## 1. INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of Educational Development just as in urbanisation, industrialization, distribution of income and wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in education sector, Ministry of Education and Social Welfare brings out 'Educational Statistics : District-wise quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. Thereafter it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each State every five year by the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry.

3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers and per-capita expenditure on education have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and hence the need for formulating the educational plans at the district-level.

## II- AREA AND POPULATION

4. Tripura State consists of three districts viz., West Tripura, North Tripura and South Tripura. The total area of the State is 10,477 sq.km . The whole state is evenly divided into three districts and there is not much variations as far as the area is concerned.

5. The distribution of population is not so even as the areas of the three districts. In 1977 West Tripura shared about half the population of the State and the remaining half by the other districts. The Total population of the State in 1971 was 15.52 lakhs, consisting of 7.99 lakh males and 7.53 lakh females. By 1977 the population of the State is estimated to have increased to 18.59 lakhs of which 9.54 lakh were males and 9.05 lakh females. The population was the highest in West Tripura (48.3%), followed by North Tripura (26.0%) and South Tripura (25.7%).

6. The density of population per sq.km of Tripura State increased from 148 in 1971 to 177 in 1977. The density of population in West Tripura was about double the corresponding figures for North Tripura and South Tripura. Table No. 1 gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and density for the three districts.

7. Of the total population of the State in 1977, the population in the age-group 6-11 was 2.48 lakhs, consisting of 1.25 lakh boys and 1.23 lakh girls. This formed 13.4% of the total population of the State.

8. The estimated population in the age-group 11-14 in 1977 was 1.42 lakhs, consisting of the 68 thousand boys and 74 thousand girls. The population in this age-group formed 7.6% of the total population of the State.

9. Similarly, the population in the age-group 14-17 in 1977 was 1.29 lakhs, consisting of 64 thousand boys and 65 thousand girls. This formed 6.9% of the total population of the State.

10. Thus of the total population of 18.59 lakhs of the State, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 was 5.19 lakhs which consisted of 2.57 lakh boys and 2.62 lakh girls. The population in the age-group 6-17 in the State formed 27.9% of the total population.

### III - L I T E R A C Y

11. According to 1971 census the effective literacy rate that is the number of literates per hundred of the population excluding the age-group 0-4., in the State was 36.0. The literacy rate for males was 46.7 and for females 24.6. Among the districts, literacy rate was the highest in West Tripura(37.8), followed by North Tripura(37.3) and South Tripura(31.1)

### IV - G E N E R A L V I E W

#### INSTITUTIONS

12. The total number of educational institutions in the State increased from 2,558 to 3,478 during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77, showing an increase of 36.0% during the period

In 1976-77, West Tripura had the largest share of institutions (42.2%) followed by North Tripura (30.0%) and South Tripura (27.8%).

ENROLMENT :

13. The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions in the State increased from 2.61 lakhs to 3.24 lakhs during a span of 6 years (1970-71 to 1976-77). The increase in enrolment is observed in all the three districts. Of the total enrolment in 1976-77, West Tripura accounted for 52.1%, North Tripura for 25.0% and South Tripura for 22.9%.

EXTENT OF COVERAGE :

14. Extent of coverage of scheduled castes at the State level was 124.2%. In each district also the extent of coverage was more than hundred percent.

15. The extent of coverage of scheduled tribes population was only 65.1% at the State level. It was the highest in West Tripura (79.6%) followed by North Tripura (57.8%) and South Tripura (47.8%).

TEACHERS :

16. There were 9,435 teachers in 1970-71 which increased to 12,327 in 1976-77. The number of teachers increased in all the districts, West Tripura accounted for 54.5%, North Tripura for 23.6% and South Tripura for 21.9%. Among the School teachers, the per centage of trained teachers was 73.1 (73.0 for male and 73.3 for female teachers). Among the districts the percentage of trained teachers ranged from 70.4 in North Tripura to 74.0 in West Tripura.

In 1976-77, West Tripura had the largest share of institutions (42.2%) followed by North Tripura (30.0%) and South Tripura (27.8%).

ENROLMENT :

13. The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions in the State increased from 2.61 lakhs to 3.24 lakhs during a span of 6 years (1970-71 to 1976-77). The increase in enrolment is observed in all the three districts. Of the total enrolment in 1976-77, West Tripura accounted for 52.1%, North Tripura for 25.0% and South Tripura for 22.9%.

EXTENT OF COVERAGE :

14. Extent of coverage of scheduled castes at the State level was 124.2%. In each district also the extent of coverage was more than hundred percent.

