# Preface

The essays brought together in this volume touch upon certain important figures and aspects of the nationalist movement in India in the closing years of the nineteenth and first half of the twentieth century. Some of them were contributed to seminars: on the partition of India convened by the London School of Oriental and African Studies; on Gandhi, by the American Association of Asian Studies: and on 'Socialism in India' by the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, New Delhi. Friends, whose opinions I value, feel that these papers, though originally written for fellow historians, would be of interest to a wider audience. 'Gokhale's Year of Decision' appeared in the Journal of Indian History in 1965. The 'Social Thought of Gokhale' was the text of a lecture delivered during the following year. The biographical sketches of Gokhale and Motilal Nehru were occasioned by their centenaries. 'Jawaharlal Nehru as a Writer' is an amplified version of an article contributed to the Hindustan Times in 1966.

Though these essays vary in their origins, they pertain to a period in which I have had a long-standing interest; indeed, they are by-products of larger projects. They will, I hope, be of interest not only to students of Indian nationalism, but also to the general reader. The men and events discussed in this book are not really so remote from our times, nor are they so unconnected with each other as they may appear to be at first sight. The Gandhi-Nehru partnership exercised a momentous influence on the course of Indian history. The partition of India was a traumatic experience for the people of the Indian sub-continent, the understanding of which should have a liberating effect on the minds of men. Gandhi, Gokhale and the Nehrus were contemporaries, who had not a little to do with each other. The two Nehrus and Gokhale, with their rational and secular outlook, should be of special interest to a generation still struggling to shake off the burden of the past.

I must acknowledge my debt of gratitude to the India Office Library for use of the papers of Lords Hamilton, Elgin, Curzon, Lansdowne and Morley; to the National Archives of India for the Gokhale Papers; to the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library for the Nehru Papers; and to the Gandhi Memorial Museum for the Gandhi Papers.
