## I N T R O D U C T I O N

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of educational development just as in urbanisation, industrialization, distribution of income and wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector, the Ministry of Education and Culture brings out the publication "Educational Statistics: District-wise" quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. Thereafter it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state, every five years by the Ministry of Education and Culture. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry.

3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers and per capita expenditure on education have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and hence the need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

4. Wherever varified data was not available, estimated districtwise statistics have been used.

5. District-wise expenditure figures for the years 1970-71 and 1973-74 were not available hence only the total expenditure figures of the state have been included in this brochure.





## II. AREA AND POPULATION

4. The State of Jammu and Kashmir comprised of 10 districts viz. Anantnag, Baramulla Doda, Jammu, Kathua, Ladakh, Poonch, Rajouri, Srinagar and Udhampur. The total area of Jammu and Kashmir state wise 2,22,236 Sq. Kms. out of which 84,112 Sq. Kms. area is under illegal occupation of Pakistan. The district of Ladakh comprised of 95,876 Sq.Kms. area which includes the area under illegal occupation of China. Hence educational/ population data included in this volume excludes the area at present not under effective control of Government of India. For the same reasons the indices such as enrolment ratios and percentages pertaining to area and population etc. in respect of Ladakh district have not been worked out.

The district-wise area in respect of the state remained same in 1976-77 as it was in the year 1970-71 and 1973-74. Among the districts (ignoring Ladakh) Doda had the largest share of area i.e. 8.5% (11,691 Sq.Kms) and Poonch was the smallest district i.e. 1.2% (1,658 Sq.Kms.)

The population of Jammu and Kashmir was 46.06 lakhs (24.53 lakh males and 21.53 lakhs females in 1971 and its estimated population was 49.99 lakhs (26.28 lakh males and 23.91 lakhs females) in 1973-74 and it was 54.10 lakhs (28.11 lakhs males and 25.99 lakhs females) in 1976-77. The highest population was in Anantnag district (9.01 lakhs) closely followed by Srinagar district (8.96 lakhs) and the lowest population was in Ladakh district i.e. 1.14 lakhs in 1973-74. By the year 1977, the estimated population of Anantnag and Srinagar districts was 9.75 lakhs and 9.70 lakhs respectively where as the population of Ladakh district was 1.23 lakhs.

6. The overall density of population per Sq.Km. was 33 in 1971 which is estimated to have increased to 36 in 1973-74 and to 39 in 1977. The density of population per Sq.Km. in 1977 varied widely among the districts. It varies from 322 (the highest) in Srinagar to only 34 (the lowest) in Doda. The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the years 1970-71, 1973-74 and 1976-77 are given in Statement No.2. The table No.1 below gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and the density of population in 1977.

7. The total population of the state as well as population of different age groups for the year 1971 and 1977 given in this report are based on revised population projections (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the agegroup 6-11, 11-14, and 14-17 are based on the following formula:-

To get the sex-wise break up of total population in the various age-groups of the district, first of all the girls population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in the above formula total population is replaced by the girls' population. The boys population is obtained by the residual method i.e.

Boys population in the age-group 6-11 (=)

Total population in the age-group 6-11 (-)

Girls population in the age-group 6-11

Similar formulae are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-groups 11-14 and 14-17 years.

1977 8. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 7.11 lakhs (3.57 lakh boys and 3.54 lakh girls) in which formed 13.1% of the total population of the state.

9. Similarly the estimated population in the age-group 11-14 was 3.83 lakhs in 1977 (1.96 lakhs boys and 1.87 lakhs girls) which constituted 7.1% of the total population.

10. The population in the age-group 14-17 in 1977 was 3.52 lakhs consisting of 1.8 lakhs boys and 1.7 girls. This formed 6.5% of the total population.

11. Thus out of the total population of 54.10 lakhs of the state, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 14.43 lakhs consisting of 7.34 lakhs boys and 7.12 lakhs girls. The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 26.7% of the total population. The percentage for boys was 26.1 while for girls it formed 27.4.

### III - LITERACY

12. According to the 1971 census the effective literacy rate i.e. the number of literates per hundred of the population (excluding the age group 0-4) in the state was 21.71. The literacy rates for males and females were 31.01 and 10.94 respectively indicating a wide gap between the two sexes. Details are given in statement No.7.

