## Centrally Sponsored Schemes in the Education Sector

---

### Background

Report of the Group of Officials on Centrally Sponsored Schemes defined these schemes as schemes fully or partially funded by the Centre and implemented by the States or State agencies except those which fall in the Centre's sphere of responsibility i.e. in the Union list.

Until the Fourth Five Year Plan, central assistance to the States for implementation of Plan programmes within the State's jurisdiction was given in the form of scheme-wise allocation of funds. This resulted in rigidities and inefficiencies in the system and inequitable distribution of central assistance. The matter was raised in several meetings of National Development Council (NDC). On the basis of discussions in NDC, the concept of block assistance in the State Plans was subsequently introduced. However, it was felt by the Central Ministries and the Planning Commission that scheme-wise assistance should be continued for a limited number of schemes. These schemes were classified as Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS). National Development Council(NDC) while agreeing to the concept of CSS, suggested limiting the total monetary value of CSS to 1/6th or 1/7th of the quantum of central assistance to State Plans.

The Sixth Plan again witnessed an enlargement of CSS in terms of number as well as quantum of assistance for finalising such schemes. At the time of discussion of the Approach Paper to

the 7th Plan in July, 1984, some of the Chief Ministers suggested a closer examination. An Expert Group under the chairmanship of Shri K.Ramamurthi went into the various issues relating to Centrally Sponsored Schemes. The NDC while considering the Ramamurthi report at its meeting held on the 8th and 9th November, 1985, resolved that a Committee of NDC should be set up to examine the various issues raised in the Report and report back to NDC. Accordingly, NDC Committee under the chairmanship of Shri P.V.Narasimha Rao the then Minister of Human Resource Development was set up to (a) Review the criteria for taking up new Centrally Sponsored Schemes; (b) review of the ceiling of 1/6th or 1/7th of Central Plan assistance keeping in view the Plan objectives of poverty alleviation and employment generation etc.; (c) consultation mechanism for starting new CSS, (d) examination of CSS under implementation with a view to dropping or transferring of some of them with the modalities of transfer of the funds involved; and (e) suggesting a periodical review mechanism of transferred schemes.

The NDC Committee (Narasimha Rao Committee) constituted a Group of Officials, headed by Shri J.S.Baijal, the then Secretary, Planning Commission, to work out the details regarding retention or mode of transfer of CSS to State Plans. The Group of Officials submitted its report to the NDC Committee on April 13, 1987. The NDC in the 43rd meeting held on December 23-24, 1991 approved the recommendations of the NDC Committee which involved transfer of 113 Centrally Sponsored Schemes to the States. Finally 68 Centrally Sponsored Schemes out of 113 Centrally Sponsored Schemes were transferred to the States.



## **Centrally Sponsored Schemes in Education**

Centrally Sponsored Schemes in education sector fall in the following three categories:

- i) Bringing about greater equality through expansion of better educational facilities to the deprived sections of the society;
- ii) Improvement of the quality in education and;
- iii) Involvement of voluntary agencies.

When the Eighth Five Year Plan proposals were being formulated, the views of the Planning Commission were that ongoing centrally sponsored schemes would ordinarily be terminated except where specific justification for continuance as centrally sponsored schemes was forthcoming. Planning Commission classified Centrally Sponsored Schemes into two lists.

**List I:** Comprising schemes which should continue in the Eighth Plan as Centrally Sponsored schemes - these are related to national goals and having a national character on account of which it is important to fund and monitor them from the Centre.

**List II:** Other schemes which could be transferred to the States.

The schemes started by the Department of Education fell into the category of List No.I and none of them was considered necessary to be transferred to the States.

The Department of Education, at present, implements 17 Centrally Sponsored schemes. Financial assistance released to the States and the physical achievements made are indicated in the Tables that follow:-

### **Financial Releases**

Tables 1 to 11 indicate financial releases made under the various Centrally Sponsored Schemes. It can be seen from Table 6 that during the Seventh Plan (1985-90) an amount of Rs.1248.80 crore was released to the States/Union Territories under different Centrally Sponsored Schemes. The amounts released during Annual Plans of 1990-91 and 1991-92 were Rs.363.95 crore and Rs.382.11 crore respectively. During the first three years of Eighth Plan i.e. 1992-93, 1993-94 and 1994-95, the amounts released were Rs.503.60 crore, Rs.664.69 crore and Rs.747.70 crore respectively.

### **Physical Achievements**

#### **Operation Blackboard**

The scheme of Operation Blackboard, started in 1987-88 to bring about substantial improvement in physical facilities in primary schools with the aim of improving retention has three inter-dependent components, namely;

- (i) Atleast two reasonably large all weather rooms along with separate toilet facilities for boys and girls;
- (ii) Atleast two teachers and as far as possible one of them a woman; and

(iii) Essential teaching and learning material including blackboards, maps, charts, a small library, toys and games and some equipment for work experience.

