## INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances exist in the field of Educational Development too just as in Urbanisation, industrialisation, distribution of income and wealth. With a view to highlight national variations in the educational sector, the Ministry of Human Resource Development brings out the publication Educational Statistics - District-wise quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. There after it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state every five years by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry in respect of some states. However for the quinquennial year 1976-77 such reviews were brought out for all the states and union territories with legislature.

3. For making inter district comparisons possible, some important indices such as Enrolment Ratio, Percentage of trained teachers and teacher pupil ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and are of much need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

### II. AREA AND POPULATION:

4. The area of West Bengal State is 88752 Sq. Kms. as per 1981 Census. It consists of 16 districts. The number of districts in the State remained the same during the period 1978-1982. The district-wise area in West Bengal varies from 14136 sq.kms. in case of

24 Parganas to 104 Sq. Kms. in case of Calcutta.

5. The estimated population of West Bengal State was 514.51 lakhs (271.54 lakhs males and 242.97 lakhs females) in 1978 whereas according to 1981 census, the estimated population was 557.13 lakhs (291.35 lakhs males and 265.78 lakhs females) in 1982. The population varies among the districts from 109.62 lakhs in 24 Parganas followed by Midnapore (62.83 lakhs) to 10.46 lakhs in Darjeeling district.

6. The overall density of population per sq. km. was 586 in 1978 which increased to 620 in 1982 at State level. The density of population in 1982 varied widely among the districts from 32436, the highest in Calcutta district to 302, the lowest in Purulia district. The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the year 1978 and 1982 are given in Table I. General view of the extent of variation in area, population and density is given below:-

7. The population of the State of different age-groups for the years 1978 and 1982 given in this report are based on the revised population (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of the Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 are based on the following formula :-

We assume that

8. To get the sex-wise break-up of total population in the various age-groups of the districts, first the population of girls is estimated by using the above formula. The boys population is obtained by subtracting girls population from total enumerated population.

9. The total population of children in the age-group 6-11 was 69.41 lakhs (34.97 lakhs boys and 34.44 lakhs girls) in 1978 which is estimated to have increased to 71.27 lakhs (36.13 lakhs boys and 35.14 lakhs girls) by 1982. In 1982, 6-11 age-group population formed 12.6% of the total population.

10. The total population of children in the age-group 11-14 was 30.30 lakhs (19.40 lakhs boys and 10.90 lakhs girls) in 1978 which is estimated to have increased to 41.20 lakhs (21.05 lakhs boys and 20.23 lakhs girls) by 1982. The percentage of population in the age group 11-14 to total population in 1982 was 7.4%.

11. Similarly the population in the age-group 14-17 in 1978 was 35.31 lakhs (18.19 lakhs boys and 17.12 lakhs girls) which is estimated to have increased to 50.87 lakhs (26.23 lakhs boys and 24.64 lakhs girls) by 1982. Population in the age-group 14-17 formed 9.1% of the total population in 1982.

12. Out of the total Census population of 557.13 lakhs in 1982 of the State, the school-going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 163.41 lakhs consisting of 83.41 lakhs boys and 80.00 lakhs girls. The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted **29.3%** of the total population. The percentage for boys was 29.6% while for girls it was 30.1%. The district-wise population of different age-groups is given in Appendix No. 3.

### III. LITERACY :

13. According to the 1981 Census the effective literacy rate i.e. the number of

literates per hundred of the population in the West Bengal State is 40.9. The literacy rates for males and females is 50.7 and 30.3 per hundred respectively. The highest literacy is in 24-Parganas (72.8) and the lowest in Malda (23.1). The literacy rate of Scheduled Castes is 24.4 and that of Scheduled Tribes 13.2 at state level. The details are given in the Appendix No.6.

#### IV. GENERAL VIEW.

##### (a) INSTITUTIONS :

14. The total number of Educational Institutions in West Bengal was 52830 in 1977-78 which increased to 67639 by 1981-82 showing an annual rate of increase of 7.0% during the period of 4 years. 24-Parganas district had the largest share of Institutions (16.6%) whereas Darjeeling had the lowest (2.4%) in 1981-82. The district-wise position of Institutions is given in Appendix No.1.

