The first chapter of the report embodies a resume of the important events of the year.

[Seasonal conditions were not quite favourable and the world wide economic depression still persisting is adversely affecting the condition of our agriculturists. The sympathetic attitude which you were pleased to adopt in connection with the collection of assessment has been a source of much relief to the ryots.] The prevailing economic depression has also had its effect on the finances of the State and hence retrenchment had to be effected.

The scheme of water-supply for the town of Kundgol has been forwarded for your sanction. The scheme, though dependent largely on the rains, when completed is calculated to remove a real grievance in that town

The proposed constitution of the State Assembly is ready and is awaiting your assent and promulgation.

The relations with the British Government and other Indian States continued to be very cordial. The relations between the various communities in the State were, as usual, harmonious.

The traditional loyalty of the people to your person and Gadi continues.

In submitting this Report I deem it my bounden duty to place on record my deep sense of gratitude to you for the kindly help and advice extended to me in all important matters of administration.

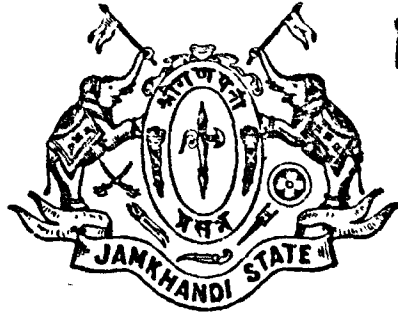
