






4. Variations in the Trade of British India with principal Countries during the last three years, as compared with average of the pre-war and war periods.







5. Monthly fluctuations in the net Imports or net Exports of Gold, Silver and Treasure (on private account) during 1923-24 and 1924-25.






7. Variations in the shares of the principal articles in the Import and Export trade of British India during the last three years, as compared with averages of the pre-war and war periods.




**9. Variations in the shares of the principal Countries in the Import and Export trade of British India during the last three years, as compared with averages of the pre-war and war periods.**




