FREFACE

This volume on District Educational Statistics for the Union Threitory of Fondicherry, is the first in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the States and Union Territories. The main saim is to highlight the inter-district variations in a State by giving educational data at district levels with the help of some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentages of trained teachers, per capita expenditure, teacher pupil ratio etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have widehed or narrowed down with time the data for the year 1976-77 has been analysed and compared with that for the year 1970-71.

I take this opportunity to express my appreciation of the co-operation required from the Director of Education, Fondicherry and the Project staff of the Flanning, Monitoring and Statistics Division who have prepared this report.

A final figures of expenditure on education were not available only grovisional figures or expenditure have been given throughout this publication.

INTRODUCTION

- Regional imbalances do exist in the field of Educational Development just as in urbanisation, industrialization distribution of income & wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector; the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare brings out "Educational Statistics: District-wise! Quinquennially.
- 2. A Volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. Thereafter it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each State every five year by the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry.
- 3. For making inter-district comparisions possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers and per capita expenditure on education have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and hence the need for formulating educational plans at the district-level.

II- AREA AND POPULATION

- The Union Territory of Pondicherry consists of four districts viz. Pondicherry, Keraikal Mahe and Yanam. One of the specific features of this Union Territory is that the four districts are not contiguous, in fact they appear enclaves in these different States, Tamil Nadu, Kerala & Andhra. The total area of the Territory is 480 sq.km. The area of different districts varies from 290 sq.km. (Pondicherry) to merely 9 sq.km. (Mahe).
- The total population of the State in 1971 was 4.71 lakhs consisting of 2.37 lakh males and 2.34 lakh females. By 1977 the population of the territory is estimated to have increased

to 5.48 lakhs of which 2.76 lakh were males and 2.72 lakh females. The population of the different districts in 1977 varied very much. The population was the highest in Pondicherry with 3.95 lakhs followed by Karaikal with 1.16 lakhs, Mahe with 0.27 lakhs and Yanam with 0.10 lakhs.

6. The density of population per sq.km. for the Union Territory of Fondicherry increased from 981 in 1971 to 1,141 in 1977. The density of population also varied very much among the districts In 1977, the density was highest in Mahe(2,989) followed by Fondicherry (1,362), Karaikal (720) and Yanam (485). Table No. 1 gives the general view of the extent of variation in the area, population and density of population.

- 7. Of the total population in the Territory in 1977, the population in the age-group 6-11 was 71 thousands, consisting of 37 thousand boys and 34 thousand girls. The children in this age-group formed 13.0% of the total regulation of the Territory.
- 8. The population in the age-group 11-14 : in 1977 in the Territory was 41 thousand consisting of 21 thousand boys and 20 thousand girls forming 7.4% of the total population.

- 9. Similarly, the population in the age-group 14-17 in 1977 was 36 thousands consisting of 18 thousand boys and 18 thousand girls. The population in this age-group formed 6.6% of the total population.
- 10. Thus of the total population of 5.48 lakhs of the Union Territory, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 yrs. was 1.48 lakhs which consisting of 75 thousand boys and 73 thousand girls. The population in the age-group 6-17 accounted for 27.0% of the total population. Among the males it formed 27.2% while among the females it formed 26.9%.

III - LITERACY

- 11. Accordingly to the 1971 census the effective liberacy rate that is number of liberates per hundred of the population excluding the age-group 0-4 in the Union Territory was 53.3. This literacy rates for males and females were 66.5 and 40.0 respectively.
- 12. Among the districts, the literacy rate was the highest in Mahe(77.7), followed by Pondicherry (52.2), Karaikal (51.6) and Yanam (50.7).

IV - GENERAL VIEW

INSTITUTIONS:

13. The total number of educational institutions in the Union Territory of Pondicherry increased from 505 to 533 during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. Thus there was an increase of 5.5% during the period of 6 years. In 1976-77 Pondicherry had the largest share of institutions (67.9%) followed by Karaikal (25.5%) Mahe (3.8%) and Yanam (3.2%).

