PREFATORY NOTE

AT the invitation of the organisers of the Extension Lectures of the Mysore University I agreed to deliver at Bangalore and afterwards at Mysore three lectures on the life and work of my master G. K. Gokhale. They were actually delivered in the beginning of 1935. Mysore I did not exactly repeat what I had said at Bangalore, but varied the matter considerably. Bangalore Press, which undertook to publish lectures in book form, entrusted the editing to my friend Mr. A. V. Ramaswami.
