Sir,

I have the honour to submit the annual report on the working of Joint Stock Companies for the year ending 31st March 1918. The returns prescribed by the Government of India are appended to the report and the statistics relating to private companies have, in accordance with the instructions of the Director of Statistics, been shewn separately in each statement. As usual, the report also deals with societies registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, the Provident Insurance Societies Act, 1912, and the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, 1912.

2. During the year fifty new companies limited by shares were registered as compared with 36 in the previous year. One company "The Aniline and Alizarine Trading Company, Limited", which was in voluntary liquidation, was revived by the Court and restored to the list of working companies. The registered office of the "Bon Jumerri Anthracite Colliery, Limited" was transferred from the Province of Bengal to this Province. The details in respect of these companies are shewn in Statement No. II.

3. No new company limited by guarantee was registered but one such company, by name the "Ex Soldiers Society of India and Burma", was transferred to Bombay from the United Provinces. This is shewn in Statement No. III.

4. Of the 53 companies referred to above, 34 were public and 19 private, as against 23 public and 13 private companies registered in the previous year. The companies registered during the last two years are classified as under:—

In connection with the above the most interesting feature has been the large authorised capital of some of the new companies, over 19 crores of rupees being added during the year, the Tata Industrial Bank, Limited, leading with an authorised capital of 12 crores. The average authorised capital of the new companies works out at over 38½ lacs per company, of which a large portion has already been subscribed.

5. Thirty two companies,—30 limited by shares and 2 by guarantee, were removed from the register as compared with 25 in the previous year. Of these 32 companies, 9 were wound up by the Court, 13 went into voluntary liquidation and 10 were removed from the register under section 247 of the Act.

6. Of the companies in course of liquidation on or before 31st March 1917, liquidation has been reported complete in the case of 14 companies. As stated in my report last year, the majority of these companies are being wound up under the old Act which means that the liquidation drags on indefinitely, no effective steps being taken in many cases by the liquidators to bring matters to an end.

7. The bulk of the extinct concerns have now been removed from the register under section 247 of the new Act but there are still a few to be dealt with. There are also several companies on the register not at present working because of the effect of the war, but which hope to commence or to resume operations when normal conditions have returned, and I am permitting these companies to mark time without enforcing the Act against them.

8. The total number of companies working at the close of the year was 590, of which 573 were limited by shares and the remaining 17 by guarantee.

9. There were 26 private companies at the commencement of the year. 20 private companies including the "Bon Jumerri Anthracite Colliery, Limited", transferred from Bengal, were registered during the year as against 13 in the previous year; one of the above-mentioned 20 "The India Culture and Development Works Company, Limited" was subsequently converted into a "Public Company" under section 151. On the other hand "Steiners Limited" which was registered in 1905 as a public company was converted into a private company. There were accordingly 46 private companies at work at the close of the year.

#### *Change of Name.*

10. No company changed its name during the year.

#### *Alteration in Capital.*

11. One hundred and fourteen existing companies increased their authorised, subscribed and paid up capitals by Rs. 2,40,77,500, Rs. 1,67,30,010, and Rs. 1,79,31,290 respectively, as compared with increases of Rs. 1,34,93,500, Rs. 96,96,375 and Rs. 1,20,19,581 respectively in the previous year.

Most of the increases in capital were by Cotton Companies, which, owing to the war, were enabled to extend their operations.

12. Forty-one companies reduced their capital during the year. The aggregate reduction in authorised, subscribed and paid up capital being Rs. 5,29,250, Rs. 69,91,235 and Rs. 12,91,249 respectively as compared with decreases of Rs. 3,70,500, Rs. 41,56,125 and Rs. 14,64,915 respectively in the preceding year.

#### *Branch Registers.*

13. The provisions of section 41 in respect of British Registers were not utilized by any company.

#### *Appointment of Inspectors.*

14. The report of the Inspector appointed under section 138 of the Act referred to in paragraph 22 of my last report in the case of the Indian and Peninsular Steam Navigation Company, Limited, was transmitted to Government by the Inspector and a copy was finally transmitted to the company under section 141, the cost of the investigation being recovered by me from the

company, an order having been made by the Local Government under section 111 (3). The report by the Inspector in respect of the affairs of the Igatpuri Railway Co-operative Society, Limited, has not yet reached me.

The powers of investigation granted to Registrars under section 137 were of great utility on many occasions during the year.

*Registration of Mortgages and Returns of Allotment.*

15. Companies are, as a rule, fairly punctual in registering particulars of mortgages under section 109 and returns of allotment under section 104 but whenever companies failed to file these returns within the prescribed times, orders granting extensions of time had to be obtained from the High Court or a District Court before they could be filed in my office.

*Publication of Form G.*

16. The offices of the companies referred to in section 136 were visited and in all cases the section was found to have been complied with.

