ABSTRACTS

(a) SYSTEM OF SCHOOL EDUCATION (DIFFERENT STAGES)

The Primary stage consists of Classes I-V, i.e. of 5 years duration in 21 States/UTs. States/UTs. where the primary stage consists of classes other than I-V are Assam, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Goa, Daman Diu, Lakshadweep, Mizoram and Mahi region of Pondicherry. In Gujarat the primary stage consists of classes I-VII with no middle stage. In Meghalaya, it consists of classes A, B, I, II and III whereas the primary stage consists of classes I-IV in rest of the above listed states/UTs.

Middle stage consists of Classes VI-VIII in as many as 20 States/UTs. The exceptions are Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Goa, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep, Mizoram and Mahe region of Pondicherry. There is no middle stage in Gujarat whereas it consists of classes IV-VI in Meghalaya. In rest of the above listed States/ Uts, it consists of Classes V/VI-VII.

Secondary stage consists of Classes IX-X in 20 States/UTs. However, Hr. Secondary/Senior Secondary stage consists of Classes XI-XII (10+2 pattern) in all the States/UTs although in several States/UTs it forms part of University/Collegiate stage.

Statewise details for diffefent stages of school education may be seen at pages 1-5.

(b) AGE RESTRICTION FOR ADMISSION:

Minimum age for admission to Class I of the Primary stage is generally 5+ or 6+ years. In 20 States/UTs., the minimum age for admission to Class I is 5+ years and in 8 States it is 6+ years whereas in the rest of the States/UTs either there is no age restriction or the age of admission is less than 5+ years.

Details for all the States/Union Territories are given at pages 6-7.

(c) MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

Regional language or the mother tongue is the medium of instruction at the primary stage in most of the States/UTs. Facilities for studying in different languages (other than Regional language) in different States vary considerably. State-wise details for different stages of school education may be seen at pages 6-12.

(d) TEACHING OF HINDI & ENGLISH:

Apart from Hindi speaking States teaching of Hindi is compulsory in most of the non Hindi speaking States/UTs also. Classes in which teaching of Hindi are compulsory or optional for different States are given on pages 13-14.

Teaching of English is compulsory in all the States/UTs although the class from which teaching of English is compulsory differs from State to State. However, in general it is compulsory in Classes VI to X or even XII in most of the States/UTs. State-wise details may be seen at pages 15-16.

(e) PUBLIC EXAMINATION:

In all the States/UTs public examination are conducted at the end of class X and class XII by State Boards of Secondary/Higher Secondary Education and the minimum age for Secondary examination varies from 14+ to 16+ years. It has been reported to be 14+ years from Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and Chandigarh, Pondy & Karaikal region of Pondicherry and 16+ years from Assam, Jammu & Kashmir, Nagaland, and Tripura. There are no age restrictions for appearing in the Boards Examination in Bihar, Gujarat, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu & Mizoram. In some of the States the first public examination is also conducted at the middle stage of school education although these are conducted generally by the District Boards of School Education. State-wise details may be seen at pages 17-24.

(f) NUMBER OF WORKING DAYS:

Number of working days at different stages of school education is more than 200 in all the States/UTs. except those of Jammu & Kashmir and Mizoram wherein the number of working days is less than 200. State-wise details may be seen at pages 25-26.

(g) ACADEMIC TERMS:

The academic year generally starts in the month of April, May or June and ends in the month of March or April or May. The exceptions are Bihar, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura and West Bengal. In most of the states, long vacation periods are in summer although in some of the hilly States long winter vacations are also there. State-wise details may be seen at pages 27-31.

(h) COMPULSORY EDUCATION:

It is surprising to know that as many as 12 States/UTs have reported that the compulsory primary education corresponding to the age group 6-11 years is not being enforced there. Only 9 States have reported that the primary education is compulsory in the age group of 6-14 years.

(i) FREE EDUCATION:

Education is free up to the middle stage in Government and Government aided schools (Classes VI/VIII) in all the States/UTs except those of Meghalaya and Uttar Pradesh. In several States education is free even up to Class X or higher in Government and Government aided schools viz. Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka, Kerala, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and West Bengal, A. & N. Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Goa, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep and Pondicherry. Even of those States where it is not free for all boys students, it is free in case of girls in some of the states. State-wise details may be seen at pages 33-36.

(j) TUITION FEES CHARGED PER ANNUM:

All those States where education is not free in Classes IX and above, the annual fee varies considerably from the highest of Rs.250/- in case of Gujarat to the lowest of Rs.36/- in case of Orissa. In some of the States lower fees are charged from girls. State-wise details may be seen at pages 37-47.
