It furnishes the time-series data on the enrolment trends of elementary education from 1979 to 1989. The data has been presented for the country as a whole as well as for individual States and Union Territories. The data is also classified by stages of primary education.

The study is based on the data published by the Ministry in its annual publications in series : Education in India—Vol I, Vol. I(S) and 'Selected Educational Statistics'. The Project Staff' of the Statistical Division is to be complimented for bringing out this study.

Introduction

POLICY PROVISION FOR ELEMENTARY EDUCATION

Universalisation of Elementary Education (UEE) is a constitutional mandate. Article 45 of the Constitution stipulates, as a Directive Principle of State Policy, that the State shall endeavour to provide within a period of 0 years from the commencement of the Constitution, for free and compulsory education for all children until they complete the age of 14 years. The 6th five year plan (1980—85) envisaged UEE as a part of the Minimum Needs Programme (MNP). The point No. 10 of the 20-Point Programme calls for UEE with special emphasis on girls education. The National Policy on Education (NPE)—1986 also accords the highest priority to solving the problem of children dropping out of the school. It states to ensure that all children who attain the age of about 11 years by 1990 will have at 5 years' of schooling or its equivalent through the non-formal stream. Likewise by 1995, all children upto the age of 14 years would be provided free and compulsory education.

In spite of the fact that teaching facilities have been considerably expanded to provide free education upto class VIII in most of the States, a large number of children in the age group 6—14, still remain out of school. During the last decade alone, the number of primary and middle schools has increased from 408 thousands and 91 thousands to 548 thousands & 144 thousands in the country respectively, but so far as the goal of Universalisation of Elementary Education is concerned, the same is yet to be achieved.

The pace of enrolment growth in primary classes (I—V) which was earlier there during the fifties and sixties slowed down considerably during the seventies. An upward swing has, however, been noticed during the eighties.

Aims & Scope of the Study

The study aims at to analyse the enrolment trends during the last decade covering the period 1978-79 to 1988-89. Different target groups, viz. girls, educationally backward states wherein the additional efforts are called for have been identified. Comparative progress at the middle stage vis-a-vis primary stage has also been analysed.

Elementary education consists of two stages namely primary stage consisting of classes I—V and the middle stage also called upper primary consisting of classes VI—VIII. The pattern of the first and second stages of elementary education i.e. primary and middle are not uniform in all the States, yet in most of the States, the first stage consists of classes I—V. To ensure inter-state comparability, the analysis has been made on the basis of enrolment in classes I—V and VI—VIII irrespective of the different systems of school classes in several States.

Sources of Data used in the Study

The analysis has been made separately for boys and girls enrolment and total enrolment in classes I—V (primary), classes VI—VIII (middle) and classes I—VIII (elementary) for the country as a whole and also at State level. Statewise enrolment data used for this study is based on the Ministry's annual publication under the series 'Education in India—Vol. I' upto the year 1985-86 and the provisional data on enrolment published under the Ministry's annual publication 'Selected Educational Statistics' for the later year i.e. 1986-87, 1987-88 and 1988-89. The progress of enrolment at all India levels separately boys, girls and total (boys+girls) in classes I—V, VI—VIII and I—VIII has been indicated in Appendix I to IV. Annual percentage variation and the percentage coverage of Population in the relevant age groups 6—11 & 11—14 years also defined as gross enrolment ratios have also been worked out. Annual compound growth of enrolment at State level have been worked out separately for primary Classes I—V, and Middle (Classes VI—VIII) stages under Table I & II.

STUDY APPROACH AND ITS INSTRUMENTS

The study was based on deductive approach for bringing out important conclusions about enrolment trends during a decade's time between 1978-79 to 1988-89. The numerical information was available in different publications used as source of data like Education in India Vol. I and Selected Educational Statistics brought out in annual time series etc. As regards the instruments used for study, the survey of published documents was one of the major tools used for this work. The Interviews and discussions among the project officers and staff were held several times till arriving at important inferences with regard to the trend analysis of numerical data available in the documents. However, no formal questionnaire and interview schedules were developed for conducting this study.