ENROLL T.T:

The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions in the Union Territory in 1970-71 increased from 91 thousands to 1.19 lakhs in a span of 6 years(1970-71 to 1976-77). The increase in enrolment is observed in all the districts. Among the districts the increase in enrolment among the boys as well as girls was the highest in Mahe. The table No. 2 gives the percentage increase in enrolment of boys and girls in different districts for the period 1970-71 to 1976-77.

16. The total enrolment in all the educational institutions in 1970-71 formed 19.4% of the total ropulation of the Union Territory. By 1976-77 this figure changed to 21.7%.

The percentage of girls which in 1970-71 was 39.2 increased to 40.8 in 1976-77.

Among the districts m Mahe had the highest percentage of girls (19.3) followed by Pondicherry (40.5) Karaikal (39.9) and Yanam (39.3).

The highest percentage of the enrolment was in Yanam (30.1) followed by Pondicherry (22.3), Mahe (21.8) and Karaikal (19.0).

EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF S.C. :

17. Extentent of coverage of Scheduled Castes at the Union Territory level was 79.4%. It was the highest in Pondicherry (84.3%), followed by Yanam (69.0%), Karaikal(62.2%) and Mahe (58.3%).

TEACHERS:

- 18. The total number of teachers in educational institutions in the Union Territory increased from 3,583 in 1970-71 to 4,628 in 1976-77, showing the rate of increase as 4.9% peranum. In 1976-77 the percentage of women teachers was 35.7 in the Union Territory. In 1970-71 for every one thousand population the number of teachers were 7.6 and by 1976-77 the same increased to 8.4. In 1976-77 the number of teachers per thousand population was the highest in Yanam (11.1) and the lowest in Karaikal (7.5).
- 19. 92.6% of the School Teachers were trained in 1976-77. This percentage for men teachers was 96.7 and for women teachers 85.5. Among the districts the percentage of trained teachers varied from 91.0 in the district of Pondicherry to 98.0 in Mahe.

EXPENDITURE:

20. The total direct expenditure on all the recognised institutions in the Union Territory has increased by about three times during the period of 6 yrs.(1970-71 to 1976-77). It has increased from 2.22 crores to 6.69 crores during this period. Though

the direct expenditure has increased substantially in all the districts, some districts have recorded more increase than the other districts for example the highest increase in the expenditure was in Yanam, followed by Mahe, Karaikal and Pondicherry.

- 21. The expenditure per institution which was Rs.43,902 in 1970-71 increased to Rs.1,25,428 in 1976-77.
- The direct expenditure per capita was Rs.47.1 in 1970-71. By 1976-77, the direct expenditure for capita increased to Rs.122.1. In 1976-77, the per capita expenditure on education was the highest in the district of Yanam (Rs. 145.2), followed by Pondicherry (Rs.132.1), Mahe (Rs.113.4) and Karaikal (is. 87.8).

V- PRE - PRIMARY EDUCATION

- The number of pre-primary schools in the Union Territory increased from 47 in 1970-71 to 51 in 1976-77. The number of teachers also increased from 60 to 62 during the same period.
- The total enrolment in pre-primary schools decreased from 2,592 in 1970-71 to 2,336 in 1976-77. But there was no decrease in the enrolment of pre-primary classes. The enrolment in pre-primary classes increased from 3,589 (1,868 boys and 1,721 girls) in 1970-71 to 3,944 (1,999 boys and 1,945 girls) in 1970-77. Pondicherry had the highest enrolment of 3,605 followed by Karaikal (324) and Yanam (15). The percentage of girls in pre-primary classes increased from 47.9 in 1970-71 to 49.3 in 1976-77.
- 25. The total direct expenditure on pre-primary schools increased from Rs.1.13 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.4.62 takhs in 1970-77. Among the districts the direct expenditure was the highest in the district of Pondicherry followed by Karaikal and Yanam.