### IV GENERAL VIEW

#### (a) INSTITUTIONS:

13. The total number of educational institutions in Jammu and Kashmir state was 7,217 in 1970-71 which increased to 8,826 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 22.3% during the period of 6 years. The district of Baramulla had the largest share of institutions 1600 (18.1%) and Poonch district had the lowest share 299 (3.4%) in the year 1976-77. The district-wise position of institutions is given in statement No.1.

#### (b) ENROLMENT

14. The total enrolment in all recognised educational institutions in the state increased from 5.89 lakhs in 1970-71 to 6.77 lakhs in 1976-77. The increase in enrolment is observed in almost all the districts of the state. The enrolment increased with an average annual growth rate of 2.5%. Jammu district had the highest enrolment i.e. 1.73 lakhs while Ladakh district shows the lowest enrolment i.e. 0.12 lakhs in 1976-77.

15. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was 29.8 in 1970-71 which increased to 31.8 in 1976-77. Among the districts Jammu had the highest percentage of Girls (38.3) and the lowest percentage (23.5) was in Poonch district.

16. The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institutions as a percentage of total population was 12.8 in 1970-71 and it increased to 12.5 in 1976-77 at the state level. The percentage enrolment to total population in 1976-77 was the highest in Jammu district i.e. 20.1 and the lowest in Doda district (8.3).

#### (c) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES

The percentage of the enrolment of scheduled castes to the total enrolment for the year 1976-77 was 7.5%. Hence, the co-efficient of equality\* for scheduled castes was 84.3 at the state level in 1976-77. Details can be seen in statement No.8. Jammu and Kashmir state has no scheduled tribe population. The percentage of scheduled Castes population to total population was 8.9%.

The percentage of trained teachers in schools varied from 85.4 in Kathua district to 64.5 in Ladakh district. The percentage of women trained teachers in schools was highest (88.6%) in Kathua District and the lowest (67.5%) in Baramula district.

(e) EXPENDITURE:

19. The total expenditure (excluding expenditure on Directorate and Inspectorate) of all recognised educational institutions in the state was Rs. 876.54 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to Rs. 1984.10 lakhs in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an average annual rate of growth 21.1%. The percentage share of expenditure of districts in 1976-77 was the highest in the case of Srinagar district (25.4) and the lowest in the case of Ladakh district (2.6).

20. The expenditure on education per head of population in the state increased from Rs. 19 in 1970-71 to Rs. 37 in 1976-77. In 4 districts the per capita expenditure was more than the state per capita expenditure. The lowest per capita expenditure in 1976-77 was observed in Anantnag District (Rs. 26) and the highest was in Srinagar district (Rs. 52). The expenditure per institution also increased from Rs. 12145 in 1970-71 to Rs. 22,480 in 1976-77. The maximum being in Jammu Rs. 37,704 and minimum was in Ladakh Rs. 14,256. The district-wise details are given in statement No. 5.

21. V- PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

The number of Pre-Primary schools in Jammu and Kashmir was 261 in 1970-71 and by the year 1976-77 all the pre-primary schools had been upgraded.

The total number of teachers in pre-primary schools was 261 (245 male and 16 females) in 1970-71. The enrolment in pre-primary classes was 7,100 in 1970-71 and 5,857 in 1976-77. 68 students (40 boys and 28 girls) belonging to scheduled castes were enrolled in pre-primary classes in 1976-77.

23. The expenditure on pre-primary schools was Rs. 192216 in 1970-71. Details may be seen in Statement No. 9.

VI PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS:

24. The total number of primary schools in Jammu and Kashmir increased from 4,872 in 1970-71 to 6078 in 1976-77, showing an annual increase of 4.1%. The highest percentage of primary schools was in Baramula district (19.2%) while the lowest percentage was in Poonch district (3.5%) in 1976-77. The details may be seen in statement No. 10.

25. On the average, in 1970-71, a primary school was serving an area of 28.4 Sq. Kms. Over the period of 6 years this position improved slightly and a primary school was serving an area of 22.7 Kms. in 1976-77. In 1976-77, the average area served by a primary school was the minimum (3.4 Sq. Kms.) in the case of Srinagar and (maximum) in Doda (19.9 Sq. Kms.) (The district of Ladakh has been ignored.)