Section—One

ENROLMENT TRENDS AT ALL INDIA LEVEL

Primary Stage

At the all India level the total enrolment of boys and girls in primary classes (I—V) increased from 690 lakhs in 1978-79 to 957 lakh in 1988-89. The annual compound growth rate for the said period works out to 3.34 %. The annual percentage increase varied from 2.92 % to 4.47 % during the same period. (Appendix-I)

The girls enrolment at the primary stage (classes I—V) increased from 264 lakhs in 1978-79 to 386 lakhs in 1988-89. The annual percentage increased in girls enrolment varied from 2.2 % to 5.2 % during the said period. The annual growth of girls enrolment works out to 3.88 % depicting a slightly faster growth of girls enrolment as compared to the boys enrolment during the last decade.

The Appendix-I indicates that—

The Gross Enrolment Ratios (GER) a crude measure of the percentage coverage of population in the age group 6—11 years has also shown an increase from 81.6 % in 1978-79 to 99.6 % in 1988-89. The corresponding Gross Enrolment Ratio for girls also increased from 64.3 % to 82.5 % during the same period.

The bar diagramme-I and its corresponding line diagramme also indicate the trend of regular increase over the period of a decade on year to year basis. The compound Growth Rate of enrolment has been shown in Table No. 3 for primary classes.




BAR DIAGRAM - 1

MIDDLE STAGE

Gross Enrolment Ratio for children in the age group 11-14 years increased from 38.0% in 1978-79 to 57.0% in 1988-89. For girls the corresponding ratio increased from 25.5% to 42.3% during the same period.

At the middle stage (classes VI-VIII) the total enrolment (boys+girls) increased from 182 lakh to 309 lakh during 1978-79 to 1988-89 showing an annual growth rate of 5.41%. Annual percentage increase varied from 3.43% to 7.69 during the same period as depicted in Appendix-II.

Appendix-II also reveals the fact that the girls enrolment in classes VI-VIII has increased at a faster growth rate as compared to the boys enrolment throughout the period 1978-79 to 1988-89. The annual percentage increase varies from 4.5% to 9.9% and the annual growth rate of girls enrolment in classes VI-VIII works out to 6.55% during the last decade. These finding are further supported by the Bar Diagramme—2 and the Line Diagramme—2

The Statement No.2 refer to the year wise enrolment data i.e. total enrolment and annual growth rate in terms of the percentage either increased or decreased on year to year basis and for the entire period of a decade from 1978-79 to 1988-89.

The Statement No.2 contains 11 different sheets each of these comprises the data for a particular year from 1978-79 to 1988-89.




ENROLMENT TRENDS DURING

ELEMENTARY STAGE

At elementary stage consisting classes I-VIII, the total enrolment increased to 1267 lakhs in 1988-89 from 871 lakhs in 1978-79. The annual percentage increase varied between 2.6% to 5.2% during the given period and the annual growth rate of total enrolment (boys+girls) works out to 3.81% and 3.44% and 4.42% separately for boys and girls enrolment. From, the above it may be seen that the difference between the Gross Enrolment Ratios for the boys and girls at the primary stage (6—11) years age group has somewhat increased from 17.3% to 19.3% during the last decade. Accordingly a serious look towards girls education is called for both at the Centre and State levels. In fact the goal of Universalisation of Elementary Education could be attained only if girls enrolment in Primary Classes (I—V) increases at a much faster annual growth rate of 6 to 7% in future as compared to the annual growth of 3.8% during the last decade. Appendix-III and Graph -3 are clear evidence of this conclusion.




BAR-DIAGRAM-3

Appendix No. IV and its corresponding line diagramme gives the yearwise girls enrolment at Primary (Class I-V), Middle (Class VI-VIII) and the Elementary (Class I-VIII) stages for the period 1978-79 to 1988-89. Inspite of the fact that the girls enrolment has been increasing at a faster rate in comparison to that of the boys enrolment. It may be noted that percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment in Primary stage (I-V) increased marginally during the last decade. Infact it increased just by 2% from 38.3% in 1978-79 to 40.3% in 1988-89.

