# APPENDIX

## NOTES

(1) The figures given in the Comparative Tables, 1908-1916, have been prepared from data kept in the books of the Department of Agriculture and Commerce. The rest has been compiled from the report submitted by local authorities for the year 1916, i.e. including all the reports of such societies as had finished their business year during 1916.

(2) Under the caption, "Number of Coöperative Societies Examined" have been included all the societies from which reports have come, whether the facts under examination existed in connection with the societies or not.

(3) Number of members, shares, investment, and reserve fund, give the figures reported at the end of the given year. The amount of loans made and savings received, are the figures that appeared as present at the end of the previous year, added to the amount transacted during the year in question. The amount of sales, purchases, cost of the work put on the material and the use of equipment, show the amount paid or received during the year named.

(4) In the third table relating to the funds, the figures representing money borrowed and deposits, are the amount actually on hand at the end of the year.

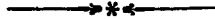
