PREFACE TO SECOND EDITION.

To meet a continued demand, I am constrained to offer a second edition of this little work. It has been gratifying to receive evidence from many quarters that the book has served a useful purpose. I cannot but express gratitude for the favour with which it has been received by local government bodies, for whom it was chiefly intended, and by the press.

In all branches of civic administration I have found the Berlin Corporation eager to learn from other towns on the Continent and in Great Britain, and to adopt whatever improvements they can apply to their own affairs. In many respects I humbly think we in this country may in turn learn much from them, and I hope we shall be ready to follow their good example.

In the following pages I have sought, with as little comment as possible, simply to record the actual condition of things as I found them, leaving those concerned to judge for themselves how far the facts suggest instruction which might lead to improvement at home.

The figures given are taken chiefly from the municipal estimates for the year ending 31st March 1893.