Therefore, it may be concluded it would take long time to establish sex equality in education even at the primary stage unless effective steps are taken to accelerate the present annual growth of girls enrolment (3.9%) to a much higher level say of 6 to 7% annually.

At the middle stage however the situation is comparatively better as the percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment in classes VI-VIII has increased from 32.6% in 1978-79 to 36.2% in 1988-89 implying that sex disparities at the middle stage are likely to be narrowed down at a faster rate.

Taking primary & middle stages together also the percentage share of girls has shown only a marginal increase from 37.1% to 39.3% only during the last decade implying that sex disparities are yet to be overcome to achieve the goal of UEE in an effective manner.





PROGRESS OF ENROLMENT

Section—Two

ENROLMENT TRENDS IN STATES/UTS

Primary Stage

During the last decade, some of the educationally backward States have shown good progress towards achieving the goal of UEE. Of the nine educationally backward States, viz., Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, J&K, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal, as many as five States Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa and West Bengal have a higher Gross Enrolment Ratio for the 6-11 years age group as compared to the corresponding ratios at national level during the year 1988-89. For the 11-14 age group also, Assam, J & K, Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal have gross enrolment ratios exceeding the corresponding ratios at the national level.

Table-III depicts the sexwise annual Compound growth rates of enrolment in classes I-V for all States/UTs during the period 1978-79 to 1988-89. The annual growth varies considerably among different States. It is found to be the highest (7.7%) for Arunachal Pradesh followed by Assam (6.20%), Tripura (5.87%) and the lowest for Kerala (0.24%). In all there are 7 States for which the annual growth of enrolment in classes I-V exceeds 5% whereas for 12 States/UTs, the annual growth was found to be exceeding than that at the national level. For yearwise break-up of these statistical parameters, Statement No.—I from the year 1978-79 to 1988-89 has been referred to in this report.

While it is encouraging to observe that the annual growth of enrolment was significantly higher than the national annual growth of 3.3% in case of Andhra Pradesh (3.9%), Assam (6.2%), J & K (4.6%), Madhya Pradesh (5.7%), Rajasthan (5.7%), West Bengal (4.9%) and Arunachal Pradesh (7.7%), which are educationally backward States, the situation seems to be gloomy in case of the other two educationally backward States, viz., Bihar & Orissa both of which have annual growth of even less than that at the national level. For Uttar Pradesh also, the annual growth is found to be just marginally higher than the annual growth at the national level. This calls for need to take immediate action by these three States for implementing the UEE in an effective manner. See Bar-Diagram 4.

For all the States/UTs, the annual growth of girls enrolment is found to be higher than that for boys, the only exception being Assam wherein a different trend is observed. The highest annual growth of girls enrolment in Classes I-V is also found to be in Arunachal Pradesh (10.4%) followed by Maharashtra and Rajasthan (7.6% each) and in Sikkim (7.0%).

It is again distressing to note that the girls enrolment at primary stage (Classes I-V) in three major educationally backward States, namely, Assam, Bihar and Orissa have an annual growth of less than that at the national level. This calls for taking concrete measures by these States to promote girls education.

The position of percentage of enrolment of each state during these 10 years, year to year basis has been given in the Statement No.4 comprising 4 different sheets, each of them contains the data for 2 to 3 years.



Middle Stage

In Table No. 2, annual compound growth rate of enrolment at the middle stage (classes VI-VIII) has been worked out separately for boys, girls and total enrolment for all States/UTs. It may be seen that annual growth of total enrolment varies considerably from State to State for the period 1978-79 to 1988-89. The annual growth is found to be the highest in case of Arunachal Pradesh (12.9%) followed by Sikkim (11.7%) and Dadra and Nagar Haveli (9.6%).