15. The extent of coverage of scheduled tribes population was only 65.1% at the State level. It was the highest in West Tripura (79.6%) followed by North Tripura (57.8%) and South Tripura (47.8%).

TEACHERS :

16. There were 9,435 teachers in 1970-71 which increased to 12,327 in 1976-77. The number of teachers increased in all the districts, West Tripura accounted for 54.5%, North Tripura for 23.6% and South Tripura for 21.9%. Among the School teachers, the percentage of trained teachers was 73.1 (73.0 for male and 73.3 for female teachers). Among the districts the percentage of trained teachers ranged from 20.4 in North Tripura to 74.0 in West Tripura.

EXPENDITURE :

17. The total direct expenditure which was Rs. 4.4 crores in 1970-71 increased to Rs.8.5 crores in 1976-77. Of the total expenditure in 1976-77, 58.8% was made in West Tripura,20.8% in North Tripura and 20.4% in South Tripura. Expenditure per institution varied from Rs. 34 thousand in West Tripura Rs. 17 thousand in North Tripura. Expenditure per head of population varied from Rs. 36.5 in South Tripura to Rs. 55.8 in West Tripura.

V- P R E - P R I M A R Y - E D U C A T I O N

18. The number of pre-primary schools in the state increased from 357 in 1970-71 to 575 in 1976-77 and there has been increase in the number of schools in all the districts. The number of teachers also increased from 489 to 876 during the same period.

19. The enrolment in pre-primary classes which was 16,924 in 1970-71 increased to 30,756. The enrolment increased in all the three districts of the State. Of the total enrolment in 1976-77, West Tripura accounted for the highest enrolment of 13,577, followed by North Tripura (9,125) and South Tripura (8,054).

20. The total direct expenditure on pre-primary schools which was Rs.5.97 lakhs in 1970-71 increased to Rs.7,84 lakhs in 1976-77. Of the total expenditure in 1976-77, West Tripura accounted for the highest expenditure of 4.76 lakhs followed by North Tripura (Rs. 1.91 lakhs) and South Tripura (Rs. 1.17 lakhs).

VI- PRIMARY-EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

21. The number of primary schools in the State increased from 1,384 in 1970-71 to 1,531 in 1976-77 recording an increase of 10.6% during the period of 6 years.
22. The number of teachers increased from 3,542 in 1970-71 to 3,897 in 1976-77 and there was increase in all the districts of the State.
23. On an average there was a primary school for every 7.6 sq.km. area. in 1970-71. By 1976-77 the situation improved and a primary school served an area of 6.8 sq.km. and the improvement was recorded in all the three districts of the State.
24. The population served, by a primary school increased from 1,122 in 1970-71 to 1,214 in 1976-77 at the State level. The average population served by a primary school varied from 1,498 in West Tripura to 1,035 in South Tripura and 1,027 in North Tripura.

ENROLMENT :

25. The total enrolment in primary schools which was 1.27 lakhs in 1970-71 increased to 1.42 lakhs in 1976-77. The enrolment in the primary stage i.e. in classes I-V increased from 1.63 lakhs in 1970-71 to 1.99 lakhs in 1976-77. This shows a compound growth rate of 3.4% per annum. The growth rate of enrolment in these classes was 2.8% in the case of boys and 4.2% in the case of girls.
26. The percentage of girls in the total enrolment in 1970-71 was 39.8 which increased to 41.8 in 1976-77. Table 'No.2 indicates the growth of enrolment in 1976-77 as compared to

1970-71 and the percentage of girls in the total enrolment during the period.

27. The enrolment ratio which was 74.7 in 1970-71 increased to 80.0 in 1976-77. There was improvement in the enrolment ratio in all the districts. In 1976-77 the enrolment ratio of boys varied from 75.5 in South Tripura to 84.2 in North Tripura while that of girls varied from 59.8 to 71.4. The details are given in statement No. 12.

28. Of this total enrolment in classes I-V, 30,595 belonged to scheduled castes which formed 15.4% of total enrolment. Among the districts the percentage of scheduled castes students to total students varied from 13.6 to 16.5.

29. The enrolment of scheduled tribes students was 42,474 forming 21.3% of the total enrolment in classes I-V. This percentage varied from 18.1 to 23.5 in different districts. The details can be seen in statement in No. 13.

EXPENDITURE :

30. The direct expenditure on primary schools increased from Rs. 134.96 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.221.21 lakhs in 1976-77 showing an increase of 63.9% during the period under consideration.

