




#### **EXPLANATIONS**


- 1. The academic year 1945-46, as usual, means the period from 1st April 1945 to 31st March 1946.
  - 2. For definiteness, enrolment has been taken to be that on 31st March, 1946.
- 3. Endowments etc. include endowments, subscriptions and contributions etc. from public.
- 4. Certificated Teachers are those who have obtained any form of teacher's certificate other than the one granted on the basis of public examination of a training college or a training school.
- 5. Baluchistan and Administered Areas in Hyderabad are not included in this pamphlet, as figures for these are not yet available for the year 1945-46.
- 6. In Totals and Grand Totals for 1944-45, figures for Administered Areas in Hyderabad are excluded, as these are not available. Similarly for 1943-44, in case of Administered Areas in Assam (Manipur).
- 7. Secondary Stage in different Provinces and Centrally Administered Areas begins differently, but in all cases it ends with High School course. The following table gives the classes at which it begins:—


