










1909-10 TO 1913-14

EXPORTS









(1866-67 TO 1916-17)




- Note.—1. Each division of the ordinate represents Rs. 15 crores equal to Rs. 1,500 lakhs or £10 millions sterling.

 6. Net imports of Treasure are the Imports minus the Exports of gold and silver, both private and Government. The exports of treasure are ordinarily very much less than the imports.




(I) IMPORTS
