READ—

The Reports from the Commissioner in Sind and the Commissioners of Divisions on the administration of the Local Boards in the Bombay Presidency during the year 1904-1905.

RESOLUTION.—In the year under review the number of District Local Boards in the Presidency remained unchanged, while that of Taluka Local Boards shows an increase of 3 owing to Boards having been newly constituted at Nasrat in the Hyderabad District and Pithoro and Singhoro in Thar and Parkar.

2. The area and population of the Boards in the Presidency proper have remained unaltered, but in Sind the constitution of the 3 new Taluka Local Boards has caused variations under those heads.

3. Triennial elections were held in the Presidency proper in the Districts of Khándesh, Násik, Poona, Sholápur, Bijápur and Dhárwar. As regards Bijápur, no account of the elections is given, and in more than one-fourth of the groups in the Central Division in which elections were held there was no contest at all. In Shirpur in Khándesh the contest was keen, and a fair amount of interest was evinced in Gadag, Ranobennur and Kod. The proportion of qualified voters who exercised their privilege was much below 50 per cent. in the Central Division, as also in the Dhárwar District, where the abstention of voters is mainly attributed to the prevalence of plague.

4. In the Presidency proper 817 meetings were held during the year against 853 in the previous year, 39 being adjourned for want of a quorum. The rule as regards half-yearly meetings was complied with by all the District Local Boards in the Northern and Southern Divisions; no information on this point has been supplied in respect of the Central Division. In Sind the District Local Board of Karáchi again held only one such meeting owing to the prevalence of plague. The prescribed number of 4 meetings was not held by 10 Taluka Boards in the Northern Division. A smaller number was found sufficient for the transaction of the business of the remaining Boards in that Division, while in regard to the defaulters in the Southern Division, *vis.*, the Taluka Local Boards of Khánápur, Gadag, Karajgi and Sangameshvar, steps have been taken to ensure the future observance of standing orders. The provisions of section 34 of the District Municipal Act were made use of whenever necessary by circulation of papers among the members. There is a small improvement in the average attendance of members in the Presidency proper, but a falling off is noticeable in Sind mainly in the Hyderabad and Sukkur Districts.

5. The total income of the Boards decreased from Rs. 49,00,157 in the previous year to Rs. 43,84,296 in the year under review.

The following statement compares the receipts under the principal heads of revenue with those of the preceding year :—

The principal variations are explained below.

6. *Provincial rates.*—The net decrease under this head amounts to Rs. 8,14,255 and is shared in by all the Divisions in the Presidency proper. The Central Division and the Northern Division together are responsible for the large decrease of Rs. 6,22,318, all the Districts in those Divisions contributing to it on account of remission and suspension of local cess due to the unfavourable season and ravages of locusts, as also to there being no large recoveries of arrears in Ahmedabad and Surat Districts, as in the previous year. In the Southern Division the decrease of Rs. 54,301, which occurred mainly in the Belgaum, Bijapur and Dhárwár Districts, is also attributed to the suspension of land revenue owing to indifferent seasons. Sind shows a net increase of Rs. 62,364, which is recorded in all the Districts where *rabi* crops are grown, and due to the favourable inundation of 1903-04.

7. Under "Interest" there was a decrease of Rs. 1,142 in Sind due to the sale of Government Securities in the Lárkína and Sukkur Districts owing to the Dispensary funds being insufficient to meet the necessary expenditure.

8. *Police.*—The increase of nearly Rs. 13,000 under this head is due to larger realizations under the Cattle Trespass Act in Khándesh, Poona, Násik and Sátára in the Central Division, and in all the Districts of the Northern Division, where a greater number of cattle had been turned loose by their owners on account of scarcity of fodder. In Sind there was a decrease of Rs. 2,318, due to the low inundation of 1904-05 and the absence of rain.

9. *Education.*—In the Southern Division there was an increase of Rs. 5,112 shared in by all the Districts. Of this Rs. 4,129 were mainly due to school fees and contributions in the Belgaum and Dhárwár Districts. These were the result of larger attendance at schools consequent on the gradual abatement of plague and the shorter duration of its outbreaks, and also of the greater interest taken by the people in educational matters in the latter District.

10. *Medical.*—The greater part of the increase of Rs. 2,620 in the Southern Division occurred in Ratnágiri alone, where the receipts improved by over Rs. 2,000 on account of the transfer of the Dápoli Dispensary to the District Local Board, the Dápoli Municipality having been converted into a notified area. This increase was more than counterbalanced by a decrease of Rs. 4,927 in Thána, which, however, is merely nominal, as last year's figures were inflated by the transfer to the District Local Board of the surplus receipts (Rs. 4,919) of the Victoria Memorial Fund for the establishment of a new Dispensary at Mokhida.

11. *Scientific and other Minor Departments.*—The decrease of nearly Rs. 4,000 under this head is confined mainly to Sind. In Surat the accounts of the Veterinary Dispensary fund were amalgamated with those of the Local Fund, as the management of the dispensary was for the first time assumed by the District Board, and this caused an increase of over Rs. 1,000. In Sind the revenue declined by over Rs. 5,000 owing chiefly to the prohibition of several important fairs in Karachi on account of plague. The receipts from experimental cultivation in Sukkar and Thar and Párkar Districts also declined on account of the injury caused by the severe frost last winter.

