PREFACE

During the war owing to the need for economy of paper no reports on the progress of education in India have been published. The last published report "Education in India" is for the year 1938-39. With the improvement in the paper supply position, it is hoped to resume the issue of this report as well as of the Quinquennial Review of the Progress of Education in India.

A few statements showing important statistical information on education in India have been in the past prepared for official use only. It is considered that these may be useful to educationists and the public. Accordingly the attached statements containing certain salient features of education in the period 1942-43 to 1944-45 are published. As this is not a full report on educational progress, no attempt has been made to summarise and draw conclusions from the statements. I leave the figures to speak for themselves.

I take this opportunity to express my gratitude to the Provincial Governments and other authorities who have supplied the information on which these tables are based.






TOTAL NUMBER OF INSTITUTIONS
