

The following amendments have been sanctioned by Bombay Act No. IV. of 1905:—

To Section 3, clause (1), add the words 'and for the purposes of Sections 25 and 26 includes a village-officer appointed or officiating under any of the provisions of the Bombay Hereditary Offices Act, or the Matadars' Act, 1887.'

In Section 33, for the words 'Commissioner' wherever it occurs, substitute the word 'Collector.'

To the heading above Section 40, add the symbol &c.

In Section 43-

- (a) after the word 'remove,' insert the words 'from his holding';
- (b) after the words 'natural product,' where they first occur insert the words 'whether of the like description or not.'

In Section 52, as amended by Section 4 of the Bombay Land Revenue Code Amendment Act, 1901, for the word 'or,' where it first occurs, substitute the word 'and.'

In Section 80, for the words ' for the Collector to ' substitute the words the Collector shall on due tender thereof.'

In Section 144, the words 'subject to the orders of the Commissioner' should be omitted.

In Section 187, after the words 'in force,' in the second place where they occur, insert the word 'or by any contract with the Secretary of State for India in Council.'

In Section 214, clause (c), after the word 'may 'insert the words 'or may not.'

In Section 214, clause (i), after the word 'generally' insert the words "or carrying out the purposes and objects of this Act, and.'

#### In Schedule B-

- (a) to the Form of Road to be required under Section 23, add the following proviso, namely:—
- Provided always that nothing herein contained nor the security hereby given shall be deemed to limit my liability in respect of the matters aforesaid to the forfeiture of the said sum of rupees only, and that should that sum be insufficient to recoup the Secretary of State for India in Conneil in full for any loss or damage sustained by him in respect of the matters aforesaid I agree to pay to him on demand such further sum as shall be deemed by the person at the head of the said office necessary in addition to the said sum to cover such loss or damage as aforesaid, and
- (b) is the Form of Security to be subjoined to the Rend of the principal for the word 'such' substitute the words' the sum of rupees, in which the abovesaid has bound himself, or such smaller.'