It is encouraging to note that with the only exception of U.P. the annual growth of total enrolment in classes VI-VIII is found to be higher than the annual growth of 5.5% at the national level in respect of all other educationally backward States, viz, Andhra Pradesh (6.9%), Assam (9.2%), Bihar (5.7%), J&K (6.9%) Madhya Pradesh (8.3%), Orissa (5.7%), Rajasthan (6.6%) and West Bengal (8.7%).

For 15 States, the annual growth of total enrolment in classes VI-VIII is found to be higher than that at the national level. The annual growth is found to be more than 7% in the States of Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Sikkim, Tripura, West Bengal, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh and Dadra & Nagar Haveli. Statement 5 has been referred to in support of these inferences.

The Annual growth is found to be very low in Kerala (0.95%) and Punjab (1.9%), which however seems to be on account of declining trends in population and other demographic factors.

It is encouraging to note that the girls enrolment at the middle stage (VI-VIII) in all the educationally backward states also increased at faster rate as compared to the annual growth of total girls enrolment at the national level for the said period.

Excluding Assam, all other States had a higher growth of girls enrolment at the middle stage (classes V-VIII) as compared to the annual growth of boys enrolment during 1978-79 to 1988-89. The annual growth of girls enrolment is found to be the highest in Arunachal Pradesh (15.7), followed by Sikkim (15.2%), Dadra and Nagar Haveli (11.6%), Himachal Pradesh (11.2%) Madhya Pradesh (10.3%) and A & N Islands (10.1%) and more than 8% in 4 States/UTs during the period 1978-79 to 1988-89.


In all there are sixteen States where-in girls enrolment in Classes VI-VIII increased at an annual rate of higher than 9% during the last decade. From the above analysis we may conclude as under :—

- (i) The girls enrolment at the middle stage (Classes VI-VIII) has been increasing at a much faster rate as compared to the boys enrolment during the last decade in all the states except Assam.
- (ii) Barring Uttar Pradesh, total enrolment at the middle stage in all the educationally backward states has increased at a faster rate as compared to that at the national level. This implies that regional disparities are likely to be reduced in future at the middle stage of education.
- (iii) The annual growth of enrolment at the middle stage (Classes VI-VIII) is found to be much higher than the corresponding growth at the primary stage (Classes I-V). This implies that the percentage of students continuing their education beyond class V has been steadily increasing with the improvements in teaching facilities for middle education in the country. Bar diagram No. 5 interestingly indicates the realistic position for nine educationally backward States.

Elementary stage (Classes I—VIII)

The annual growth of enrolment at the elementary stage (Classes I—VIII) during the period 1978-79 to 1988-89 varies considerably among different States/UTs. The annual growth is found to be the highest in Arunachal Pradesh (8.41%) and the lowest in case of Kerala (0.48%). States/UTs wherein the annual growth is found to be higher than that at the national level are:—Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, J & K, Madhya Pradesh, Chandigarh, Delhi and Mizoram.

It is a matter of concern to note that for Bihar, Orissa and Uttar Pradesh which have been classified as educationally backward States, the annual growth of enrolment in classes I—VIII is found to be less than the annual growth for the country as a whole i.e. 3.8%. This is otherwise quite obvious from Bar Diagram No.6. This implies that the programme of "Universilisation of Elementary Education" has so far not been implemented effectively in these States. Consequently the national goal of achieving UEE could be made possible in the shortest possible time period only if the annual growth of enrolment in these States is increased significantly to atleast 5%.

The girls enrolment at the elementary stage (Classes I—VIII) too has also been growing unevenly among different States/UTs. The highest annual growth of girls enrolment is found to be highest in Arunachal Pradesh (11.10%) and the lowest in Kerala (0.35%). States/UTs where-in the annual growth of girls enrolment is found to be lower than the annual growth of girls enrolment at the all India level are Bihar (4.35%), Kerala (3.39%), Maharashtra (3.59%), Meghalaya (3.31%), Orissa (3.8%), Punjab (1.11%), Tamilnadu (3.35%), Dadar and Nagar Haveli (3.17%), Delhi (0.37%), Goa, Daman & Diu (3.25%). While the lower annual growth of girls enrolment in States, like, Kerala, may be because of significant progress already made by most of the above mentioned States/UTs, the situation seems to be grim in case of States like Bihar and Orissa both of which are educationally backward States. The girls education programmes have not been implemented effectively in these two States. Accordingly, there is an urgent need by the concerned State Governments to take time bound measures for promoting girls education at the elementary stage.

