Sir,

I have the honour to submit the following report on the working of the Indian Companies Act VI of 1882 in Bombay for the year 1912-13, together with the ten statements in the forms prescribed by the Government of India. Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 and those to which the Provident Insurance Societies Act V of 1912 and Companies to which the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act VI of 1912 applies are also included in the report.

2. Forty-three new Companies with share Capital were registered during the year. No Company either without limited liability or with liability limited by guarantee was registered during the year under report. The Bombay Brush Manufacturing Company, Limited, which was under liquidation, has been revived under the orders of the Court. It has, therefore, been removed from the list of the Companies under liquidation and added to that of the new Companies in Statement No. II.

3. Below is the statement showing comparison between the different kinds of documents registered during the years 1912-13 and the year 1911-12:—

From the above, it will be seen that there is a decrease under "Notices of Situation etc." which is apparently due to the lesser number of changes in the addresses of the Companies. The decreases under other heads are minor and call for no explanation. The increase under "Returns under the Societies Act" is noticeable and due to the persistent calls made therefor. Under the head "Miscellaneous" there is an increase which can be ascribed to the larger number of agreements under section 28 registered. The increase under other heads is due to ordinary fluctuations.

4. Subjoined is a classified list of Companies limited by shares registered during the year under report and the preceding year :—

The table above exhibits a substantial increase in Mills and Presses. This is due to the improvement in the result of the working of this industry in the past year and to the confidence produced by the proposed legislation in the Companies Act by which the public expect that their interests will be better watched and safeguarded. The decrease under "Banking and Loan" can be explained by the large number registered in the previous year which to a certain extent removed a scope for further expansion in this direction.

5. Twenty-six Companies went into liquidation during the year under report as compared with 35 in the previous year and, excepting 3, all are in the course of liquidation. The three Companies referred to above were finally dissolved in the same year. Of the Companies that were under liquidation on 31st March 1912, sixteen have also completed their winding up and were fully dissolved. Two Companies limited by guarantee were also taken into liquidation.

6. At the close of the year 1912-13 there were in the aggregate 615 working Companies. Of these 593 were Companies limited by shares with a nominal capital of Rs. 52,34,96,900, a nominal issued capital of Rs. 32,29,64,217, paid up capital of Rs. 27,47,01,104 as compared with 575 Companies with a nominal capital of Rs. 46,68,45,750, nominal issued capital of Rs. 31,06,81,686 and paid up capital of Rs. 26,78,52,519. The number of Companies limited by guarantee at the end of the year was 22 as compared with 24 at the close of the previous year, but as the two Companies that went into liquidation were Companies with unlimited number of members, there was no change in the number of members in the year as compared with the previous year, which was 16,765.

7. One hundred and fifteen Companies increased their capital, either nominal or subscribed or both. The aggregate increase in capital in nominal was Rs. 2,32,90,000, in the issued nominal Rs. 1,76,60,140 and in paid up Rs. 1,21,92,531.

8. There were 12 Companies that reduced their Capital. The reduction in the nominal capital was Rs. 10,50,100, in issued nominal Rs. 12,39,194 and in paid up Rs. 20,52,601 against 17 Companies with a reduction in nominal capital of Rs. 8,50,000, issued nominal Rs. 3,25,070 and paid up capital Rs. 73,305 in the year preceding.

9. The total receipts of this office from all sources amounted to Rs. 24,923-6-0 against Rs. 17,347-4-0 in the preceding year showing an increase of Rs. 7,576-2-0. The following table shows the different kinds of heads under which fees were realised in the years 1912-13 and 1911-12 :—

It will be observed from the above statement that the most noticeable increase is under new Companies and Societies and is due to the increase in the registration in the number of Companies with large capital and Societies under Act XXI of 1860. The increase under "Special Resolutions" is due to the increase in capital of the existing Companies. Other items of increases are minor and require no remarks. The decrease under "Other documents and copies" is due to the lesser number of such documents being filed and to the less demand of copies respectively. This head is liable to fluctuation.

10. The expenditure of the office amounted to Rs. 2,247-8-0 against Rs. 2,324-15-0 in the preceding year.

11. In two cases action was taken for non-compliance with the provisions of section 69 of the Act. One Company was convicted and the other acquitted as the Company proved that it carried no business.

12. The offices of Companies referred to in section 69 were examined and all of them, except the two above referred to, were found to comply with the requirements mentioned in sections 65 and 69.

Act IV of 1900.

13. No advantage has yet been taken by any Company of the provisions to the above Act.

The Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860.

14. The following are the 14 Societies registered during the year as against 7 in the preceding year :—

This Act requires that these Societies do file annually in this office the lists of their Governing bodies, but as the Act prescribes no penalty for defaults, in very many cases these returns were secured only after several reminders. There is no provision under which these Societies have to file their annual accounts in this office, but as they are corporate bodies and in some cases have money transactions with the public it may be desirable that these Societies should file their accounts or Balance sheets like the Joint Stock Companies, and a provision to the above effect may be legislated for.

The Indian Life Assurance Companies Act (No. VI of 1912).

15. So far only one Company, *viz.* The China Mutual Life Insurance Company, Limited, has complied with the provisions of section 19 and filed its papers in this office.

16. Only one Company, by name "The Crown Insurance Company, Limited," was registered under the Indian Companies Act after making the deposit required under section 4.

17. There were 14 Life Assurance Companies. Of these 5 Companies have, I understand, made deposits with the Comptroller General. Some, it appears, are trying to deposit the amount required by section 4, while others will go in liquidation owing to their inability to make the required deposit.

The Provident Insurance Societies Act (No. V of 1912).

19. Three applications were received for registration under section 6. Of these 2 are Societies started by a single person and one by an incorporated body of persons who have by special resolution amended their Memorandum of Association to enable the opening of a Provident Fund, but this Company has failed to obtain the sanction of the High Court as required by section 8 of the Indian Companies (Memorandum of Association) Act XII of 1895. The applications in question are awaiting disposal pending the publication of the rules under section 24 of the Act.

20. There was registered under the Indian Companies Act one Company by name "The Pioneer Assurance Company, Limited". It is a Society under this Act and has not submitted its rules, nor has it applied under section 6 for its registry. I understand that it has not yet started work.

21. The attention of the Companies that fall within the provisions of the Act was drawn to sections 6 and 7 but they have more or less disregarded the law. Such steps as may be found necessary will be taken against them as soon as the rules under section 24 are finally published.
