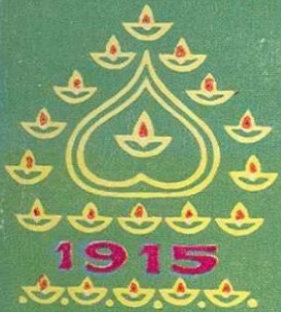

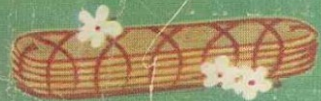

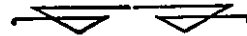

# FOREWORD

The GIPA Jubilee Committee has much pleasure in offering to the public this Souvenir of the completion of fifty years since the formation of the nucleus of the Gokhale Institute of Public Affairs, Bangalore, and twenty years since its consolidation in a developed working form on a permanent basis. Its history is outlined in an article in this publication (pages 55 to 91).

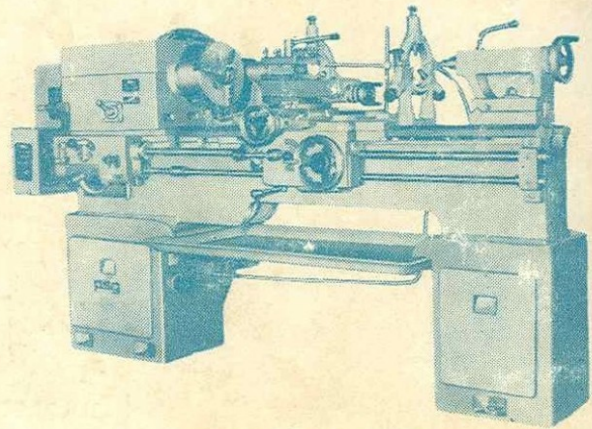
