NORTHERN DIVISION

I. NUMBER OF ESTATES UNDER MANAGEMENT.

There was no estate under management under the Guardians and War s Act during the year under reference.

There were no minors' estates under the management of the Collectors in this division under the Guardians and Wards Act during the year 1946-47.

· SOUTHERN DIVISION

There was only one estate, i.e., Beleri estate. No new estates were taken under management during the year under report.

II. INCOME.

Total gross income realized during the year was Rs. 44,594-7-2 as against Rs. 5,127-2-0 of the previous year. The gross income includes Rs. 39,800 realized on account of securities matured during the year.

Nil.


IN. Payment of Debts and Existing Liabilities. The estate is free from debt and other liabilities.

X. Civil suit.

A money decree for Rs. 575 + court cost was obtained against one Mr. L. D. Patil of Betigeri, and darkhast proceedings were started. An area of 4 acres and 18 gunthas was purchased. The judgment-debtor did not hand over the possession of the decretal property, as there was defect in the auction sale and also in the sale certificate issued by the Court. A civil suit for possession and partition has been filed in the Civil Court, Junior Division, Gadag.

XI. General Remarks.