##### (b) ENROLMENT :

15. The total enrolment in all recognised Educational Institutions in the State increased from 75.61 lakhs in 1977-78 to 100.44 lakhs in 1981-82. The enrolment increased with an average annual growth rate of 8.2%. 24-Parganas had the largest share in enrolment i.e. 13.3% whereas Darjeeling had the lowest share of enrolment

i.e. 2.2% in 1981-82. District-wise position of enrolment and percentage share is given in Appendix No.1.

16. The percentage of Girls enrolment to Total enrolment was 37.6 in 1977-78 which slightly increased to 39.5 by 1981-82. Among the districts Darjeeling had the maximum 43.4 percentage of Girls enrolment to Total enrolment whereas Purulia had the minimum (29.1) in 1981-82. Out of 16 districts there were ten districts in which percentage of girls enrolment was below to that of state percentage. Details are shown in Appendix No. 4.

(c) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES :

17. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes or the co-efficient of equality is defined as :-

$$I = \frac{\text{Percentage of Enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to Total enrolment}}{\text{Percentage of population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to Total population}} \times 100$$

18. In West Bengal in 1981-82 the percentage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes students to total number of students was 14.5% (15.1% for boys and 13.5% for girls) and 3.4% (4% for boys and 2.4% for girls) respectively. The percentage for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes population to total population was estimated to be 22.0% and 5.6%

respectively. Therefore the extent of coverage or coefficient of equality at state level works out to be 65.9% and 59.8% respectively. In case of Scheduled Caste students the highest extent of coverage was in Cooch Behar (105.4) and the lowest in Burdwan (37.1). There are six districts which reported extent of coverage less than that at State level. On the other hand extent of coverage varied from 140.3% in Murshidabad to 22.6% in Burdwan in case of Scheduled Tribes students. There are five districts which reported extent of coverage below to that at State level District-wise position for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes students can be seen from Appendix 7 and 8 respectively.

(d) TEACHERS :

19. The total number of teachers in the State in all educational institutions increased from 2,40,542 in 1977-78 to 3,04,109 in 1981-82, showing an average Annual rate of increase of 6.6% during 1977-82. 24-Parganas had the largest share of teachers (17.9%) whereas Darjeeling had the smallest i.e. 2.1%. Details may be seen in Appendix No.1.

20. In 1981-82 total number of teachers upto school level was 304,109 (239,362 males and 64,796 females) out of which 167,598 (131,065 males and 36,533 females) were trained teachers. The percentage of trained teachers to the number of males, females total number of teachers in school education was 54.7%, 56.4% and 56.1% respectively. Details may be seen in Apperdx No.5.

V-PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

21. The number of recognised Pre-Primary schools in West Bengal increased from 181 in 1977-78 to 191 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 5.5% during the period of 4 years. 24-Pargana reported the highest number of 43 primary schools, though there is no increase from 1977-78 to 1981-82 and West Dinajpore district had no pre-primary school either in 1977-78 or in 1981-82.

Number of teachers in pre-primary schools increased from 493 in 1977-78 to 517 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 4.9%.

22. Enrolment in Pre-Primary schools increased from 13,181 to 16496 (9467 boys and 7,029 girls). However the enrolment in Pre-Primary/Nursery classes increased from 19633 (11061 boys and 8572 girls) in 1977-78 to 22,658 (12,926 boys and 9,732 girls) by 1981-82. In 1977-78 out of 19633 only 918 (4.7%) students (562 boys and 356 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 262 (1.3%) students (160 boys and 94 girls) to Scheduled Tribes, whereas in 1981-82 the enrolment percentage of S.C. and S.T. students was 6.9% and 3.5% respectively. District-wise position is given in Appendix No.9. It has been observed that of these 191 Pre-Primary schools the substantial number viz.71 existed in rural areas. Accordingly the enrolment viz. 9142 (55.4%) belongs to the rural belt. District-wise details are given in Appendix No.10.

PRIMARY EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS.

