## PREFACE

The problem of the separation of state and local revenues is one which has received much attention recently from students of finance and state officials, and while it has not yet been widely adopted it is almost invariably discussed when financial reforms are under consideration. In this monograph, the writer has endeavored to make a comparative study of separation in those states where this aspect of the relation of state and local revenues is most prominent-attempting to ascertain the causes of its growth, its relation to increases in revenue and expenditures, and its effect on the distribution of the tax burden.

The writer wishes to take this opportunity to acknowledge her indebtedness to Professor Stephen I. Miller of Leland Stanford Junior University for suggesting the subject of the monograph, and to Professor Edwin R. A. Seligman, under whose direction the study has been made. The degrees of A.M. and Ph.D. are given to students who fulfil the requirements prescribed. (For particulars, see Columbia University Bulletins of Information, Faculty of Political Science.) Any person not a candidate for a degree may attend any of the courses at any time by payment of a proportional fee. Ten or more Cutting fellowships of $\$ 1000$ each or more, four University fellowships of $\$ 650$ each, two or three Gilder fellowships of $\$ 650-\$ 800$ each, the Schiff fellowship of $\$ 600$, the Curtis fellowship of $\$ 600$, the Garth fellowship of $\$ 650$, and a number of University scholarships of $\$ 150$ each are awarded to applicants who give evidence of special fitness to pursue advanced studies. Several prizes of from $\$ 50$ to $\$ 250$ are awarded. The library contains over 600,000 volumes and students have access to other great collections in the city.
