Subject.—*Annual Report.*

SIR,

I have the honour to submit the Annual Report on the working of the Joint Stock Companies for the year ending 31st March 1923. The Returns Nos. I to X prescribed by the Government of India are appended to the Report and the statistics relating to Private Companies have in accordance with the instructions of the Director of Statistics been shown separately in each statement. The Report also deals with Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1860, the Provident Insurance Societies Act, V of 1912 and the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, VI of 1912.

2. I was on leave from 26th April to 17th November 1922 during which period Mr. H. H. Wadia, M.A., Bar.-at-Law, held the charge of the office of the Registrar of Companies. I took charge from him on 18th November 1922.

The Indian Companies Act, VII of 1913.

3. During the the year under report 71 new Companies were registered as compared with 93 in the year preceding. Of these 70 are limited by shares and one limited by guarantee. The former comprise 21 Public and 49 Private Companies. Twenty-one Public Companies include two Companies, *viz.*—"The Central Provinces Portland Cement Company, Limited" and "The Hume Pipe and Concrete Construction Company (India), Limited" transferred from the Province of Bengal to this Presidency. The above 49 Private Companies include one Company, limited by shares "The Moon Automobile Company, Limited" which was in voluntary liquidation and was restored to the Register by Court's Order and also one Private Company "The Porcupine Foundry Company, Limited" which was transferred from the Province of Bengal to this Province. The details in respect of these Companies are shown in Statement No. II.

5. The decrease in the number of new Public Companies even compared with last year's depressed total is very noticeable. I attribute this decrease to the factors mentioned last year, *viz.*, general trade depression, depressed stock exchange prices and reaction caused by the failures which followed the boom of 1919-20; but the extensive market manipulations of certain large operators in Bombay and the crash that resulted from their efforts to effect "corners" still further frightened the investing public and great reluctance is displayed to invest in industrial securities, investors apparently preferring the good and certain yield now obtainable from Government Loans. In addition it will be noticed from figures given below that over Rs. 16 crores of capital was paid up during the year to Companies already in existence which naturally restricted the amount of capital available for new concerns.

As regards Private Companies it will be noticed that there is a slight increase. Some of the new Companies are undoubtedly due to the incidence of taxation but the attraction of limited liability when so many businesses have failed is responsible for others.

6. Of the 70 new Companies the 21 Public Companies had a nominal capital of Rs. 3,34,76,000 and the 49 Private Companies, a nominal capital of Rs. 4,59,69,550.

7. Sixty-eight Companies were dissolved during the year as compared with 28 in the previous year. I am still dealing with the derelicts of the boom and no less than 45 Companies were struck off the Register as defunct under Section 247. Sixteen Companies in liquidation at the commencement of the year were finally wound up and 7 which went into liquidation during the year completed their winding up.

8. Two other Companies were removed from the Register on transfer to other Provinces, viz.—“The Prem Spinning and Weaving Company, Limited” transferred to the United Provinces and “The Peninsular Locomotive Company, Limited” transferred to Bihar and Orissa.

9. Sixty-nine Companies went into liquidation during the year as against 37 last year; of these 54 were Voluntary liquidations and 15 were ordered to be wound up by the Court.

10. The total number of Companies working at the close of the year was according to the Registers 888 of which 659 were Public, 206 Private and remaining 23 limited by Guarantee and not having a share capital.

11. Eleven Companies increased their authorised capital by Rs. 1,10,65,000 as against 16 Companies with an increase of Rs. 1,75,22,150 in the preceding year.

12. The returns received from Companies during the year show an increase of subscribed and paid up capital by Rs. 7,78,28,240 and Rs. 16,47,06,262 as against Rs. 47,04,72,745 and Rs. 24,76,93,172 respectively in the previous year.

13. Sixteen Companies reduced their capital during the year. The total reductions in the authorised, subscribed and paid up capital amounted to Rs. 6,00,000, Rs. 17,47,582 and Rs. 18,91,071, as against reductions of Rs. 43,30,000, Rs. 29,06,020 and Rs. 51,758 in the preceding year. The authorised, subscribed and paid up capital of Companies that went into liquidation, wound up by Courts, struck off the Register and transferred to other Provinces was Rs. 37,67,34,584, Rs. 4,49,23,919 and Rs. 1,73,04,240 respectively.