23. Total number of Primary Schools in West Bengal State increased from 41603 in 1977-78 to 47626 in 1981-82. The highest percentage share of Primary schools was in 24 Parganas (16.3%) and the lowest in Darjeeling (2.0%). Average area served by a Primary school in 1977-78 was 2.1 sq.kms. and the same was 1.9 sq. kms. in 1981-82. The average area served by a Primary school was minimum in Calcutta (0.1 'sq. kms.) and maximum in Jalpaiguri district (3.9 sq. kms.) in 1981-82.

24. The average population served by a Primary school in the state was 1237 in 1977-78 but facilities slightly improved on an average a primary school was available for 1176 in 1981-82. Among the districts the facilities of primary schools was maximum in Purulia as on average a primary school served 664 persons whereas it was maximum in case of Calcutta as for 2599 persons only a primary school was available. Details are given in Appendix 11.

25. The total number of teachers in Primary schools in West Bengal increased from 100447 in 1977-78 to 172201 in 1981-82. In 1981-82 the highest percentage share of teachers was in 24 Parganas district i.e. 15.6% and the lowest in Darjeeling district i.e. 2.4%. Women teachers formed 18.7% of the total teachers in Primary schools in 1981-82.

## Enrolment

26. The total enrolment in Primary schools in West Bengal increased from 5072350 in 1977-78 to 64,97,856 in 1981-82. In classes I-V, the enrolment increased from 5596671 (34,29,280 boys and 2167391 girls) to 6786519 (4009650 boys and 2776869 girls) during this period with an average Annual increase of 5.3%. Education has been progressing at Primary school level in the state.

27. The percentage of enrolment in Classes I-V to the corresponding population in the age-group 6-11 (also called the Enrolment Ratio) gives an index of the faculties created at Primary stage of education. In West Bengal this percentage increased from 80.6% to 95.2% during the period under review. In case of boys, the enrolment ratio increased from 90.1% to 111.0% and for girls the increase was from 62.9% to 79.0%. In 1981-82, the enrolment ratio was maximum (123.7% in Darjeeling and minimum in Calcutta (71.4%). In 6 districts the enrolment ratio works out below to that of state figure. In case of girls the enrolment varied from 113.3% in Darjeeling to 56.8% in Purulia. In 11 districts the enrolment ratio works out below to the State level percentage. In 1981-82 the number of teachers in primary schools was 172201 (139957 men and 32244 women). The pupil-teacher ratio was 38. 55.1% teachers were trained in the primary schools (55.6% men and 53.8% women). The District-wise details are given in Appendix 13.

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES :

28. In 1981-82, out of 67.87 lakhs in Classes I-V, 11.71 lakhs and 2.68 lakhs belonged to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes forming 17.3% and 4.0% respectively. Hence the extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in these classes works out to be 70.6% and 71.4% respectively. District-wise details of enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and their percentage etc. are given in Appendix No.14 and 15.

PRIMARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS :

29. In 1981-82 of the total 47626 primary schools, 40866 (85.8%) existed in rural areas. Maximum number of primary schools have been reported in rural areas of Murshidabad (7294) followed by West Dinajpore (5914) and the minimum viz. 798 in Darjeeling rural areas. Enrolment in all the primary schools of the rural areas of the state was 5044853. At the same time provisional enrolment in Primary Classes I-V in rural areas was 47.95 lakhs forming 29.35 lakhs boys and 18.60 lakhs girls. District-wise details are given in Appendix 16.

30. The total number of habitations in the State in 1981-82 was 47,139. Out of these 47139 habitations, 30176 habitations had Primary Schools in them and 16,903 had Primary schools within a distance of 2 Kms. during the period 1981-82. District-wise position is given in Statement No.17.

MIDDLE EDUCATION

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS :

31. The total number of Middle schools in the State increased from 3207 in 1977-78

to 3695 in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 3.6% during the period of 4 years. In 1981-82 the largest number of middle schools were reported in 24 Parganas (773) and lowest in Darjeeling (46).

