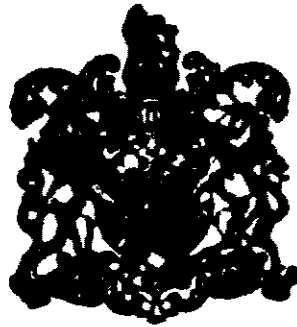

[Subject.—Annual Report.]

I have the honour to submit my Annual Report on the working of Joint Stock Companies in Bombay for the year ending 31st March 1922 together with the Statements Nos. I to X prescribed by the Government of India. A list of Private Companies has been appended to this Report and marked A. The classification of companies in the statements has been made in accordance with the Orders Nos. 2835 and 7658 dated 8th June 1920 and 1st November 1920 of the Government of India. As desired therein "Number on the Register" assigned to each company has been shewn; the new scheme of filing having been partially introduced. The operations under the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act VI of 1912 and the Societies registered under the Provident Insurance Societies Act V of 1912 and the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 are, as usual, dealt with in the Report.

The Indian Companies Act, VII of 1913.

2. The number of Companies registered during the year was 92 as compared with 180 in the preceding year. Of these 87 companies are limited by shares and 5 limited by guarantee having no share capital. The former comprise 41 public and 46 private companies. One public share capital company "The Commercial Trading Company, Limited" was restored on the Register under the orders of the Court and added to the list. A table showing the classification of the companies registered during the last three years is given below:—

3. The decrease in the number of new public companies is very pronounced. I attribute it mainly to the general trade depression which must hamper the commencement of new enterprises but an additional factor is probably the reaction of the investing public consequent to the failure of many of the unstable companies floated during the boom of 1919-20, coupled with the tightness of money and the heavy fall in the stock exchange values of shares. Sound enterprises backed by names which the public knows would still appear to be able to draw subscriptions; but the company promoters who were so active in 1920 appear to have found the year under review unfavourable for approaching the public.

As regards Private Companies it will be noticed that there is no corresponding decrease though the total is lower than the preceding year. The trade depression probably has the effect of keeping the number of private companies up as when in favourable times a partnership is satisfactory in times of stress the advantage of limited liability is more carefully considered. The incidence of taxation is a contributory cause to the number of private companies.

4. The number of companies that went into liquidation during the year was 37 as compared with 57 in the previous year. Of these four were ordered to be wound up by Courts and thirty-three went into voluntary liquidation.

5. All documents and papers of "Hanslux, Limited," "Ex-Soldiers Society of India and Burma," and "Venus Provident Insurance Society, Limited" were transferred under orders of Courts in accordance with the provisions of section 15 of the Act, to the Registrars of Joint Companies, Central Provinces, and Delhi. The first two were old companies and the last one a fresh concern. The first one is a share capital company and the last two are guarantee companies. These companies were removed from the registers and have been deducted from the list.

6. Twenty-eight companies were dissolved during the year. Of these three were completely wound up by Court and 11 by liquidators and 14 were struck off the registers under section 217.

7. The total number of companies working at the close of the year was according to the registers 933, of which 726 were public and 185 private share capital companies and the remaining 22 were companies limited by guarantee and not having a share capital; but it is probable that these figures include a number of abortive companies floated during the boom period which will have shortly to be dealt with under section 217.

8. Of the 88 new share capital flotations 43 were private companies having Authorised Capital of Rs. 12,83,61,000 and 42 public with Nominal Capital of Rs. 3,93,70,000.

9. Sixteen old companies increased their Nominal Capital by Rs. 1,75,22,150 as against 21 companies with an increase of Rs. 1,01,79,000 in the year preceding.

10. The returns received from companies show that the subscribed and paid up capital has been increased by Rs. 47,04,72,745, and Rs. 24,76,93,172 as against Rs. 38,76,77,520 and Rs. 18,02,73,948 respectively in the previous year.