Table-IV and Bar Diagramme—6 indicates the Annual Growth Rate of Enrolment for all States/UTs and for nine educationally backward States during the period of 10 years from 1978-79 to 1988-89.



Conclusions

1. The girls enrolment has grown slightly at a higher annual rate as compared to the boys enrolment during the last decade.
2. The difference between the Gross Enrolment Ratios for the boys and girls at the primary stage 6-11 years age group has some what increased from 17.3% to 19.3% during the last decade. Accordingly a serious look towards girls education is called for both at the Centre and State levels. In fact the goal of Universalisation of Elementary Education could be attained only if girls enrolment in primary classes (I-V) increases at a much faster rate of 6-7% in future as compared to the annual growth of 3.8% during the last decade.
3. During the last decade, some of the educationally backward States have shown good progress towards achieving the goal of UEE. Of the nine educationally backward States, namely, Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, J & K, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal, as many as 5 States namely Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa and West Bengal have a higher gross enrolment ratio for the 6-11 years age group as compared to the corresponding ratios at national level during the year 1988-89. For the 11-14 years age group also, Assam, J & K, Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal have gross enrolment ratios exceeding the corresponding ratios at the national level.
4. The existing classification of educationally backward States needs to be reconsidered based on the latest enrolment data in classes I-V for the purpose of Universalisation of Elementary Education. However, for other national programmes like National Literacy Mission, etc. we may adopt some other relevant criteria based on the latest data on literacy which would be available based on 1991 census.
5. While it is encouraging to observe that the annual growth of enrolment was significantly higher than the national annual growth of 3.3% in case of Andhra Pradesh (3.9%), Assam (6.2%) J & K (4.6%), Madhya Pradesh (5.7%), Rajasthan (5.7%), and West Bengal (4.9%) which are educationally backward States, the situation seems to be gloomy in case of other two educationally backward States like Bihar & Orissa both of which have annual growth of even less than that at the national level. For Uttar Pradesh also, the annual growth is found to be just marginally higher than the annual growth at the national level. This calls for need to take immediate action by these three States for implementing the UEE in an effective manner.
6. For all the States/UTs, the annual growth of girls enrolment is found to be higher than that for boys, the only exception being Assam wherein a different trend is observed.
7. The girls enrolment at the middle stage (Classes VI-VIII) has been increasing at a much faster rate as compared to the boys enrolment during the last decade in all the states except Assam.
8. Barring Uttar Pradesh, total enrolment at the middle stage in all the educationally backward states has increased at a faster rate as compared to that at the national level. This implies that regional disparities are likely to be reduced in future at the middle stage of education.
9. The annual growth of enrolment at the middle stage (Classes VI-VIII) is found to be much higher than the corresponding growth at the primary stage (Classes I-V). This implies that the percentage of students continuing their education beyond class V has been steadily increasing with the improvements in teaching facilities for middle education in the country.
10. It may take several decades to establish sex equality even at the primary stage unless effective steps are taken to accelerate the present annual growth of girls enrolment (3.9%) to a much higher level say of 6-7% annually.
11. Based on the existing enrolment patterns during the last decade, it may be concluded that sex disparities at the middle stage are likely to be narrowed down at a faster rate as compared to the primary stage.
12. For the Elementary Stage i.e. primary & middle stages taken together also, the percentage share of girls has shown only a marginal increase from 37.1% to 39.3% only during the last decade implying that sex disparities are yet to be over come to achieve the goal of UEE in an effective manner.