(d) TEACHERS:

18. The total number of teachers in the state in all educational institutions increased from 23,860 in 1970-71 to 34,720 in 1976-77 showing an annual rate of increase of 7.6% during the period. The number of total women teachers in the state increased from 6,065 in 1970-71 to 10,877 in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 13.2%. In 1976-77 the percentage of trained teachers in school education was 72.6 as against 63.9% in 1970-71. Similar percentages for male and female trained teachers were 71.7 and 74.5 respectively. Details may be seen in statement No.6.

26. The population served by a primary school in the state was 945 in 1970-71 and it became 890 in 1976-77. Among the districts the population served by a primary school varied from 1311 in Jammu to 438 in Ladakh in 1976-77.

27. Total number of teachers in primary schools in Jammu and Kashmir also increased from 6,463 in 1970-71 to 8,468 in 1976-77. This shows an average annual increase rate of 5.2% during the period under review. During this period there was an increase in the number of teachers in all the districts. The number of women teachers formed 38.0% of the total number of teachers in 1976-77. The highest percentage of teachers was 18.9% (1,600) in Anantnag while lowest percentage i.e. 3.3% (277) was found in Poonch District.

(b) ENROLMENT:

28. In 1970-71 the total enrolment in primary schools in Jammu and Kashmir was 2,06,539 which became 2,00,748 in 1976-77. In classes I-V, the enrolment increased from 3.81 lakhs (2.64 lakhs boys and 1.18 lakh girls) in 1970-71 to 4.22 lakhs (2.78 lakhs boys and 1.44 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 1.8 per annum. The enrolment growth rates in these separately for boys and girls were 0.9% and 3.8% respectively which shows that girls education is getting better deal in the state. Details may be seen in table. No.3.

29. The percentage of enrolment in classes I-V to the total population in the age group 6-11 (also called enrolment ratio) gives the index of the facilities created at the primary stage of education. At the state level this percentage increased from 59.2 to 59.4 during the period of 6 years. In the case of girls alone the increase in percentage was from 37.9 in 1970-71 to 40.8 in 1976-77. Among the various districts, taking boys and girls together, the enrolment ratio in 1976-77 was the highest in ( ) Jammu district (92.2) and the lowest in Doda district (41.7%).

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES:

30. Of the total enrolment of 3.81 lakhs in classes I-V in 1970-71 0.14 lakh students belonged to the scheduled castes forming 3.6% of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1976-77 the enrolment of scheduled caste students increased to 0.35 lakhs and formed 8.3% of the total enrolment in these classes. The co-efficient of equality of scheduled castes in these classes works out to 93.2%. The district-wise details are given in statement Nos. 12 & 13.

(a) EXPENDITURE:

31. The total expenditure on primary schools in Jammu and Kashmir increased from Rs.171.04 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.327.83 lakhs in 1976-77. This gives an average annual growth rate of 15.2% during the period under consideration.

32. The per capita expenditure on primary schools in the state was Rs.3.7 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.6.1 by 1976-77. The per capita expenditure in 1976-77 was the lowest in Jammu district Rs.4.3 and the highest in Ladakh district Rs.11.3.

35. On an average, in 1970-71, a middle schools served an area of 95 sq. Kms. The position improved considerably in 1976-77 and a middle school was then available for ever 72 sq. Kms. area. In 1976-77 the area served by a middle school was less than the state average in 8 districts (Ladakh not taken into account). The area served by a middle school was the lowest in Srinagar (9 sq. Kms.) and the highest in the case of Doda (74. sq. Kms.) (Ladakh ignored).

36. The population served by a middle school in the state decreased from 3,168 in 1970-71 to 2803 in 1976-77 i.e. during the period of 6 years. Among the districts, the population served by a middle school in 1976-77 varied from 3458 in Jammu to 1872 in Kathua district. The details are given in statement No. 14. The number of teachers in middle schools also increased from 6,833 in 1970-71 to 10,760 in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of 9.6% during the period.