12. *Miscellaneous.*—Under this head there was a decrease of Rs. 6,324 in the Districts of Ahmednagar, Khándesh, Poona and Sátára and a small increase of Rs. 1,526 in the Southern Division, but the items included under it are of a fluctuating nature and call for no remarks.

13. *Civil Works.*—Income under this head is mainly derived from (a) tolls on roads and ferries, and (b) popular contributions. As regards (a), the net increase of Rs. 16,401 in the Central Division was due entirely to the establishment of additional toll stations in the Khándesh District and to heavier imports of cotton from Hyderabad territory and the Berárs into that district. There was a decrease in Poona due to there being no arrears for recovery from toll farmers as in the previous year. In the Southern Division an increase of nearly Rs. 15,422, contributed to more or less by all the Districts, was a result of keener competition at the auction sales of the farms. In the Northern Division there

was an increase of Rs. 3,229 in Kaira, Panch Mahals and Surat Districts, but it was more than counterbalanced by the large decrease of Rs. 7,310 in the Ahmedabad and Thána Districts. In Ahmedabad the falling off was due to the failure of crops, and in Thána to an instalment of tolls outstanding at the end of the year to the extent of Rs. 3,184. In Sind the increase was due to larger receipts from sales of lac and babul pods from roadside trees in Hyderabad District and to the sale of two old ferry steamers belonging to the Sukkur Local Board for Rs. 9,900. The receipts of the District Local Board, Karachi, however, decreased by over Rs. 5,000 owing to the failure of the ferry farmer to pay a portion of the amount due to the Board.

With regard to (b) variations of importance took place only in the Northern Division, where Ahmedabad, Panch Mahals and Surat Districts show an aggregate increase of Rs. 6,705, of which 70 per cent., composed of sums received in connection with water-supply and tank repairs, were contributed in Surat.

14. Contributions from Provincial to Local increased by over Rs. 1,50,000, and the increase is shared in by all the Divisions. It is chiefly due to the increased grants to Local Board Schools sanctioned in Government Resolution No. 1,749, dated 29th August 1903, and fully drawn in the year under report, and partly to improvement in the realizations from sand and quarry fees in Sind and the Southern Division and to Government grants for village water-supply and sanitation in the Central and Southern Divisions.

15. The incidence of income per head of population increased from 4 annas 5 pies to 6 annas and 2 pies, while the incidence of taxation decreased from 2 annas 8 pies to 2 annas 2 pies.

16. The total expenditure of the Boards amounted to Rs. 46,59,024 against Rs. 45,81,112 in the previous year, showing an increase of Rs. 7,87,912. The following statement shows the distribution of the expenditure under various heads as compared with that of the previous year:—

The important variations in the above figures are noted below.

17. *Education*.—Under this head there was an increase of nearly Rs. 72,000, which is shared in by all the Divisions. It was due mainly to the cost of opening new schools, grant of promotion to school masters, appointment of new and trained teachers, purchase of furniture, and grant of scholarships. In Thána Rs. 2,744 were spent on scholarships in the wild tribes schools, and in Koliba also a small sum was spent on a similar object. Ahmedabad shows a decrease of over Rs. 8,000, which is nominal, as there was unusual expenditure in the preceding year on the purchase of furniture out of the special grant from Government.

18. *Medical*.—The decrease of Rs. 39,447 under this head was general in all the Divisions, but was only nominal, being caused by the introduction of the new arrangements sanctioned by Government whereby Hospital Assistants were paid during the year from Provincial Revenues instead of from Local Funds as in the previous year. There was an increase of nearly Rs. 5,000 in the Southern Division on account of vaccination in all the Districts except Koliba, which was

mainly due in Kánara and Dhárwár to the grants towards the purchase of Lano-line Vaccine Paste.

10. *Scientific and other Minor Departments.*—There was an increase of Rs. 3,426 in the Northern Division, due principally to a grant to the horse show in Ahmedabad, the taking over of the Veterinary dispensary by the Surat District Board, and the improvement of the veterinary establishment in Thána.

20. *Stationery and Printing.*—There was an increase of over Rs. 9,000 in the Presidency proper, and the bulk of it, *viz.*, Rs. 7,347, occurred in the Central Division, and nearly Rs. 2,000 in the Southern Division on account of extra printing necessitated by the general elections held in Khándesh, Násik, Poona, Sholápur, Bijápur and Dhárwár.

21. *Miscellaneous.*—There was an increase of Rs. 2,355 in the Central Division only, as the unspent balance of the grant from the Provincial to Local Funds for improvement of ghát communications in the Násik District was refunded by the Board. In the Northern Division a decrease of over Rs. 4,000 was mainly due to the refund of the grant for improvement of communications by the Thána District Board in 1903-04, and in the same year a payment of Rs. 12,980 by the Hyderabad District Board to the Karachi Board on account of fishery revenue accounts for the large apparent decrease of over Rs. 8,000 in Sind.