VII - PRIMARY EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS:

- 26. The number of primary schools increased from 259 to 288 in the Territory during the period under consideration. This shows an increase of 11% in 6 years. In 1976-77 Pondicherry had the maximum number of primary schools (183) followed by Karaikal, Yanam and Mahe. The increase was substantial in case of Pondicherry.
- 27. On an average there was a primary school for an area of 1.9 sq.km. in 1970-71 and for every 1.7 sq.km. in 1976-77. Mahe had the most improved position ... where a primary school served on an average for an area of 0.9 sq.km. only.
- 28. On an average the Union Territory had one primary school for every 1,818 people in 1970-71. By 1976-77 this had increased to 1,901. District-wise Details are given in Statement No. 11..
- The total number of Teachers in primary schools in the territory increased from 785 in 1970-71 to 1,054 in 1976-77. During the period under consideration there was an increase in the number of teachers in each district except in Yanam where there was a slight decrease. in the number of teachers.

ENROLMENT:

The total enrolment in primary schools in Pondicherry in 1970-71 was 28,568 which increased to 34,997 in 1976-77. In classes I-V the enrolment which stood at 58,296 in 1970-71 increased to 70,144 by 1976-77. This shows a compound growth rate of 3.1% per annum. The enrolment compound growth rate in these classes was 2.5% in respect of boys and 3.9% in

respect of girls and thus better progress has been recorded in the enrolment of girls.

31. The percentage of girls in 1970-71 was 42.2 and the same rose to 44.1% in 1976-77. The following table gives the enrolment in 1976-77 in classes I-V as a percentage enrolment in 1970-71 and the percentages of girls enrolment in 1976-77.

- 32. The percentage of enrolment in classes I-V to total population in the age-group 6-11 #.e. enrolment ratio " gives an index of achievement in the field of primary education. This enrolment ratio has increased from 95.1 in 1970-71 to 98.5 by 1976-77. For boys it decrease from 109.1 to 106.9 while in case of girls it has increased from 80.9 to 89.6 during the period under consideration. In all the districts, enrolment ratios in respect of girls have improved.

 ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T.:
- 33. Of the total enrolment in classes I-V in 1976-77, 10,530 belonged to Scheduled Costes communities. Of this number 6,409 were boys and 4,121 girls. The percentage of S.C. students

to the total enrolment in classes I-V which stood at 14.7 in 1970-71 increased to 15.0 in 1976-77. Among the boys it remained static at 16.3% while among girls it increased from 12.5% to 13.3%. There is a large variation among the districts in the percentage of scheduled castes students to total enrolment in classes I-V. This is mainly due to the variation in the percentage of scheduled castes population to the total population and also due to the variation in the educational development in different districts. The details are given in Statement No.13. EXPENDITURE:

- 34. The total direct expenditure on primary schools increased four times during the period under consideration. The direct expenditure increased in all the districts. The increase in direct expenditure was the highest in case of Yanam.
- 35. The per capita expenditure on primary schools in the Union Territory in 1970-71 was Rs.5.3 and the same increased to Rs.17.8 in 1976-77. Among the districts, the per capita expenditure on primary schools in 1976-77 varied from Rs.12.8 in Mahe to Rs.43.7 in Yanam.
- 36. The total direct expenditure on primary schools formed 11.3% of the total direct expenditure on education in the Union Territory in 1970-71. By 1976-77 this percentage increased to 14.6 at the Union Territory level. District-wise expenditure on primary schools formed 11.3% in Mahe, 12.8% in Pondicherry, 22.6% in Karaikal and 30.1% in Yanam.
- The average incurred cost per student in primary schools in 1970-71 was Rs.87.7 which increased to Rs.278.9 at the Union Territory level. In the different districts in 1976-77 the cost per student in primary schools varied from Rs.259.9 in Mahe to Rs.291.7 in Yanam. There is a negative correlation between the cost per student and the teacher pupil ratio.

The cost ler student is the highest where the teacher pupil ratio is the lowest. At the Union Territory level the teacher pupil ratio is 33. Among the districts the teacher-pupil ratio varied from 31 in case of Karaikal to 33 in Mahe and 34 in Pondicherry and Yanam. Table No. 4 summarises the position.