32. On an average, a middle school served an area of 27.4 sq. kms. in 1977-78. The position slightly improved by 1981-82 as there was a middle school available for every 24.0 sq. kms. In 1981-82 the middle school facilities were the maximum in Calcutta as for every 0.8 sq. kms. a school was avialable but the minimum in case of Darjeeling (63.5 sq. kms.)

33. The population served by a middle school in the State was 16043 in 1977-78 but the facility slightly eclined as a middle school was available for 15078 persons in 1981-82. Among the districts, the population served by a middle school in 1981-82 varied from 9990 in Midnapore to 27425 in Calcutta. Details are given in Appendix No.18. The number of teachers in Middle schools also increased from 15122 in 1977-78 to 21042 in 1981-82. District-wise particulars are given in Appendix No.20.

#### ENROLMENT

34. The total enrolment in middle schools was 5.06 lakhs in 1977-78 which increased to 6.04 lakhs in 1981-82 at an average annual increase of 4.8%. The enrolment at middle stage i.e. in classed VI-VIII, increased from 1287391 (814508 boys and 472803 girls) in 1977-78 to 1901096 (1150641 boys and 750455 girls) in 1981-82.

This shows an average annual increase of 11.9%. The average annual enrolment increase separately for boys and girls comes out to be 10.3% and 14.7% respectively.

35. The percentage of enrolment in Classes VI-VIII to corresponding population in the Age-Group 11-14 years i.e. enrolment ratio, gives an index of facilities available at the middle stage of education. In West Bengal this percentage was 33.6 (42.0 for boys and 25.0 for girls) in 1977-78 which increased to 46.1 (54.7 for boys and 37.1 for girls) in 1981-82. In 1981-82 the enrolment ratio was maximum in Howrah district (72.6%). Enrolment ratio was minimum in Jalpaiguri (19.7%). In 10 districts the enrolment ratio was below to that at State level. District-wise position is given in Appendix No.19.

#### ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

36. Of the total enrolment of 1207391 in Classes VI-VIII 67503 (48203 boys and 18695 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 13084 (13293 boys and 4794 girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes in 1977-78 forming 5.2% of the total enrolment. In 1981-82 out of total enrolment of 1901096 in these classes, 108256 (126924 boys and 61322 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 42,271 (31,152 boys and 11119 girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes, forming 9.9% and 2.2% respectively. Hence the coefficient of equality for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes works out to 45% and 39.3% respectively. District-wise particulars are given in Appendix No.21 and 22.

37. Out of 3695 middle schools in the state, 3016 belonged to rural areas. Murshidabad district rural areas reported the highest number of middle schools (639) and the lowest number was 31 in Darjeeling. Enrolment in middle schools of rural areas was 5.11 lakhs in 1981-82 which forms 64.4% of enrolment of classes VI-VIII of whole of the State. District-wise position of middle schools and enrolment has been depicted in Appendix No. 23.

38. The total number of habitations in the State in 1981-82 were 47139. Out of 47139 habitations only 5243 had middle schools in them, 19861 habitations had middle schools upto 2 kms. and 22035 habitations had middle schools from 2 to 5 kms. in the State. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 24.

#### ENROLMENT BY STANDARD

39. Appendix 25 depicts standard-wise enrolment from Class I to VIII. At State level the decreasing trend of enrolment in each class over the previous class has been observed. Percentage enrolment of Class V to that of Class I worked out to 36.3% and of Class VIII to Class I as 24.5%. District-wise details are given in Appendix 25.

#### HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION

#### INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

40. There were 3921 High Higher Secondary schools in 1977-78 which increased to 5125 in 1981-82 showing an annual increase of 7.7% during the period of 4 years. These

schools in 1981-82 included 4087 High and 1038 Higher Secondary schools of 10 + 2 Pattern. Among the districts, during 1981-82 the largest number of High/Higer Secondary schools (1031) existed in 24 Parcanas and the smallest number of schools in Darjeeling (82).

