A FIVE-YEAR PROGRAMME OF DEVELOPMENT, 1936—1941.

INTRODUCTION.

The summary of the present position of the work of the Agricultural Department in Sind and the Five-Year Programme of Development, which are included in this Note, are based upon a review of the activities of the Department, carried out at a series of Staff Conferences, held in March 1936, and presided over by the Chief Agricultural Officer in Sind. At the present stage of the development of agriculture in Sind, it was very necessary that a definite plan should be framed in accordance with which the activities of the Agricultural Department should be directed for the next five-year period. Such a plan or programme will be most useful for the guidance of the staff of the Department and will serve as a measure of the progress which departmental research and district work may achieve in the near future towards the introduction and extension of improved agriculture in the province. In general, the main lines of policy have been indicated but, wherever possible, detailed objectives for the development of departmental activities have been shown.