14. The result of the year's working shows a net decrease of Rs. 28,68,24,034 in the authorised capital of the Companies and net increase of Rs. 3,11,56,739 and Rs. 14,55,10,951 respectively in the subscribed and paid up capital. The aggregate capital authorised, subscribed and paid up of all the Companies was at the close of the year Rs. 2,53,82,34,864, Rs. 1,47,53,43,149 and Rs. 97,74,03,063 respectively. The decrease in the authorised capital is attributable to the striking off under Section 247 of some of the Companies with a large amount of authorised capital which were floated in the boom year. Amongst the 116 Companies removed from the Register there were 6 Companies with a combined authorised capital of Rs. 21,50,00,000. The increase in the proportion of subscribed and paid up capital to authorised capital is satisfactory.

Alteration in the number of members.

15. One Company limited by guarantee was registered with 100 members during the year. The number of members at the beginning of the year was 13,612 which with 100 above rose to 13,712.

Conversion of Companies.

16. Two Public Companies, viz.—“The Japan Imports, Limited” and “The Limaye Brothers, Limited” converted themselves into Private Companies by means of Special Resolutions. No Private Company, however, converted itself into a Public Company under Section 154 (1) of the Act.

Change of name.

Branch Registers.

18. The provisions of Section 41 of the Act in respect of British registers were not availed of by any Companies.

Auditors.

19. Ten persons were granted unrestricted certificates during the year. One holder of an unrestricted certificate and one of a restricted certificate died during the year under report and their names were removed from the list. The name of one restricted certificate holder was removed from that list and added to that of the unrestricted certificate holders. There were thus 35 holders of permanent unrestricted certificates, 28 holders of permanent and 8 of temporary restricted certificates at the close of the year.

Compliance with the provisions of Section 136.

20. The reports of the Assistant Registrars of Joint Stock Companies who were requested to make enquiries in the matter show that the provisions of Section 136 of the Act were complied with during the year by the limited, banking and other Companies working in their Districts to which the provisions of the Section apply.

Foreign Companies.

21. During the year 20 Companies incorporated outside British India established their places of business in this Presidency as against 16 in the previous year and filed documents under section 277 of the Act. A list of these Companies is given in Appendix B. Three Companies, *viz.*—"J. Murray & Company, Limited," "National Benefit Life and Property Assurance Company, Limited," and "Ultra Marine Trading Company, Limited" having ceased their business in this Presidency were removed from the Register. The total number of Companies standing at the close of the year was 275.

Indian Life Assurance Companies Act.

22. No Company was registered or went into liquidation during the year. A list of Companies existing at the end of the year is given in Appendix C. A list of papers received from the Government of India under section 27 is contained in Appendix D.

Prudential Insurance Societies Act.

23. There has been no change in the number of Societies registered under the Act. A list of the existing Societies is appended and marked E.

Societies Registration Act.

24. The number of Societies registered under this Act was 15 as compared with 13 in the preceding year. A list of these Societies is given in Appendix F.

General.

25. The following table shows the number of documents registered during the year. They are classified and compared with those in the previous year:—

26. The majority of Companies in this Province are now more familiar with the provisions of the Act and there is some improvement in the filing of documents in this office. Companies are now fairly punctual in registering particulars of Mortgages under section 109. There still exists some misapprehension about the interpretation of the interval of 14 days between the two meetings as required by section 82 (2) (b) of the Act and I had to draw their attention to English Cases on the point and to return many Resolutions in which the interval was not the clear fourteen days. I had also to return many Returns of Allotments as they had not been presented within the time prescribed therefore by section 104 and ask the Companies to get the time extended by Courts.

Financial Results.

27. During the year under report the revenue from fees amounted to Rs. 40,358-0-9 against Rs. 55,297-12-0 in the preceding year. Comparison of the realisations of the two years classified under different heads is shown in the following table :—

28. The increase in revenue under items 18 and 19 is due to more applications made by the Public for searching the records of the Companies which is a satisfactory feature. The facilities offered by this office for ascertaining a Company's position are beginning to be appreciated.
