 - „ XII, to make better provision for the trial of Pilots at the Presidency of Fort William in Bengal for breach of duty.
 - „ XIII, to provide for the punishment of breaches of contract by Artificers, Workmen, and Laborers in certain cases.
 - „ XIV, to provide for the Limitation of Suits.
 - „ ~~XV~~, for granting exclusive privileges to Inventors.