(b) ENROLMENT:

37. The total enrolment in middle schools was 1.57 lakhs in 1970-71 and it increased to 2.11 lakhs in 1976-77 which shows an average annual growth rate of 5.8%. The enrolment at the middle stage i.e. in classes VI-VIII increased from 1.14 lakhs (0.81 lakh boys and 0.01 lakh girls) in 1970-71 to 1.46 lakhs (1.05 lakh boys and 0.33 lakh girls) in 1976-77. This shows an average growth rate of 4.8% per annum during the period under consideration. The average annual growth rates of enrolment separately for boys and girls in these classes were 4.9% and 4.4% respectively.

38. The percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to total population in the age group 11-14 i.e. enrolment ratio gives an index of facilities available at the middle stage of education. In Jammu and Kashmir this percentage was 34.3% in 1970-71 and 38.2% in 1976-77. In case of boys the enrolment ratio was 46.9 in 1970-71 and it increased to 53.7 in 1976-77. Similarly it increased in the case of girls from 20.6% to 22.0% during the period under consideration. Taking boys and girls together, the percentage enrolment in case of 7 districts was less than the corresponding state percentage in 1976-77. At middle stage this percentage indicates a wide disparity between the two sexes in all the districts. However, the position of boys and girls improved slightly during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. In 1976-77, the enrolment ratio was highest in Jammu for boys, girls and total (83.7, 43.2 and 63.3 and the lowest in boys, girls and total (35.6, 9.2. and 21.9 in Ladakh district. The details may be seen in Statement No. 15.

The expenditure on primary schools in 1970-71 formed 19.5% of the total expenditure on education and this percentage was 16.5 in the year 1976-77. In as many as 8 districts the percentage of expenditure on primary schools was more than the state average.

33. The average cost per student in primary schools increased from Rs.84 in 1970-71 to Rs.163 in 1976-77 at the state level. Among the districts, the cost per student was the highest in Kathua district (Rs.248) followed by Ladakh district (Rs.246) and was lowest in Jammu district (Rs.81). The teacher-pupil ratio improved significantly from 32 in 1970-71 to 24 in 1976-77. The pupil-teacher ratio varied from 41 in Jammu district to 17 in Uda district. The details can be seen from statement No.1 and Table No.4

VII- MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS:

34. The total number of middle schools in the state increased from 1930 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 32.7% during the period of six years. In 1976 highest number of middle schools was recorded in Anantnag (332) district 27.2%.

42. The total expenditure on middle schools in 1970-71 formed 16.1% of the total expenditure on education in the State and it increased to 20.2% in 1976-77. In as many as 8 districts the percentage expenditure on middle schools was more than the state percentage.

43. The cost per student in middle schools which was Rs. 90 in 1970-71 increased to Rs. 190 in 1976-77 at the state level. Among the districts the cost per student ranged from Rs. 289 in Ladakh to Rs. 120 in Jammu district. In 1970-71 pupil teacher ratio was 23 which decreased to 20 in 1976-77. Among the districts the teacher-pupil ratio varied from 31 in Jammu to 15 in Doda and Anantnag districts. Further details can be seen in statement No. 1 and table No. 6.

VIII-HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS.

The number of High/Higher Secondary Schools in Jammu and Kashmir increased from 561 in 1970-71 to 740 in 1976-77. This shows an increase of 31.9% during the period under review. The increase in number of high/Higher secondary schools was shared by all the districts. Among the districts the largest number of high/higher secondary schools was in Jammu district (138) while the smallest number was located in Poonch district (19)

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES -

39. Of the total enrolment of 1,13,821 in classes VI-VIII 3676 students belonged to scheduled castes in 1970-71 forming 3.2% of the total enrolment. Out of the total enrolment of 1,46,377 in 1976-77, 10,605 students belonged to scheduled castes communities forming 7.2% of the total enrolment. Scheduled caste population was 8.9% of the total population. Hence the co-efficient of equality of scheduled castes comes out to 80.9.

(d) EXPENDITURE:

40. The total expenditure on middle schools increased from R.140.84 lakhs in 1970-71 to R.400.16 lakhs in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 30.7% during the period under consideration.

41. The per capita expenditure on middle schools in the state was only R.3.1 in 1970-71 which increased to 7.4 in 1976-77. The range of variation among the districts is from R.11.2 (highest) in the case of Kathua district and R.6.2 (lowest) in the case of Poonch district.