31. The per capita expenditure in the State was Rs. 6.7 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs. 11.9 in 1976-77. Each district has recorded an increase in the per capita expenditure. The range in its variation was from Rs. 10.6 to Rs. 12.8.

32. The total expenditure on primary schools formed 30.4% of the total direct expenditure on education in the state in 1970-71. This percentage has decreased to 26.0 in 1976-77. Among the different districts it varied from 21.7 to 35.1.

33. The cost per student in a primary school which was Rs. 106.3 in 1970-71 increased to 155.5 in 1976-77 at the State level. Among the different districts of the State the cost per student ranged from Rs. 147.5 to Rs. 172.2. The teacher-pupil ratio in 1976-77 was 36 and it was almost the same for all the districts. Further details can be seen in statement No. 14 :

VII - MIDDLE SCHOOL EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

34. The number of middle schools in Tripura increased from 220 in 1970-71 to 277 in 1976-77 recording an increase of 25.9% during the period of 6 years. Among the districts also each district recorded an increase in the number of middle schools.

35. During the period under consideration teachers in the middle schools increased from 2,672 to 2,681 and the increase was recorded in each of the three districts.

36. On an average there was a middle school for every 47.5 sq.km. in 1970-71. By 1976-77 the position improved to 37.8 km. and there was improvement in all the three districts of the State.

37. The population served by a middle school decreased from 7,055 in 1970-71 to 6,710 in 1976-77 at the State level. The position eased in all the districts. The average population served by a middle school varied from 6,048 in North Tripura to 7,480 in West Tripura.

ENROLMENT :

38. The total enrolment in middle schools which was 53,736 in 1970-71 increased to 69,740 in 1976-77. The enrolment at middle stage i.e. in classes VI-VIII increased from 40,227 in 1970-71 to 48,749 in 1976-77. This shows a compound growth rate of 3.2% per annum. The growth rate of enrolment in these classes was 2.6% in the case of boys and 4.3% in the case of girls. Each of the three districts recorded an increase in the enrolment in classes VI-VIII.

39. The percentage of girls in the total enrolment in 1970-71 was 38.1 which increased to 40.6 in 1976-77 at the State level. Among the districts it varied from 37.2 in South Tripura to 41.6 in North Tripura. Table No. 4 indicates the growth in the enrolment in 1976-77 as compared to 1970-71 and the percentage of girls in the total enrolment during 1976-77.

40. The enrolment ratio which was 34.6 in 1970-71 decreased slightly to 34.4 in 1976-77 at the State level. In 1976-77, the enrolment ratio in respect of boys varied from 36.6 in South Tripura to 47.1 in West Tripura, while that in respect of girls varied from 19.6 in South Tripura to 30.9 in West Tripura.

41. Of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII, 4,710 belonged to scheduled castes which formed 9.7% of the total enrolment. Among the districts this percentage varied from 8.7 to 10.0. The enrolment of those belonging to scheduled tribes was 5,903 forming 12.1% of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII. This percentage varied from 8.4 to 14.7 in the three districts of Tripura.

41. Of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII, 4,710 belonged to scheduled castes which formed 9.7% of the total enrolment. Among the districts this percentage varied from 8.7 to 10.0. The enrolment of these belonging to scheduled tribes was 5,903 forming 12.1% of the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII. This percentage varied from 8.4 to 14.7 in the three districts of Tripura.

EXPENDITURE :

42. The direct expenditure on middle schools increased from 94.49 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs. 161.41 lakhs in 1976-77. There was, therefore, an increase of 74.5 during the period under consideration.

43. The per capita expenditure in the State was only Rs. 6.0 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs. 8.7 in 1976-77. Each district has recorded an increase in the per capita expenditure. The range in its variation in the different districts was from Rs. 8.2 to 9.1.

44. The total expenditure on middle schools formed 20.8% of the total direct expenditure on education in the State in 1970-71. This percentage has decreased to 18.9 in 1976-77. Among the different districts it varied from 16.3 to 23.0.

45. The cost per student in a middle school which was Rs. 172.1 in 1970-71 increased to Rs. 231.4 in 1976-77 at the State level. Among the different districts of the State the cost per student ranged from Rs. 201.9 in North Tripura to Rs. 245.2 in South Tripura. The teacher-pupil ratio in 1976-77 was 26 at the State level and among the districts also. There was not much variation. Further details can be seen in statement No. 18.

