Bombay Castle, 21st June 1927.

Read reports from the Commissioner in Sind and the Commissioners of Divisions on the administration of Local Boards in their respective charges during the year 1925-26.

RESOLUTION.

1. *Number of Boards.*—There was no change in the number of District and Taluka Local Boards in any of the districts except the Bombay Suburban District where the two taluka local boards of Ambernath and South Salsette were abolished under Government orders from 1st November 1925.

2. *Area and Population.*—The area under the jurisdiction of the Upper Sind Frontier District Local Board decreased by 90 square miles due to a decrease in river Kacha land in Kashmore taluka. There was also a decrease of 26 square miles in the area under the authority of the District Local Board, Nasik, on account of the exclusion of Bhagur village from the Board's administration. The areas under the control of the remaining District Local Boards were unchanged.

As regards population there was a slight increase of 170 in the Southern Division due to correction of mistakes in the previous year's figures in Kanara. The population in the Central Division decreased by 4,846 due to the exclusion of the Bhagur village from the control of the Nasik District Local Board. There was no other change in the population of any other Districts.

3. *Constitution.*—The year marks the complete democratization of the local Boards as all of them had non-official Presidents and Vice-Presidents. In Sind, N. D., C. D., and Bombay Suburban Division all the local boards were reconstituted in accordance with the provisions of the new Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923, while in the Southern Division there was a similar reconstitution of the District and Taluka Local Boards of Bijapur and Dharwar Districts only.

4. *Meetings.*—With the exception of the District Local Board, Kanara, and the Taluka Local Boards of Dapoli, Dero Mohabat Tando Bago, Kambar, Dhandhuka, Vada, Kalyan, Sakri and Tasgaon, all District and Taluka Local Boards held the prescribed number of meetings. Government have frequently pointed out that under section 35 (1) of the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923, it is obligatory on the Boards to meet not less than once in every 3 months. It is hoped that in future the defaulting Boards will conform to the requirements of the law. Advantage of the provisions of section 41 of the Local Boards Act was taken by a few of the District Local Boards for the transaction of business by circular. In this connection, the attention of the Boards is again drawn to the following remarks made in the last year's review on the administration of the Local Boards:—

“ A too frequent employment of the sanction given by this section is undesirable both because the intention of the Act is to limit its use to emergent cases only and because it is preferable that the disposal of business should be effected after discussion.”

5. *Income.*—The aggregate income of the Boards (excluding debit item) rose from Rs. 1,67,81,957 to Rs. 1,93,69,404. The principal variations under the different sources of revenue are explained below:—

(a) *Land Revenue.*—The receipts from this source decreased from Rs. 4,45,614 to Rs. 4,38,760. The decrease is mainly due to the drop

in the receipts from stone and quarry fees in the Northern, Central and Bombay Suburban Divisions, partly counterbalanced by increased receipts in Sind and the Southern Division. In Sind the increase was mainly due to the increased receipts from rent of fisheries.

(b) *Local Rates*.—The receipts from this source rose from Rs. 46,74,583 to Rs. 48,84,221, due to the recovery of arrears of suspended cess and in some cases to an increase in the rate of levy and larger realizations of irrigation cess. The increase was shared by all Divisions.

(c) *Police*.—The receipts from this source rose from Rs. 3,96,829 to Rs. 5,64,277. The increase was shared by all Divisions and was due to the transfer of control and management of cattle pounds to the Boards and the opening of new cattle pounds.

(d) *Education*.—The receipts under this head increased from Rs. 82,17,000 to Rs. 93,32,995, the increase being shared by all Divisions except Sind. The largest increase (*viz.*, Rs. 9,86,840) was contributed by the C. D. and was mainly due to the receipts of larger provincial grants for primary education.

(e) *Medical*.—The receipts from this source increased from Rs. 1,77,163 to Rs. 2,67,751. The increase was shared by all Divisions and was due to the revision of Government grants to medical dispensaries.

(f) *Civil Works*.—The receipts from this source increased from Rs. 24,01,271 to Rs. 32,54,665. The increase was shared by all Divisions and was due to (a) increased receipts from the auction sales of road and ferry tolls, (b) increased Government contributions for improvement of communications and village water supply and other public works, and (c) increased popular contributions.

The other variations call for no special mention.

6. *Expenditure*.—The aggregate expenditure of the Boards chargeable to current revenues rose from Rs. 1,53,61,255 to Rs. 1,73,48,158. The principal variations under various heads are explained below :—

(a) *Administration*.—The expenditure under this head rose from Rs. 5,94,579 to Rs. 6,65,511. The increase was shared by all Divisions except the Northern and Bombay Suburban Divisions and was due to new establishments, increased travelling allowances and increments. In the Bombay Suburban and the Northern Divisions the decrease was negligible and does not call for any special remark.