*Auditors.*

17. On the 1st April 1917, the number of persons holding Government Auditors Certificates issued under section 144 was 54, 3 permanent and 1 temporary unrestricted certificates, and 30 permanent restricted and 20 temporary restricted certificates being in force. During the year 3 provisional restricted certificates for a period of two years each were granted. The terms, for which restricted certificates had been granted to 11 persons, expired during the year, of which two were extended into permanent restricted certificates, 7 were renewed for further terms and 2 lapsed. One holder of a permanent unrestricted certificate died. The number of Government Auditors Certificates in force at the close of the year was thus the same as before namely, 2 permanent and 1 temporary unrestricted certificates and 32 permanent and 19 temporary restricted certificates.

Adding to this number the Chartered and Incorporated Accountants in Bombay, there are, as far as numbers are concerned, plenty of auditors but they are nearly all centered in Bombay and small mofussil companies still experience difficulty in some districts in getting suitable auditors and in paying their expenses.

*Foreign Companies.*

18. Six new companies incorporated outside British India filed documents in this office under section 277 (1) of the Act during the year, one ceased to carry on business and two changed their names during the year. The number of companies on the register accordingly rose from 209 to 214. A classified list of these new companies is given in Appendix A.

*Provident Insurance Societies Act.*

19. No new society was registered during the year. Of the eight societies operating under the Act at the beginning of the year one "The Hindu Shadi Sahaita Fund", which had practically no business, was dissolved. A list of existing societies is given in Appendix B.

*Indian Life Assurance Companies Act.*

20. No new company was registered or went into liquidation during the year. The "New Bombay Presidency Assurance Society, Limited" was removed from the register last year and was duly included in Statement No. VI, but no specific mention was made of this in para. 32 of my report. A list of companies existing at the close of the year is given in Appendix C.

21. A list of papers received from the Government of India for safe custody under section 27 is given in Appendix D.

*Societies Registration Act.*

22. The tendency of literary and charitable societies to obtain corporate status, previously mentioned by me, has continued to a certain extent. The

number of societies registered during the year was 19 as compared with 13 in 1916-17. Two societies changed their names during the year. A list of societies registered during the year is given in Appendix E.

#### Filing of Returns.

23. The table given below shows the number of documents of different classes registered during the year under report as compared with the previous year.

#### Prosecutions.

24. The majority of companies in Bombay have now some knowledge of the provisions of the Indian Companies Act and Companies' officers appear to realise, to a certain degree, their responsibilities under the Act. There has been, accordingly, some improvement in the filing of documents in this office. Explanations were however called for in respect of numerous delays, warnings were administered and less latitude generally was permitted than in former years. In a number of cases companies asked for an extension of the time limit prescribed for holding annual or statutory meetings or for filing balance sheets on the ground of prevalence of plague in certain localities. They were informed that the Act gave the Registrar no power to grant such extensions of time, but that if the plea was reasonable and substantiated the Registrar would exercise discretion in enforcing the penal provisions of the Act.

As foreshadowed in my last report, I instituted proceedings in a number of cases during the year.

In all 45 companies and persons were proceeded against and in 7 cases proceedings were withdrawn, in 17 cases convictions were obtained, in 2 cases the accused were given the benefit of section 281 of the Act in 9 cases the accused were acquitted and the remaining 10 cases have not yet been decided.

The following are examples of the cases :—

(a) One company in Satara failed to hold its annual general meeting under section 76, to submit its annual return under section 32, and to reply to my demands under section 137. The prosecution resulted in the conviction of the company and its Managing Director who were fined Rs. 250-8-0 and Rs. 111-12-0 respectively.

(b) One company in Poona failed to hold its annual general meeting in due time under section 76, to prepare and circulate its balance sheet under section 131, and to submit its annual returns under sections 32 and 131. The Directors and Managers were found guilty under section 76 but were relieved of their responsibility under section 281. As regards other alleged offences it was decided that the defaults were not proved to have been committed wilfully and the cases were dismissed.

(c) Two companies and their directors in Ahmedabad were charged with refusing to comply with my requisitions under section 137. In one case 3 directors were fined Rs. 7 each. The case against the other company has not yet been disposed of.

(d) A liquidator of a company failed to notify his appointment under section 203. He was fined Rs. 200.

(e) One delinquent company in Nasik failed to hold its annual general meeting under section 76, to prepare its balance sheet and to circulate it amongst its members under section 131, and to submit its annual list of members and summary under section 32 and its balance sheet under section 131. Two directors were convicted and each was fined in all Rs. 221-8-0 or in default was sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment, for 6 months.

#### Financial Results.

25. During the year the sum of Rs. 29,561-4-3 was realised from fees for the registration of documents, etc., as against Rs. 23,092-6-6 received during the previous year. The subjoined statement shows the receipts under the different heads as compared with those in the previous year.