45. On an average there was a high/higher secondary school for every 206 Sq.Km area in Jammu and Kashmir in 1970-71. By 1976-77 a high/higher secondary school was available for every 187 Sq. Kms. In 1970-71 there was a high/higher secondary school in Jammu district for every 22 Sq.Kms. area, whereas in Doda district, one high/higher secondary school was available for an area of 216 Sq.Kms only.

46. On an average, at the state level, there was a high/higher secondary School for every 8211 persons in 1970-71. By the year 1976-77 a high/higher secondary school was available for every 7311 persons. Among the districts the average population covered by a school varied from as high as 10,632 in Poonch district to as low as 3977 in Ladakh district.

47. The total number of teachers in high/higher secondary schools in Jammu and Kashmir increased from 8,452 in 1970-71 to 13,098 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 9.2% percent per annum during the period under consideration. During the period of 6 years, there was an increase in the number of teachers in all the districts. Women teachers formed 30.5% of the total number of teachers in 1976-77. Details may be seen in statement No. 18

(b) ENROLMENT:

48. The total enrolment in high/higher secondary schools of the state in 1970-71 was 1,89,596 which increased to 2,37,062 in 1976-77. This shows an average annual increase of 4.2% during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. The enrolment at the secondary and higher secondary stage i.e. in classes IX-XI was 56,181 (43,856 boys and 12,325 girls) in 1970-71 and it increased to 74,416 (55,490 boys and 18,926 girls) during 1976-77. \* Among the districts, the percentage of enrolment in these classes varied from 26.5% in Jammu district to 0.9% in Ladakh district.

49. The enrolment ratio for Jammu and Kashmir state at the high higher secondary stage was 18.8% in 1970-71 which increased to 21.1% (30.6% for boys and 11.0% for girls) in 1976-77. There is wide disparity in the enrolment ratio in all the districts among boys and girls. Percentage of enrolment was found to be maximum in Jammu for boys, girls and total (50%, 20.5% and 35.3%) respectively and Minimum in Ladakh district for boys, girls and total 12.9%, 3.2% and 8%. Details may be seen in table No.7 and statement No. 17

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES:-

50. Of the total enrolment of 56,181 in classes IX to XI, 169 students belonged to scheduled castes in 1970-71 which formed 0.3% of the total enrolment in these classes. Out of the total enrolment of 74,416 in high/higher secondary classes in 1976-77, 3,949 students belonged to scheduled castes. The percentage of scheduled caste students to total enrolment in these classes was 5.3% whereas the percentage of scheduled caste population to total population in the stage was 8.9%. Therefore, the co-efficients of equality for the scheduled castes communities worked out to be 59.6%. The details of enrolment and percentages etc. can be seen in the statement No. 19

**(d) EXPENDITURE:**

51. The total expenditure on high/higher secondary schools in the state increased from Rs.282.31 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs.648.65 lakhs in 1976-77. The expenditure increased with an average annual growth rate of 21.5% during the period under consideration.

52. The expenditure per capita on high/higher secondary schools at the state level was Rs.6.2 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.11.9 by 1976-77. Among districts the per capita expenditure on high/higher secondary schools was the highest in Ladakh district (Rs.20.6) and the lowest in Poonch district (Rs.8.3.)

53. The expenditure on high/higher secondary schools in 1970-71 formed 32.2% of the total expenditure on education in Jammu and Kashmir state. By 1976-77 the percentage expenditure on high/higher secondary schools was 32.6. In 7 districts, the percentage expenditure spent on high/higher secondary schools was more than the state average. The expenditure on high/higher secondary schools as percentage of total expenditure on education was 48.4(highest) in Ladakh district and 21.8 (lowest) in Srinagar district. Further details may be seen in table, No.8.

54. The cost per student in high/higher Secondary schools increased from Rs. 149 in 1970-71 to Rs. 273 in 1976-77 during the period of 6 yrs. Among the districts, it varied from Rs. 928 in Ladakh district to Rs. 155 in the case of Jammu district. The pupil teacher ratio improved at the state level from 26 in Jammu district to 9 in Ladakh district.

#### IX. PROFESSIONAL VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

55. The number of schools for vocational, professional, special and others education increased from 7 in 1970-71 to 12 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 11.9% during the period of 6 years.

