To the Hon. Hugh Guthrie, K.C., P.C., Minister of Justice.

Honourable Sir,—I have the honour to submit reports and statistics regarding the administration of penitentiaries for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1931.

The number of inmates in custody at the close of the fiscal year was 3,714, as compared with 3,187 at the beginning of the year. The average daily population was 3,434.