11. Sixteen companies reduced their capital during the year. The total reductions in the authorised, subscribed and paid up capital amounted to Rs. 43,30,000, Rs. 29,08,020 and Rs. 51,758 as against reductions of Rs. 2,25,000, Rs. 18,51,325 and Rs. 5,22,027 in the preceding year. The Authorised, Subscribed and Paid-up Capital of the companies that went into liquidation, wound up by court and struck off the registers was Rs. 21,32,45,000, Rs. 71,61,955 and Rs. 44,87,589 respectively.

12. The result of the years working is a net decrease of Rs. 3,23,18,850 in the Authorised capital of companies and a net increase of Rs. 46,04,01,770 and Rs. 24,31,53,825 respectively in the subscribed and paid up capital. The aggregate capital—Authorised, subscribed and paid up—of all the companies was at the close of the year Rs. 2,82,50,58,898, Rs. 1,44,41,86,410 and Rs. 83,18,93,012 respectively, which shows an improvement in the proportion of subscribed and paid up capital to the authorised capital.

Alteration in the number of Members.

13. Out of 5 companies, limited by guarantee three were registered with 970 members and two with unlimited number of members. A new company "Venus Provident Insurance Society, Limited" having 20 members was as stated in paragraph 5 transferred to Delhi and consequent reduction of 20 members took place. The number of members at the beginning of the year was 13,662 which with 950 above rose to 13,612.

Conversion of Companies.

14. The Ruby Mills, Limited, availed of the provisions of section 154 and was converted into a public company.

Change of Name.

15. The subjoined is a list showing the names of companies which changed their names under section 11 of the Act with the approval of Government:—

Branch Registers.

16. The provisions of section 41 of the Act in respect of British Registers were not availed of by any company.

Auditors.

17. The number of Auditors was increased by 5. There were thus 26 holders of permanent unrestricted certificates, 30 holders of permanent and 8 of temporary restricted certificates.

Foreign Companies.

18. Sixteen companies incorporated outside British India filed their papers under section 277. A list of these is given in this report in Appendix B.

Indian Life Assurance Companies Act.

19. There has been no change in the number of Life Assurance Companies working in this province. A list of the papers received from the Government of India under section 27 is contained in Appendix C.

Provident Insurance Societies Act.

20. The Bharatkhand Insurance and Industrial Company, Limited, got its rules registered under the Act. The Venus Insurance Society which was registered prior to the registration of the Venus Provident Insurance Society, Limited, will apparently cease to operate the mother company being transferred to Delhi. There being no provision in the Act for the transfer the Society presumably stands on the register. A list of the existing Societies is appended and marked D.

Societies Registration Act.

21. The number of societies registered under this Act was 18 as compared with 22 in the year preceding. A list of these Societies is given in appendix E.

General.

22. The documents registered during the year are classified and compared with those in the previous year in the following table:—

23. The old companies have mostly realised their responsibilities under the Act; but there has been noticeable a pronounced desire on the part of many of them to put off the preparation and publication of accounts. Possibly the exceptionally bad year may account for this; but at any rate I have been frequently asked for an extension of time. A number of infringements of the Act were detected and warnings given. Amongst the new companies there appears misapprehension as to the interpretation of the words "year" and "interval of fifteen months" in sections 76 and 131 owing to the wording of sections 77, 76 and 32. This has resulted in delay in presenting returns. Returns of allotments head the list in falling off which is attributable to (1) the less number of new floatations (2) misunderstanding on the part of private companies which often consider themselves exempt from compliance with this provision of law and (3) inability of companies to secure public confidence for subscription of shares.

Financial Results.

21. The revenue on account of fees realised under the various Acts as detailed in statement X amounted to Rs. 55,297-12-0 exclusive of the sum of Rs. 297-3-0 shown in paragraph 23 of the last year's report against Rs. 1,11,299-3-6 in the preceding year. Contrast of the realisations of the two years classified under different heads is made in the following table;—

25. The decrease under head 1 is due to the fewer registrations. Sale of forms shows a good deal of decrease and is due to the delay in the supply of fresh stock, particularly of form E. by the Press which caused some big concerns to print them off for themselves.

26. The expenditure of the office amounted to Rs. 37,929-1-7, against Rs. 32,465-2-11 in the previous year. The details are given below in a tabular form.
