REPORT
ON THE WORKING OF THE
CO-OPERATIVE CREDIT SOCIETIES
IN COORG

For the year ending 30th June 1911.

I.—ADMINISTRATION AND TOURING.

There was no change in the administration. The office of Registrar was held by me in addition to that of Deputy Director, Land Records and Agriculture and Settlement Officer; my staff consisted of only one clerk. During my tours I attended Committee meetings of all societies and whenever I met Committee members discussed with them the affairs connected with the management of their societies. I also attended the Fifth Conference of Registrars at Allahabad in January last.

II.—SUMMARY OF GENERAL PROGRESS.

2. Before proceeding with this report it is necessary to remark that the statements attached to it are distinguished as Imperial and Provincial, the latter as appendices which refer to purely local interest.
3. Although there has been no canvassing for new members the progress was satisfactory: four societies were registered, during the year, and 262 members were enrolled, and the total number of members is now four times that of 1906, the year in which the business was started (Appendix A).

III.—WORKING OF SOCIETIES.

4. In this province there are only rural societies, of which 13 are with limited and 9 with unlimited liabilities. All members are shareholders, and the value of the shares vary from Rs. 10 to Rs. 20 for the different societies. These shares have to be paid up in five annual instalments. In the older societies where the shares have been fully paid up, they are at premium from 5 to 30 per cent. of the value of the original share (vide Appendix B).

5. *Dividends.*—Profits are in the first instance credited to the reserve fund, and after that fund has reached 25 per cent. of the aggregate capital, each member is entitled to a dividend for the share or shares he holds. In the older societies dividends are now paid, but one-fourth of the annual profit is transferred to the existing reserve fund. The dividends this year amounted to Rs. 1,626-12-0, and ranged from 6½ to 15 per cent. per share (vide Appendix C). This sum has been credited towards new shares.

6. *Business transacted.*—The business consisted of cash loans only to members for agricultural purposes, liquidation of debts and other objects. The amount distributed aggregated Rs. 51,668, of which Rs. 34,699-2-1, Rs. 7,672-5-11 and Rs. 4,878-1-9 respectively are recoverable in 1912 and thereafter; the balance has been repaid during the year. The recovery has been good on the whole, the outstandings being 10 per cent. of the total amount lent (Appendix D). In a few societies too lenient a treatment was accorded to the defaulters during the year, but prompt measures will be taken against them next year. All societies worked with a profit.

7. *Loans.*—The number of loans granted was 1,209, of which 998 were for sums under Rs. 50, 189 for sums below 100 and 22 for sums exceeding Rs. 100 (Appendix E). The by-law requiring loans to be repaid after one year has been modified: the repayment is now to be made by annual instalments according to a graduated scale.

8. *Interest charged.*—The interest charged on money lent was 10 to 12½ per cent. while 5 to 6½ per cent. was paid for money borrowed by the societies.

9. *Management.*—There was very little change in the managing body, indeed several gentlemen have now continued to hold the office of President, Committee member or Controller for the last seven years; and the societies to which they belong are most fortunate to have men of such long experience at the head of their affairs.

10. *Committee meetings.*—Particular attention was paid this year to Committee meetings, which were regularly held and in some societies exceeded the number required by the by-law (Appendix F). Copies of all proceedings are sent to me and I am glad to observe that, with few exceptions, I found them all business like.

IV.—RESERVE FUND.

11. As may be seen from Appendix G, the total reserve fund now amounts to Rs. 10,750-1-9 and this represents 21 per cent. of the aggregate capital. In nine societies it varies from 25 to 35 per cent., and in the others from 4 to 23 per cent. Of the reserve Rs. 7,739-14-8 are invested in Government securities which are kept in the District Treasury, and the balance, which is utilized in the business of societies, will in due course be also invested. I may remark here that the Committees formerly dissented with my proposal that the reserve fund should be kept in a tangible form and out of reach of every one, but I think they all now agree that this is the correct way of disposing of it. It is true that we get only 3½ per cent. interest from Government, but the small profit, realised from the interest weighs little against the financial security which is obtained by a substantial reserve fund.

V.—RESOURCES.

12. The chief source of raising money is by shares and this amounts to Rs. 26,361; next to this come deposits and debentures amounting to Rs. 20,433 and the Government loan amounting to Rs. 4,867 (*vide Appendix H*). The money raised by shares is the net savings of the members themselves due to their thrift; while the deposits and debentures belong chiefly to wealthy and sympathetic land owners of whom Messrs. Apparanda Chengappa, D. Chennabasappa Shetty, Hanumayya, Gijagana Devayya, Mukkati Iyappa, D. Venkatramana Shetty, C. Madayya, R.B., Arekaribashetty, Kalhalli Siddabasappa and Uddur Chandrapappa Shetty deserve special mention. These gentlemen have greatly contributed towards the confidence in the co-operative movement in Coorg by lending money at a low interest and by adding their names to the list of members.

VI.—DISPUTES AND LITIGATION.

13. There have been 29 cases of litigation, and they have all been satisfactorily settled without any loss. Such proceedings have in no way affected the reputation of the societies, and it is noteworthy that most of the persons concerned have asked to be reinstated as members.

VII.—AUDIT AND INSPECTION.

14. All accounts have been audited by me, in some cases twice, during the year. In addition to this revenue officials have also very kindly given the most valuable assistance by checking the cash balance monthly. The Committee members and Controllers also check the accounts at every meeting.

VIII.—ACTS, RULES AND BY-LAWS.

15. Under section 27 of the Act, the Honourable the Chief Commissioner was pleased to make rules on the following subjects:—

- (a) On the working of the Co-operative Credit Societies in Coorg. Notification No. 27, dated 27th April 1905.
- (b) Conditions for the grant of Government loans. Notification No. 65, dated Bangalore, 30th September 1905.
- (c) Rules referring to disputes in respect of business. Notification No. 97, dated Bangalore, 21st December 1906.
- (d) Additional rules referring to disputes in respect of business. Notification No. 72, dated 17th August 1908.
- (e) Amendment in the rules for the working of the Co-operative Credit Societies in Coorg, Notification No. 61, dated 26th July 1909.
