. 3,989. The increase under the first head was due to the Thar and Pārkar District repaying to Government Rs. 8,000 as compared with Rs. 6,000 in the preceding year on account of the advance of Rs. 40,000 given by Government for constructing bridges over water-courses in the Northern District of the Jamrao Canal, and the decrease under the latter head was due to the fact that a contribution was made in 1902-1903 by the Sukkur District to the Lārkāna District towards the cost of the dispensary at Khairpur Natheshah.

25. *Debt.*—The increase of Rs. 3,388 in the Southern Division relates only to the Dhārwar District, and represents the payment of the half-yearly instalments in liquidation of the debt contracted in 1895. The decrease of Rs. 7,592 in the Northern Division is accounted for by the fact that no large deposits were refunded during the year as in the previous year. The increase of Rs. 1,494 in the Central Division is not accounted for. The decrease in Sind amounted to Rs. 956.

26. The closing balances of the Boards in the Presidency amounted to Rs. 21,31,492 against Rs. 19,12,447 in the preceding year and Rs. 15,05,134 in 1901-1902. The increase of over 4 lakhs of rupees last year was explained by the fact that it included the special grant of 7½ lakhs made by Government in that year. In almost all cases the balances are in excess of the minima prescribed by Government, but the most noticeable excess is in the districts of

Kaira, Panch Maháls and Thána in the Northern Division, Khándesh, Násik and Poona in the Central Division, Bijápur, Kolába and Ratnágiri in the Southern Division, and Karáchi, Hyderabad and Thar and Párkar in Sind. The large excess in the Kaira District was due to the exercise of caution in consequence of the extent of the damage done by locusts not being known and that in the Panch Maháls to the amount set apart for public works not being fully utilized by the Public Works Department. The excess in the Bijápur District is said to be due to the heavy realizations of the one-anna cess in the closing months of the year when no new works could be taken up and to many of the public works remaining incomplete owing to the scarcity of labourers on account of plague. In the Ratnágiri District the excess includes the balance of the School of Industry and the amount of interest on the Izon Endowment Fund, and in the Hyderabad District nearly one-third of the excess is due to certain Túluka Boards for works not completed or paid for during the year. It is noted that everywhere steps are being taken to utilize the balances.

27. The administration of the Local Boards has on the whole been satisfactory. With the more normal season the income from the one-anna cess in the Presidency Proper rose to its proper level. Owing, however, to the continuance of plague, which was severe in several districts of the Presidency, especially in the Central and Southern Divisions, the year cannot be called prosperous. The epidemic interfered with the progress of education, detracted from the interest taken in the Boards' operations, and in places affected the actual execution of works. The Government grant-in-aid for primary education was raised from one-third to half of the expenditure on condition that Local Fund expenditure was not reduced. Little advantage, however, could be taken of the enlarged grants during the year; but a considerable impetus to primary education is likely to be seen in the near future. The Boards in the Presidency Proper already utilize on education 31 per cent., 31 per cent. and 40 per cent. in the Northern, Central and Southern Divisions, respectively, of their inelastic revenues. In Sind, where extension of cultivation still affords opportunity for expansion of income, the proportion of income spent on education, 30 per cent., was not quite so high. The expenditure on communications, original and repairs, amounted in Sind to 35 per cent. on the revenue and in the Northern, Central and Southern Divisions, respectively, to 27·7, 29·3 and 32·7 per cent. The amount spent on water-supply was highest in the Northern Division, over 9 per cent. of the total expenditure, mostly in the two Northern Districts. Elsewhere the expenditure in this direction is comparatively small.

28. Copies of this Resolution should be submitted to the Secretary of State and the Government of India, and should be forwarded to all Commissioners and Collectors and other Officers and Departments as usual.