41. On an average, there was a High/Higer Secondary school for every 22.4 sq. kms. in 1977-78. By 1981-82 the position improved considerably and a school was then available for every 17.3 sq.kms. In 1981-82 in Calcutta district a High/Higer Secondary school was available for every 0.2 sq.kms. whereas in Jalpaiguri district a school was available for an area of 46.1 sq.k

42. At the state level there was a High/Higer Secondary school available for every 13,12 persons in 1977-78. By 1981-82, a High/Higer Secondary school was available for every 10,871 persons. Among the districts in 1981-82, the average population served by a High/Higer Secondary school varied from as high as 17,919 in case of West Dinajpore district to as low as 7,087 in Calcutta district. District-wise details of High/Higer Secondary schools are given Appendix 26.

43. The total number of teachers in High/Higer Secondary schools in West Bengal increased from 55,786 in 1977-78 to 43,181 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 67.00% during the period of four years. The increase in teachers was observed in all the districts. Women teachers formed 24.4% of the total number of teachers in 1981-82. District-wise particulars are given in Appendix No. 28.

#### ENROLMENT

44. The total enrolment in High/Higer Secondary schools of the State was 1555240

in 1977-78 which increased to 2573419 in 1981-82, showing an average annual increase of 16.4%. The enrolment in classes IX-XII in 1977-78 was 513863 (352116 boys and 161747 girls). In 1981-82 the enrolment in classes IX-XII increased to 1122259 (750117 boys and 372142 girls) showing an average annual increase of 29.6%. The average annual increase in enrolment of boys and girls separately works out to be 28.3% and 32.5% respectively.

45. The enrolment ratio for West Bengal state at the High/Higer Secondary stage i.e. in classes IX-XII increased from 14.6 (19.4 for boys and 9.4 for girls) in 1977-78 to 22.1% (28.6% for boys and 15.1% for girls) in 1981-82. Among the Districts in 1981-82, the enrolment ratio varied from 53.2 in Howrah to 8.2% in case of West Dinajpore district. Details are given in Appendix No. 27.

#### ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

46. Of the total enrolment of 513863 in Classes IX-XII 123421 (91720 boys and 31701 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 27424 (21215 boys and 6209 girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes in 1977-78 forming 24.0% and 5.3% respectively of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82, out of 1122259 enrolled in classes IX-XII 72245 (52529 boys and 19423 girls) belonged to Scheduled castes and 14006 (9876 boys and 4130 girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 6.4% and 1.2% respectively of the total enrolment in these classes. Thus the coefficient of equality for Scheduled Caster and Scheduled Tribes works out to be 29.1% and 21.4% respectively. District-wise details of Scheduled

Castes and Scheduled Tribes enrolment and their corresponding percentages are given in Appendices No.29 and 30.

#### HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

47. Out of 5125 High/Higer Secondary schools in the state in 1981-82, 3369 belonged to those in rural areas. Among the rural areas of different districts maximum number viz. 653 existed in rural areas of West Dinahpore district in 1981-82. At the same time, of the total enrolment in High/Higer Secondary schools in the state 1353182 or 52.6% belonged to that of rural areas. Enrolment of classes IX to X in rural areas also works out to 450631 (310395 boys and 130236 girls). This enrolment forms 61.8% of total enrolment in the state. District-wise particulars are given in Appendix 31.

#### PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

48. The number of schools for professional, vocational, special and other (school) Education in 1977-78 were 3910 which rose to 11,002 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 280.8% during the period of 4 years.

49. Total enrolment in professional, vocational, special and other (school) education increased from 143087 (96913 boys and 46174 girls) in 1977-78 to 352233 (229770 boys and 122463 girls) in 1981-82. Out of 143087 students in these classes in 1977-78, 27112 (16352 boys and 8760 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 7658 (5993 boys and 1665 girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 19.9% and 5.4% respectively to the total

enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82 out of 3,52,233 students 44946 (28602 boys and 16344 girls) belonged to Scheduled Castes and 17433 (11194 boys and 6239 girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 12.8% and 4.9% respectively of the total number of students in these classes. Number of teachers in Professional, Vocational, Special and Other (school) Education increased from 7129 in 1977-78 to 17248 in 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Appendix 32.