VIII- MIDDIE SCHOOL EDUCATION

LISTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS:

- The number of middle school increased from 81 to only 82 during the period under consiteration. While there is an increase in the number of middle schools in the districts of Taraikal and Yanam, there is also a decrease in the number of middle schools in Fondicherry and Mahe. This decrease is not the actual decrease but due to the fact that some of the middle schools were upgraded to the level of secondary schools.
- 39. On an average there was a middle schools in a radius of 5.9 sq.km. The average area served by a middle school has increased not because of the fact the education facilities

have been reduced but because of the fact that middle schools have been upgraded to secondary level.

- 40. For the union territory there was one middle school for a appulation of 5,814 in 1970-71 and by 1976-77 the same has increased to 6,677.
- 41. The total number of teachers in the middle schools increased from 958 in 1970-71 to 1,102 in 1976-77. The increase was in each district except in Mahe where the number of teachers have decreased. Moreover the decrease in Mahe is only due to the upgradation of middle schools and not because of the retrenchment of teachers in Middle Schools.

ENROLMENT:

- 42. The total enrolment in the middle schools in the Union Territory in 1970-71 was 29,354. This increased to 32,934 by 1976-77. In classes VI-VIII, the enrolment changed from 15,885 in 1970-71 to 25,644 by 1976-77. This shows a compound growth rate of 8.1% per annum. The compound growth rate of enrolment in these classes was 8.0% in respect of boys and 8.6% in respect of girls. Taking 1970-71 as the base, the percentage increase in enrolment during the period in these classes in the different districts was the highest in Fondicherry and the lowest in Karaikal.
- 43. The percentage of girls which was 36.4 in 1970-71 rose to 37.2 by 1976-77. In the year 1975-77 the percentage of girls was the highest in Mahe and the lowest in Yanam. The following table gives the enrolment in 1976-77 in classes VI-VIII as a percentage enrolment in 1970-71 and the percentages of girls enrolment in 1976-77.

the percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to total population in the age-group 11-14 i.e. enrolment ratio gives an index of progress for middle stage education. For the Union Territory, as a whole, the enrolment ratio for classes VI-VIII increased from 50.0 to 63.2 during the period. For boys it increased from 63.2 to 78.5 while in the case of girls it recorded an increase from 36.6 to 47.5 during this period. In 1976-77, the enrolment ratio was the highest in Yanam(84.5) followed by Mahe(75.0), Pondicherry (64.2) and Karaikal (54.5).

ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T. :

4. Of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII in 1976-77, 2,435 were scheduled castes consisting of 1,727 boys and 708 girls. The percentage of 5.C. students to the total students in the classes VI-VIII decreased slightly from 9.9% to 9.5%. Among the boys it remained static at 10.7% while among girls it decreased from 8.4% to 7.5%. This shows that a good number of the girls from these communities are not continuing their studies after Primary level.

District-wise details are given in Statement No. 17.

EXPENDITURE:

- 46. The total direct expenditure on middle schools increased from Rs.28.04 lakes to Rs.94.09 during the period under consideration. This shows more than three fold increased during the period of 6 years. There was a substantial increase in direct expenditure in all the districts. The increase was the highest in Yanam district.
- 47. The per capita expenditure on middle schools in the Union Territory in 1970-71 was Rs.6.0 and this increased to Rs.17.2 by 1976-77. <u>District-wise</u> the per capita expenditure varied from Rs.6.7 (Mahe) to Rs.18.8 in Pondicherry.
- 48. The total direct expenditure on middle schools formed 12.6% of the total direct expenditure on education in the Union Territory in 1970-71. By 1976-77 this percentage increased to 14.1. At district level, the percentage of expenditure on middle schools varied from 5.9 (Mahe) to 16.5 (Karaikal).
- 49. The cost per student in middle schools has increased by three times during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. Among the districts, cost-per student was the highest in Karaikal (Rs.394), followed by Yanam (Rs.327), Mahe (Rs.301) and Pondicherry (Rs.268). In case of Middle education also there is a negative co-relation between the cost per student and the teacher-pupil ratio. The teacher-pupil ratio is the lowest where cost per student is the highest. At the Union Territory level the teacher-pupil ratio improved slightly from 31 to 30 during the period under consideration. It district level there was not much variation. It varied from 28 in Karaikal. to 3° in Yanam. Table 6 summarises the position.