Table 12 shows that teaching learning equipments were supplied to 5.23 lakh primary schools and 0.27 lakh upper primary schools during the period 1987-88 to 1994-95. While additional posts of teachers sanctioned were 1.47 lakh, out of these 1.18 lakh were appointed. The post of third teacher has been sanctioned to 18990 primary schools. The number of classrooms constructed were 1.45 lakh.

## **2. Non-Formal Education:**

Despite considerable expansion of formal education, the achievement of UEE goals remain a distant dream as large group of children remain outside the formal system due to various socio-economic constraints. In order to reach this large segment of marginalised children, the Govt. of India, Deptt. of Education has been running, since 1979-80, a programme of non-formal education for children of 6-14 age-group who have remained outside the formal system. These include dropouts of the formal schools and others who are unable to attend formal schools. During 1994-95, there were 2.61 non-formal education centres in the country, 2.30 lakh in State sector and about 31 thousand in Voluntary sector. The State-wise details can be seen in table 13.

### **3. Teacher Education**

The Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Restructuring and Reorganisation of Teacher Education" is being implemented since 1987-88. Its main objectives are to impart suitable pre-service and in-service training to school teachers so that they may competently discharge their role in the context of National Policy of Education and to provide academic and resource support at the grass root level for the success of various strategies and programmes being undertaken in the areas of elementary, secondary and adult education. Under the scheme upto 1994-95, 394 DIETs, 60 CTEs and 27 IASEs have been sanctioned. State-wise details are given in **table 14**.

### **4. Lok Jumbish**

An innovative project called "Lok Jumbish" : People's Movement for Education for All: with assistance from Swedish International Development Authority (SIDA) has been undertaken in Rajasthan. The basic objective of the project is to achieve education for all by the year 2000 through people's mobilisation and their participation. The Government of India approved the first phase of the project for a period of two years, 1992-94, to cover 25 blocks spread over several districts with an estimated cost of Rs.18.00 crores to be shared by SIDA, GOI and Government of Rajasthan in the ratio of 3:2:1. The first phase of the project has concluded on 30th June, 1994.

During the first phase the target for project coverage was achieved (25 blocks) and project interventions were made in several components of primary education like teacher's training,

minimum levels of learning, opening of new schools, non-formal education centres etc.

During the phase I 204 primary schools were opened; 144 primary schools were upgraded; 339 posts of additional teachers provided; 2120 schools were provided with equipment and teaching-learning material; 650 NFE centres were opened; 30 training camps for Master Trainers and 198 camps for teachers were organised; mobilisation of activities were undertaken in 1,096 villages; 50 field centres were opened and 294 women groups were organised.

A Joint Evaluation of the project by SIDA, GOI and GOR expressed satisfaction with the initiatives undertaken in the project and recommended its extension and continuance. Proposal for continuation of Lok Jumbish Phase II during the period 1994-97 has recently been approved with an outlay of Rs.80 crores to be shared in ratio 3:2:1 by SIDA, GOI and GOR.

#### **5. Vocational Education**

Schemes of 'Vocationalisation of Higher Secondary Education' was introduced with effect from February 1988. The main objectives of the scheme are to enhance individual employability, reduce the mismatch between the demand and supply of skilled manpower and provide an alternative for those pursuing higher education without particular interest or purpose. Upto 1994-95 vocational courses have been introduced in 6317 higher secondary schools by having opened 16,039 sections. Statewise details are given in Table 15.

## **6. Science Education**

The scheme of 'Improvement of Science Education' initiated during 1987-88 aims at improving the quality of science education and promoting scientific temper as envisaged in National Policy on Education 1986. Accordingly, 100% assistance is provided to the States/UTs for upgradation of science laboratories in Government and Government-aided secondary/higher secondary schools, provision of science kits to upper primary schools, provision of library assistance to secondary/higher secondary schools and training of science and mathematics teachers. Upto 1994-95, science kits were supplied to 79427 upper primary schools, the science laboratories of 35421 secondary/senior secondary schools were upgraded, libraries of 35596 secondary/senior secondary schools were equipped with science books and 197 district resource centres were set up. State-wise details are given in **Table 16.**

## **7. Educational Technology**

The scheme of 'Educational Technology' seeks to improve utilisation of the media through Radio and Television for the back-up of educational sector. Initiated in 1972, it has undergone many changes over the years. The scheme seeks to provide the entire cost of Radio-cum-Cassette Players (RCCPs) in primary schools and 75% cost of colour television (CTV) in upper primary schools to provide access to quality education. Upto 1994-95, 3.56 lakh RCCPs and 0.62 lakh CTVs have been supplied to the schools. State-wise details can be seen in **Table 17.**