56. The total enrolment in professional and vocational (School) education also increased from 1158 (898 boys and 260 girls) in 1970-71 to 1539 (1076 boys and 463 girls) in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 5.5%. In professional and vocational (school) education the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students was 32 (29 boys and 3 girls) in 1970-71. In 1976-77, the enrolment of scheduled caste was 71 (55 boys and 16 girls). The percentage of scheduled caste students to total enrolment in these courses was 4.6%. Number of teachers in these courses increased from 108 in 1970-71 to 137 in 1976-77 showing average annual increase of 4.5%.

57. The total expenditure on these institutions increased from Rs. 71.85 lakhs in 1970-71 to 17.74 lakhs in 1976-77 during the period under review showing an average annual growth of 21%. Among the districts the maximum expenditure in 1976-77 on this account was shown by Srinagar district (14.4%) whereas minimum i.e. 9% was shown by Doda district. District-wise information on professional, vocational, special and other education (School) can be seen from statement No. 22.

#### X. HIGHER EDUCATION

##### (a) Institutions and Teachers:

58. Number of institutions for higher education increased from 57 in 1970-71 to 66 in 1976-77, showing an increase of 12.6% during this period. In 1976-77 there were 2 Universities. Out of these one each was located in Jammu and Srinagar districts. In all there were 41 affiliated institutions of degree level, 21 below degree level and 2 boards of Intermediate Education. Of the 41 affiliated institutions (degree level) 23 were for Arts, Science and Commerce ranging from one each in Anantnag, Doda, Kothua, Udhampur and Poonch, 3 in Baranulla, 6 in Jammu and 9 in Srinagar. One college of Agriculture in Baranulla; 3 colleges for Education - one each is located in Baranulla, Jammu and Srinagar, One Engineering college in Srinagar; 3 colleges for medicine - 2 in Jammu and one in Srinagar and 10 colleges for other education. Besides, there were 21 non-affiliated institutions meant for imparting education of a standard lower than the degree level.

59. Statement No. 23 gives district-wise statistics of teachers in institutions of higher education in Jammu and Kashmir. Total number of teachers in these institutions increased from 1,743 in 1970-71 to 2,257 in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 4.9% during the period. Amongst districts the number of teachers in institutions for higher education was the highest in Srinagar (1038) and lowest in Laksh (8).

(b) ENROLLMENT:

60. The total enrollment in all institutions of higher education in the state was 29,276 in 1970-71 which became 26,755 in 1976-77 of this, 13,621 students were studying in Arts Science and Commerce colleges, 190 in Agricultural and Forestry, 572 in Education, 824 in Engineering, Technology and Arch., 1166 in Medical Colleges, 810 students were studying in other courses and 2207 students were studying in universities. The total enrollment in institutions for higher education was the highest in Srinagar (9,717) followed by Jammu (5973) and the lowest was in Doda (183). In addition 2,365 students were undergoing studies to qualify for diploma/certificate courses in non-affiliated colleges.

61. Statement No. 25 gives enrollment in higher education by type of education. The total enrollment in higher education was 29,080 (21,267 boys and 7,813 girls) in 1970-71 which became 26,555 (13077 boys and 13478 girls) in 1976-77. Out of the total enrollment 20,060 (13,117 boys and 6,943) students were enrolled for general education and 6495 (4,960 boys and 1,535 girls) in professional education during the year 1976-77.

(c) ENROLLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES

62. There were 908 (813 boys and 95 girls) students belonging to Scheduled Castes studying for higher education in 1976-77. This figure is 3.5% of the total enrollment in higher educational institutions.

In 1970-71 their number was 542 (483 boys and 54 girls) and it formed 1.9% of the enrollment of high education. The coefficient of equality of scheduled caste students at the higher education stage was 39.3% in 1976-77 and 21.3 in 1970-71.

(d) EXPENDITURE

63. The total expenditure on high education in the state increased from 272.57 lakhs in 1970-71 to 591.72 lakhs in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 19.5% during the period under review. Amongst districts, the highest expenditure was recorded by Srinagar (46.2%) and the lowest in the case of Rajouri (0.4%) during the year 1976-77.