VIII- HIGH/ HR. SEC. SCHOOLS

INSTITUTIONS .ND TE.CHERS :

- 50. The number of High/Higher secondary schools in Pondicherry increased from 46 to 65 during the period under review. This shows an increase of 41.3% during a period of 6 years. The highest increase was in Mahe followed by Pondicherry and Karaikal whereas in Yanam there was no increase in the number of schools.
- 51. On the average there was one high school for every 10.4 sq.km.at the Union Territory level in 1970-71. This position improved to 5.4 sq.km. by 1976-77. The average area served by high school varied from 1.5 sq.km. in Mahe to 10 sq.km. in Yanam.
- 52. Because of the increase in the number of schools, the population served by a High/Hr.Sec. school decreased substantially from 10,237 in 1970-71 to 8,423 in 1976-77. Looking at the district level one finds that in 1976-77 the population served by a school of this type varied significantly from 5,873 in Pondicherry to 4,850 in Yanam.

53. The number of teachers in High/Higher Secondary schools increased by about 1.5 times in Union Territory during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. The increase was noticed in each of the districts.

ENROLMENT

the enrolment in High/Hr.sec, schools in Pondicherry was 41,152 in 1976-77 where as the enrolment in classes IX-XI was 12,711 (8,530 boys and 4,181 girls) only. The enrolment in classes IX-XI increased from 8,864 (6,219 Boys and 2,645 girls) in 1970-71 at an annual compound rate of 6.2%. The enrolment in these classes increased in all the districts. Taking 1970-71 as the base, the percentage increase in total enrolment during the period for these classes in different districts was the highest in case of Pondicherry and the lowest in Yanam.

55. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment increased from 29.8 to 32.9 during the said period. In 1976-77 the percentage of girls was the highest in Mahe (47.7) followed by Pondicherry (32.6), Karaikal (31.3) and Yanam (28.6). The following table gives the enrolment in 1976-77 in classes IX-XI as a percentage of enrolment in 1970-71 and the percentages of girls enrolment in 1976-77.

- 56. For the Union Territory the enrolment ratio in classes IX-XI was 31.3 in 1970-71 and this increased to 35.1 by 1976-77. In the case of boys it increased from 44.1 to 46.9 while in the case of girls it recorded an increased from 18.6 to 23.2. In 1976-77, the enrolment ratio was the highest in Yanam (36.4) followed by Pondicherry (36.2), Karaikal (34.5) and Mahe (23.9).

 ENROLMENT OF S.C. IND S.T.:
- Out of the total enrolment in classes IX-XI in 1976-77 there were 938 scheduled castes (691 biys & 247 girls). The percentage of s.c. students to the total students in the classes IX-XI decrease slightly from 7.7% to 9.3% by 1976-77. Among the boys it decreased from 9.1% to 8.1% where as among girls it increased from 4.2% to 5.9% District-wise details can be seen in the statement No. 21.

EXP_NDITURE :

- 58. The total direct expenditure on High/Higher secondary schools increased more than four times from Rs.36.63 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.168.94 lakhs in 1976-77. The increase was in all the districts but it was the highest in pondicherry.
- 79. The per capita expenditure on secondary schools in the Union Territory in 1970-71 was Rs.7.8 and the same increased to Rs.30.9 in 1976-77. Among the districts, the per capita expenditure varied from Rs.27.1 in Pondicherry to Rs.68.4 in Mahe.
- 60. The total direct expenditure on High/Higher secondary schools formed 16.5% of the total direct expenditure on education in the Union Territory in 1970-71. By 1976-77 this percentage increased to 25.3 at the Union Territory level. Among the districts, the percentage of expenditure on High/Higher secondary schools varied from 20.5 in Pondicherry to

60.3 in Mahe.

- 61. The cost per student in High/Higher secondary schools in 1970-71 was Rs.146.0 which increased to 410-5 in 1976-77. Among the districts the cost per student was the highest in Yanam(Rs.574.2) and the lowest in the district of Pondicherry (Rs.376.2).
- 62. The teacher-pupil ratio in 1970-71 was 24 which increased to 27 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 it varied from 23 in Karaikal and Yanam to 29 in Fondicherry.