(b) *Education*.—The expenditure under this head rose from Rs. 89,41,530 to Rs. 97,80,077, the increase being contributed by Sind and the Central and the Bombay Suburban Divisions. In Sind the increase was due to the opening of new schools and increased grants-in-aid given to several Madressahs and Boarding houses. In the Central Division the increase was chiefly due to the transfer of control of primary education from Government and certain municipalities to the District Local Boards. In the S. D., the decrease was negligible, while in the Northern Division, the total decrease amounted to Rs. 2,13,419 and was chiefly due to the fact that the Educational accounts of the Thana District Local Board were transferred to its School Board from 1st August 1925.

(c) *Medical*.—The expenditure under this head decreased from Rs. 10,50,720 to Rs. 9,82,187. The decrease was contributed by the Northern, Central and Bombay Suburban Divisions and was mainly due to the payment in the previous year of arrears of pay of medical officers.

(d) *Civil Works*.—The expenditure under this head rose from Rs. 39,93,027 to Rs. 50,52,006. The increase was contributed by all Divisions except the Bombay Suburban Division and was mainly on account of buildings, communications and water-works.

7. *Closing Balances.*—The aggregate closing balances of all Boards amounted to Rs. 67,94,174 against Rs. 54,68,386 in the previous year. It appears that the closing balances with most of the Boards are very largely in excess of the prescribed minima. Last year, the attention of the Boards was drawn to the necessity for closer budgetting and they were asked to endeavour to bring the estimated closing balances more nearly to the prescribed minimum working balances. Government regret to find that in spite of this warning the closing balances at the end of the year under review, have risen by more than 13 lakhs of rupees. These figures are not satisfactory. Government must again impress on the Boards the need for more careful budgetting.

8. *Works and Standing Committees.*—It is noticed that standing committees and works committees have not yet been appointed by all district and taluka local boards. In the last year's review it was pointed out that under section 36 (1) of the Act VI of 1923 it is obligatory on the Boards to appoint Standing Committees. All Boards which have not yet appointed such Committees should do so in the near future.

9. *Village Panchayats.*—The working of the Village Panchayats did not on the whole show any marked improvement.

10. *Audit of Accounts.*—In the reports from Sind, the C. D. and the Bombay Suburban Division no separate reference is made to the results of the Audit of the Local Fund Accounts. The Commissioners should be requested to see that in future this reference is not omitted from their reports. In the Northern Division, the accounts of the Boards are reported to have been fairly well maintained. Some of the usual irregularities were repeated but no serious mismanagement was reported anywhere in the Division. In the S. D. there was on the whole a marked improvement in the maintenance of the Boards accounts but the working of the Engineering branch was far from satisfactory. In Kanara, a Sub-Overseer whose conduct in recording measurements was found to be suspicious was discharged from the Board's service and in Roha (Kolaba) the services of one Sub-Overseer and a karkun were dispensed with. The recurrence of such cases can only be prevented by the employment of a properly qualified supervising staff and adequate action against the delinquents.

11. *Administration Report.*—The reports of the Commissioners on the administration of the Local Boards are due to reach Government on the 1st October and the printed tabular statements to be attached to the reports are due from the Manager, Government Central Press, on the 1st November every year (*vide* Government Resolution no. 11348, dated 8th November 1920). These reports and statements are generally not submitted to Government punctually by the Commissioners and the Manager, Government Central Press, with the result that the issue of the Government review is unavoidably delayed. The Commissioners and the Manager, Government Central Press, should be requested to submit their reports and statements punctually in future.

12. *General Remarks.*—The administration of the Boards was on the whole fairly satisfactory. The working of the Public Works Department section in some districts still leaves much to be desired for want of a qualified staff. Those Boards which have not yet appointed qualified Engineers should realize the necessity of doing so at an early date. Failure to make such appointments must entail a great deal of inefficiency and waste in the execution of works, and points to a lack of a proper sense of their responsibilities on the part of the Presidents and members of the Boards concerned.

13. The reconstitution of the Boards on an elective basis as provided under the new Act of 1923, was an important feature of the year under review. In some districts the interest shown in the elections was not very keen; in others the elections were run on communal lines. On the whole the results were satisfactory.

14. Lack of funds continued to be the principal difficulty of the Boards. Most of them were unwilling to avail themselves of the powers of taxation conferred upon them by the Act of 1923 and preferred to rely on

the financial support of Government. Under the present financial conditions it is idle to expect any increase in the already large grants-in-aid given by Government. The Boards must realize this, and if they desire increased amenities must be prepared to provide the requisite funds by increased taxation. The incidence of taxation in all districts is decidedly low. It is, therefore, not surprising that the Local Board revenue everywhere is inadequate to meet the primary obligations of the Boards.
