Sir,

I have the honour to submit the report on the working of the Indian Companies Act VI of 1882 in the province of Bombay for the year 1913-1914, together with the statistics in the forms (statements marked Nos. I to X) prescribed by the Government of India. Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 and those to which the Provident Insurance Societies Act V of 1911 and Companies to which the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act VI of 1912 apply are also dealt with in the report.

2. During the year sixty-six new Companies were registered. Of these, sixty-four were Companies whose liability was limited by shares and the remaining two by guarantee. In the last named class is included a Company by name "Rander Mehefile Islam Kutubkhana" which was granted a license under section 26 of the Act. Two Companies, *viz.*, The Mehta Bros. Match Manufacturing Company, Limited, and The Gordhan Spinning and Weaving Company, Limited, which were under liquidation, were revived under the orders of the Civil Courts. These were consequently removed from the list of Companies under liquidation (statement No. VI) and added to the list of new Companies with share capital (statement No. II).

3. Subjoined is a statement showing comparison of documents arranged under different heads as registered during the year 1913-1914, and the year 1912-1913:—

The above table exhibits a noticeable increase under two heads—"Notices of Situation, etc.," and "New Companies." Increase in registration of new Companies is dealt with hereafter whilst the increase in the notices of charge of offices is due to the larger number of Companies on the Register and notices

received from newly registered Companies. Returns under the Societies Registration Act again show an increase, which can be ascribed to the persistent calls, inviting the attention of the Secretaries of these Societies to compliance with the provisions of section 4 of Act XXI of 1860. The other items of increase or decrease are not so striking as to require an explanation as they are subject to fluctuation.

4. With a view to exhibit the nature of the various industries which have attracted the capital from the public during the year, a classified list is given below, of Companies Limited by shares, registered under the Act during the year as contrasted with those during the year preceding :—

The above shows a significant increase in the head of "Other Trading Companies" but it includes a good number of minor concerns, some of which may perhaps not live long enough to start work.

The large increase of new Companies, especially under the above head, may be ascribed to the following fact:—

The public considered the new Companies' Law that was to come into force from April 1st, 1914, to be severe, and therefore, to avoid the troubles and difficulties that they anticipated under the new Act, intending promoters of Companies hastened the formation and registration of their projects. The rise would have been still higher had it not been for the banking crisis which brought to light more explicitly the responsibilities of the Directors in Joint Stock Companies and made people hesitate accepting directorships which, I should think, was done rather too freely before. Mills and presses have kept steady though with a small rise, as this industry is still attractive. The increase under "Insurance and Navigation" can be ascribed to the ample field for these enterprises.

The increase or decrease under other heads can well be ascribed to ordinary fluctuations.

5. In the matter of Banking and Loan Companies, there were some more additions to the number of *swadeshi* concerns of this nature at the beginning of the year. But any further increase in this direction was abruptly checked during the closing months of the year by the financial crisis which overtook the *swadeshi* banking world both in Bombay and up-country, and which caused the downfall of many of the existing companies, and gave such a rude shock to credit that any attempt to open new banks or loan companies would have been futile. Fortunately the crisis—severe though it was—passed off more rapidly than was at first anticipated. Though in individual cases its results were extremely disastrous, its effect upon credit generally does not seem to have been either widespread or very damaging.

6. Forty-six Companies went into liquidation during the year under report as compared with 26 in the preceding year. Of these, ten were finally dissolved in the same year. Nine of the Companies that were under liquidation on or before the 31st March 1913 have been finally wound up and two were revived and restored as stated in paragraph 2 above. Two Companies limited by

guarantee also went into liquidation. During the year the number of Companies that ceased to work is rather high and is due to a certain extent to the bank failures.

7. At the close of the year 1913-1914 the number of working Companies was 635. Of these, 613 were Companies limited by shares with a nominal capital of Rs. 52,56,56,900, nominal issued capital of Rs. 35,03,68,967 and paid up capital of Rs. 29,53,08,206 as compared with 593 Companies with authorized capital of Rs. 52,31,96,900, nominal issued capital Rs. 32,29,64,217 and paid up Rs. 27,47,01,104. The number of Companies limited by guarantee at the end of the year was 22 against the same number of Companies in the previous year. The number of members was increased by 20 over the figure of 16,765 of the previous year, the two Companies of this kind that went into liquidation being Companies with unlimited number of members.

8. One hundred and thirty-seven Companies increased their capital, either registered, subscribed or both. The aggregate increase in nominal was Rs. 30,50,000, in issued nominal Rs. 5,95,45,900 and in paid up Rs. 3,30,03,942 against 115 Companies with an increase in nominal capital of Rs. 2,32,90,600, issued nominal of Rs. 1,76,60,140 and paid up of Rs. 1,21,92,531 in the previous year.

9. Eighteen Companies reduced their capital. The reduction in the nominal capital was Rs. 12,94,100, in the issued nominal Rs. 3,76,175 while in the paid up capital was Rs. 4,05,573 against 12 Companies with a reduction in the nominal capital of Rs. 10,50,100, issued nominal Rs. 12,39,194 and paid up Rs. 20,52,601 in the year preceding.

10. The income of this office from all sources amounted to Rs. 31,057-4-0 against Rs. 24,923-6-0, showing an increase of Rs. 6,133-14-0. The following is a comparative table showing realisations of both the years 1912-1913 and 1913-1914 as arranged under different heads:—

The noticeable increase observable in the above statement is under the registration of "New Companies" and "Notices of situations" which as shown above in the causes of increase of documents are due to the increase in the number of new Companies. The decrease under "Special resolutions" can be attributed to the smaller increase of new capital made by special resolutions by Companies during the year. The other heads of increase and decrease are minor and subject to fluctuations.

11. The expenditure during the year amounted to Rs. 2,478-5-3 against Rs. 2,247-8-0, showing an increase of Rs. 225-13-3.

The increase under establishment (salaries) is due to the absence of clerks on privilege leave. The increase under contingent charges is due to the purchase of two wooden presses for Rs. 160 and that under travelling allowance to the attendance in Courts and also to two attendances of a clerk as a witness in criminal cases at Madras.

12. The offices of the Companies referred to in section 69 of the Indian Companies Act, 1882, were examined and all of them were found in order.

The Provident Insurance Societies Act (No. V of 1912.)

15. A Company by the name of "The Bharat Sarkar Company, Limited," was registered during the year under Act VI of 1882 and has applied for registration under the Provident Insurance Societies Act. This application, together with those from the other Companies which came within the provisions of the Act, are awaiting disposal pending publication of the final rules under the Act. There are only 10 Provident Societies on the registers of this office and these are the survivals of the very large number that had once existed. A little over 10 years ago there were over 200 of such Societies especially in Gujarát. But the constitution of these Societies was so defective that only the nominees of the members who died within the first 3 to 6 months benefited. As the amount receivable by the nominees of deceased members at once fell down to insignificant sums, these Societies came into disrepute, the number of subscribers fell off, and the Societies collapsed one after the other. There is no more confidence in such Societies, and it does not look likely that there will be any significant increase in these in the near future, even with the better regulations provided for by the new Act.

The Indian Life Assurance Companies Act (No. VI of 1912.)

16. The following three Companies that complied with the provisions of section 4 of the Act regarding deposits were registered during the year:—

- (1) The East and West Insurance Company, Limited.
- (2) The Western India Life Insurance Company, Limited.
- (3) The Industrial and Prudential Assurance Company, Limited.

17. The Government of India having decided that Companies that were carrying on business prior to the passing of the Act were not required to comply with the provisions of section 19, Foreign Life Insurance Companies did not submit papers of the kind therein named for registration.