## **8. Computer Education**

A pilot project on Computer Literacy and Studies in Schools (CLASS) was initiated in 1984-85 in consultation with Department of Electronics. The project aims at providing computer familiarity to secondary/senior secondary level students. 2798 schools have been covered upto 1994-95. The State-wise details are given in **Table 18.**

## **9. Environmental Orientation to School Education**

The scheme started in 1988-89 aims at providing infusion of environmental information and concepts in the general syllabus and curriculum. The scheme initially catered to the requirements of elementary sector was subsequently extended to secondary and senior secondary levels. Assistance is given to State Governments for reviewing syllabus and text books for providing environment orientation. A major thrust under the scheme is to fund NGOs for developing innovative methods and reading material for school children in the field of environment.

## **10. Integrated Education for the Disabled Children (IEDC)**

100% assistance is provided to the States/UTs/Voluntary Organisations for providing necessary facilities to disabled children in common schools, such as books and stationery allowance, transport allowance, uniform allowance, readers allowance, equipment allowance, hostel charges etc. The scheme also provides for meeting the cost of salary of special teachers; setting up of resource rooms, carrying out of assessment of disabled children, training of special teachers, removal of

architectural barriers in schools and production of instructional material.

#### **11. Promotion of Yoga**

Under the scheme, financial assistance is provided for training of teachers in yoga and for building the infrastructure necessary for the purpose. In addition, institutions of all India character are given assistance for maintenance as well as developmental expenditure for promotion of basic research and/or for teachers training programme in various aspects of yoga other than the therapeutical aspect. Financial assistance to yoga institutions for promotion of therapeutical aspect is being extended by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

#### **12. Rural Functional Literacy Programme (RFLP)**

Rural Functional Literacy Projects (RFLP) is one of the oldest Schemes initiated right with the launching of the National Adult Education Programme on 2nd October, 1978. It has been a centre based programme. On the basis of findings and recommendations of evaluation studies and internal assessment, the scheme of RFLP was re-organised and several structural changes were made. Following the success of Total Literacy Campaigns, the Centre based Programme has been closed down in almost all the States/UTs w.e.f. April, 1991. The Expenditure Finance Committee, however, recommended the implementation of the revamped RFLP Scheme from 1994-95 in Jammu and Kashmir, North Eastern States, border districts of Rajasthan and other difficult terrain, hilly areas and isolated pockets. There is a provision of Rs.6.00 crores for 1994-95 under the Scheme.



### **13. Post Literacy and Continuing Education(PL&CE)**

The scheme was launched through establishment of Jana Shikshan Nilayams(JSNs) all over the country in a phased manner. The objective of the scheme is to provide opportunity of continuing education to neo-literates to facilitate retention of their literacy skills, enable the learners to continue their learning beyond elementary literacy and to create scope for application of their learning for improvement of their living conditions.

### **14. Strengthening of Administrative Structure in Adult Edn.**

Under the scheme, the States/UTs are being assisted to create necessary supportive administrative structures at State/UT and district levels for implementation of Adult Education Programmes. While the central grant is meant to cover the entire expenditure on items like POL, re-imbusement of medical expenses, office expenses, travelling expenses etc. are met by the State Governments.

### **15. Appointment and Training of Hindi Teachers in Non-Hindi Speaking States/UTs**

With a view to assisting the non-Hindi speaking States/UTs for promotion and propagation of Hindi in pursuance of the provisions contained in Article 351 of the Constitution of India, the Central Government had started, during the Second Plan, the schemes of (i) Appointment of Hindi teachers; and (ii) Opening/Strengthening of Hindi Teachers Training Colleges. Under these schemes central assistance was provided to the non-Hindi speaking States/UTs on 100% basis. These schemes were implement-

ed upto the Seventh Plan as two separate schemes. Since the objectives of these schemes are similar, these have been merged together into a single scheme entitled "Appointment and Training of Hindi Teachers in non-Hindi speaking States/UTs" in the Eighth Plan.

#### **16. Financial Assistance for Promotion of Modern Indian Languages and English Language**

Financial Assistance is being provided to voluntary organisations as well as individuals for brining out publications as well as purchase of books with a view to promoting and propagating Modern Indian Languages and English Language. Similarly, voluntary organisations engaged in promotional activities in various Modern Indian Languages and in English also receive Central assistance. These are ongoing schemes and now being administered by the CIIL, Mysore (MIL portion) and by the CIEFL, Hyderabad (English Language portion).

#### **17. Appointment of Urdu Teachers**

A scheme for appointment of Urdu Teachers and grant of incentives for teaching and study of Urdu is under consideration in consultation with the Plannin commission.