VIII - HIGH/HR. SEC. SCHOOL EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

46. The number of high/hr. secondary schools in the state increased from 89 in 1970-71 to 126 in 1976-77, showing thereby an increase of 41.6% during the period of 6 years.
47. The number of teachers increased from 2,181 in 1970-71 to 3,041 in 1976-77. The increase was also recorded in all the three districts individually.
48. On an average there was a high/hr. sec. school for every 117.7 sq. km. in 1970-71; By 1976-77, the situation improved and a high/hr. secondary school served on an area of 83.2 sq. km and there was improvement in all the three districts of Tripura.
49. The average population served by a high/hr. sec. school declined from 17,440 in 1970-71 to 14,752. The average population served by a high/hr. sec. school varied from 13,809 in West Tripura to 17,272 in North Tripura.

ENROLMENT :

50. The total enrolment in high/hr.sec. schools which was 42,868 in 1970-71 increased to 54,010 in 1976-77. The enrolment in the secondary stage is shown to have been decreased from 19,890 to 18,646.

51. The percentage of girls in the total enrolment in the secondary stage increased from 36.00 to 40.3 during the period. Among the districts it varied from 35.9 in South Tripura to 42.2 in West Tripura. Table No. 6 indicates growth in the enrolment in 1976-77 as compared to 1970-71 and the percentage of girls in the total enrolment during 1976-77.

52. Of the total enrolment in classes of IX-XI, 1,572 belonged to scheduled castes which formed 8.4% of the total enrolment. Among the districts the percentage of scheduled castes students varied from 6.6 in North Tripura to 9.2 in West Tripura.

53. The enrolment of those belonging to scheduled tribes was 1,776 forming 9.5% of the total enrolment in the secondary stage. This percentage varied from 6.6 in North and South Tripura to 11.8 in West TRIPURA. The details may be seen in the statement No. 21.

EXPENDITURE :

54. The direct expenditure on High/Hr. Secondary schools increased from Rs.135.95 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs. 284.26 lakhs in 1976-77. There was, therefore, an increase of 109.1% during the period of 6 years.

55. The per capita expenditure on the State was Rs.8.8 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.15.3 in 1976-77. The increase was noticed in each of the three districts.

56. The total expenditure on the High/Hr.Secondary schools formed 30.6% of the total direct expenditure on education in the State in 1970-71 which increased to 33.3 in 1976-77. Among the districts it varied from 30.8% to 34.5%.

57. The cost per student in a high/hr,secondary school which was Rs.317.1 in 1970-71 increased to Rs.526.3 in 1976-77. Among the different districts of the State, the cost per student varied from Rs.495.0 to Rs. 541.4. The teacher pupil ratio in 1976-77 was 18 in the State and it was the same in all the three districts. The details can be seen in statement No. 22.

IX PROF. VOC. SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION)

58. The number of Professional vocational Special and other schools which was 493 in 1970-71 increased to 945 in 1976-77 and the enrolment increased from 12,717 to 20,471 during this period of 6 years. In 1976-77 of the 945 vocational institutions 425 were in West Tripura, 296 in North Tripura and 224 in South Tripura. The number of teachers also increased from 678 to 1,255 during the period under consideration. The total expenditure increased from Rs.19.64 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.60.41 lakhs in 1976-77.

X - H I G H E R E D U C A T I O N

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

59. The number of institutions for higher education which was 15 in 1970-71 increased to 18 in 1976-77. Of the 18 institutions in 1976-77, 14 were in West Tripura and 2 each in North Tripura and South Tripura. Of the total of 18 institutions for higher education, 10 were affiliated degree level institutions which included among others 6 Arts, Science and Commerce colleges. The number of teachers in institutions for higher education which was 473 in 1970-71 increased to 561 in 1976-77.

ENROLMENT:

60. The enrolment in higher education decreased from 7,550 in 1970-71 to 6,430 in 1976-77. Of the 6,430 students studying in higher education, 5200 were studying in general education courses while 1,230 were in professional education courses: The details may be seen in statement No. 25 and 26.

61. Of the total enrolment in higher education, 448 belonged to scheduled castes and 378 to scheduled tribes. District-wise details may be seen in statement No. 27.

EXPENDITURE :

62. The total direct expenditure on the institutions for higher education which was Rs. 54.97 lakhs in 1970-71 increased to Rs.116.70 lakhs in 1976-77. Thus the amount of expenditure doubled in a period of 6 years. Of this total amount spent in 1976-77, Rs. 90.04 lakhs were incurred on the affiliated institutions of degree level. Among the districts, Rs. 97 lakhs were spent in West Tripura, Rs. 11 lakhs in North Tripura and Rs. 9 lakhs in South Tripura.
