



### PREFATORY NOTE.

The listing of all the English records from 1803 to 1868, which are preserved in the Punjab Record Office, has already been completed in twenty-eight volumes. The present volume is a supplement to these and includes such papers as could not be mentioned in previous Press Lists.

A scrutiny of the records showed that some papers were actually missing from the bundles while they had been mentioned in the Press Lists. An elaborate search was accordingly made for such documents among the records of the Punjab Civil Secretariat and the Financial Commissioners' Office. The work entailed a patient examination of important old files relating to Indian States, political pensions, jagirs, revenue remissions and the like, and it revealed that besides such documents which were found attached to the files belonging to the above-mentioned offices, several other papers of the Punjab Record office, which had not been listed previously, existed there. All these have now been brought back to this office and listed in this volume. This process has taken some four years.

An alphabetical subject-index to the present volume will shortly be prepared and published.