IX: VOCATIONAL, TROFESSIONAL, SPECIAL & OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

- 63. The number of schools for vocational, professional, special and other education decreased sharply from 62 in 1970-71 to 32 in 1976-77. Of these 32 institutions 24 were in Findicherry and 8 were in Karaikal.
- 64. The total enrolment in vocational classes also decreased from 1,874(1,491 hay and 383 girls) in 1970-71 to 1,436(945 boys and 491 girls) in 1976-77. The number of trackers also decreased from 125 in 1970-71 to only 81 in 1976-77.

65. The total direct expenditure on these institutions increased from Rs.4.03 lakhs in 1976-71 to Rs.7.51 lakhs in 1976-77.

X - HIGHER EDUCATION

DISTITUTIONS .ND TE.CHERS :

- 66. The total number of institutions for Higher Education increased from 9 in 1970-71 to 15 in 1976-77. There was an increase in the number of institutions in all the districts except in Mahe where the number of institutions remained the same. Of the 15 institutions 10 were affiliated, 4 mon-affiliated and one pre-Degree College. Out of the 10 affiliated digree-level colleges, 8 are Arts, Science and Commerce Colleges, one is a Law College and one Medical Colleges. Law and Medical Colleges are in the district of Pondicherry only. Arts, Science, & Commerce colleges are spread over all the districts, Pondicherry having the largest number of colleges followed by Karaikal, Yanam and Mahe.
- 67. The total number of teachers also increased from 623 in 1970-71 to 769 in 1976-77 recording an increase of 23.4%. The number of teachers increased in all the districts recording the highest rise in Yanam followed by Mahe, Karaikal and F ndicherry.

ENRCLMEN1:

68. The enrolment in institutions for higher education in 1976-77 was 6,008. Of the total enrolment there were 4,984 students (3,535 boys and 1,449 girls) studying in the courses of higher education. Of 4,984 students, 37733 were studying in General Education and 1,251 were studying in Professional Education. The enrolment in higher education

increased at an annual rate of 11.3% during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. The corresponding growth rates for boys and girls were 9.7% and 16.2% respectively. Taking 1970-71 as the base, the percentage increase in enrolment during the period in higher education in different districts was the highest in Yanam and the lowest in Karaikal.

69. The percentage of girls which was 24.7 in 1970-71 increased to 29.1 in 1976-77. In the year 1976-77 the percentage of girls was the highest in Mahe (48.7) followed by Pondicherry (27.0), Karaikal (25.3) and Yanam (32.6). The following table gives the enrolment in 1976-77 in higher education as percentage of enrolment in 1970-71 and the percentage of girls enrolment in 1976-77.

ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T. :

70. Of the total enrolment in higher education in 1976-77, 257 belonged to scheduled castes. (191 Boys and 60 girls). The percentage of S.C. students to the total students in higher education which stood at 1.5 in 1970-71 increased to 5.2 by 1976-77. Among the boys

it increased from 1.8 to 5.6 where as among girls it increased from 0.7 to 4.1 District-wise details can be seen in Statement No. 27.

EXFENDITURE:

- 71. The total direct expenditure on higher education institutions increased from Rs.1.26 crores in 1970-71 to Rs.2.96 crores in 1976-77. The increase was 135% at the Union Territory level. A substantial increase was noticed in all the districts.
- 72. Of the total expenditure of Rs.2.77 crores spent on the affiliated institutions (degree level), 29.8% was on Arts, Science & Commerce colleges and 68.9% on medical colleges.
- 73. In 1976-77 expenditure on higher education formed 44.2% of total direct expenditure. Among the districts this percentage varied from 22.4 in Karaikal to 22.5 in Mahe, 26.7 in Yanam and 50.3 in Pondicherry.
- 74. The average expenditure (direct) per student per annum in 1976-77 was Rs.1,826 in Arts, Science and Commerce colleges and Rs,32,710 in Medical colleges. In Arts Science and Commerce colleges, the average expenditure per student per annum was the highest in karaikal (Rs. 3,271) and the lowest in Mahe (Rs. 1,185). The district-wise details may be seen in statement No. 28.