22. *Civil Works.*—This head shows a net increase of Rs. 1,15,244. In the Central Division the increase amounted to Rs. 1,21,955 and in the Northern Division to Rs. 60,940. In the Southern Division and Sind expenditure decreased by Rs. 42,509 and Rs. 25,272, respectively. The aggregate charge represents over 50 per cent. of the total expenditure of the Boards as against 49 per cent. in the preceding year. The following statement compares the charges under the various sub-heads with those of the preceding year:—

The above figures show that the largest expenditure was incurred on communications. This was mainly in Khándesh, Násik, Ahmednagar, Poona, Thána and Surat, and the expenditure absorbed more than 67 per cent. of the total outlay on Civil Works. The greatest falling off occurred under Buildings, and was more or less general, and was due to fewer new buildings having been constructed during the year than in the previous year. Expenditure on water-works and water-supply also shows an increase of over Rs. 56,000, which is participated in chiefly by Ahmednagar, Karachi, Hyderabad, Thar and Párkar, Belgaum, Dhárwár, Ahmedabad, Kaira, Broach and Thána. In the Central Division, Northern Division and Sind, new school-houses, dispensary, dharmashalas, wells, tanks, inspection bungalows and bridges were constructed. The amount expended on public works carried out by the Local Boards establishment was Rs. 11,70,746 against Rs. 10,93,603, while the amount expended on works executed through the agency of the Public Works Department was Rs. 11,68,373 against Rs. 11,28,751 in the preceding year.

23. *Contributions.*—There was a decrease of nearly Rs. 32,000 in all the Divisions, of which the Northern Division is responsible for Rs. 17,593 and the Central Division for Rs. 10,735. The fall of Rs. 10,830 in Ahmedabad is nominal and is due to the Board having made practically no payment to

Government during the year as it did in the preceding year. In Kaira the reduction of grants to Municipalities owing to smaller recoveries of the one-anna cess within their limits accounts for the decrease of Rs. 6,375. In the Central Division the most marked decrease was in Poona, where there was nothing to set against the grant made in 1903-04 on account of a new dispensary building at Indápur.

24. *Debt.*—The falling off under this head, i. e., Rs. 13,404, occurred mainly in the Dhárwár District and also in Kaira and Thina, where the fact that no promissory notes of value were purchased as in the preceding year virtually accounts for the total fall of Rs. 8,364 in the Division.

25. *Interest on debt.*—The increase of nearly Rs. 6,000 under this head occurred mainly in the Dhárwár District.

26. The closing balances of the Boards in the Presidency amounted to Rs. 18,43,788 as against Rs. 21,31,492 in the preceding year. The decrease has taken place in the Presidency proper. Sind shows an increase of Rs. 60,000. In all the Districts, except Sátira, Ahmedabad and Dhárwár, the balances approximate to or are much in excess of the prescribed minima. The most important excesses appear in Surat, Thána, Khándesh, Kolába, Ratnágiri and all the Districts of Sind. In respect of excesses in Surat and Thána no explanation has been furnished, but as regards the Khándesh District it is stated that a sum of Rs. 2,28,413 has since been allotted from the balance for the construction of roads and buildings in Khándesh. In all Sind Districts the increase was due to larger realizations from the one-anna cess, and in Hyderabad the excess is attributed to works not yet completed or paid for, to Government and popular contributions for wells and to savings from the amount provided in the Budget for certain works, &c. Steps have been taken in all Divisions to utilize the excess balances for works of public utility. The balances of Ahmedabad and Sátira fell considerably short of their prescribed minima. In the former the deficiency is explained as the combined result of overdrawals during famine years and outlay almost as great as last year in the face of a considerable decrease in the amount actually available for expenditure. In Sátira there was apparently not a sufficient working balance, but the special grants from Government will soon place that district in an easier position.

27. The administration of the Local Boards during the year 1904-05 does not call for any special remarks. The year was uneventful and though not on the whole unprosperous was nowhere marked by unusual activity in any branch of local administration. His Excellency the Governor in Council notes with regret that the figures relating to elections do not indicate that the working of the Boards excites any increasing interest among those who are qualified to vote. The decrease exhibited in the aggregate income of the Boards was a serious one, but does not seem to have affected the expenditure of the year, which was in excess of that of the previous year. The result however was a falling off in the amount of the closing balances. The increase in the School receipts is a welcome testimony to the diminished prevalence of plague, and it is satisfactory to observe that the expenditure on Education increased by an appreciable amount during the year. In connection with the Civil Works executed by or on behalf of the Boards, it is gratifying to note that the greater part has been spent on communications, an object which in almost all districts both deserves and repays such attention as can be bestowed upon it. His Excellency in Council observes also with satisfaction that considerable expenditure was devoted to water-supply and water works. The general financial condition of the Boards appears to be quite sound, two only being in a position of indebtedness. These Boards have taken long term loans from Government, which they are repaying punctually by instalments.
