

INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances exist in the field of Educational Development too just as in Urbanisation, industrialism ... distribution of income and wealth. With a view to highlight national variations in the educational sector, the Ministry of Human Resource Development brings out the publication "Educational Statistics-District-Wise" quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. There after it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state every five years by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry in respect of some states. However for the quinquennial year 1976-77 such reviews were brought out for all the states and Union Territories with legislature.

3. For making inter district comparisions possible, some important indices such as Enrolment Ratio , Percentage of trained teachers and teacher-pupil ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show vide range of variations between the districts and are of much need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

11. AREA AND POPULATION

4. Total Area of State is 173877 sq. kms. as per 1981 census. It had 31 districts in 1976 but in 1981 two new districts namely Maghepura and Khagria were formed making 33 districts in the state. The district-wise area in Bihar varies from 1918 sq-kms. in case of Begusarai district to 18266 sq. kms. in case of Ranchi district. The figure shown at item No. 34 against the title Anglo-Indians under Col. 2 pertains to the Anglo Indian students spread all over the State and are not included in any district during the 1976-77 year.

5. The population of Bihar was 633.78 lakhs in 1977. For 1982, the estimated population is 714.821 (367.17 lakhs males and 347.65 lakhs females). The highest population was in Santhal Paragana district (35.88 lakhs) and lowest in Gopal Ganj District (12.48 lakhs) in 1977. In 1982 also the estimated population varied widely among the 33 districts from 38.01 lakhs in Santhal Paragana district to 11.24 lakhs in Nawada district.

6. The over all density of population per sq. km. was 364 in 1977 & is estimated to have increased to 411 in 1982. The density of population per sq. km. in 1982 varied widely among districts viz. from 964 the highest in Patna to only the lowest in Palamu. The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the years 1976-77 and 1981-82 are given in Appendix No. I. The table No. I below gives a general view of the extent of variations in area, population and the density of population in 1982.

7. The total population of the state as well as population of different age groups for the year 1977 and 1982 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 31st March of the year) available from the office of Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 are based on the following formula:-

We assume that:

$$\frac{P_{6-11}}{P} = \frac{P_{i\ 6-11}}{P_i} = K$$

Where K = is estimated from the formula

P_{6-11} = denote 6-11 age group population of the State

P = Total population of the State.

P^i_{6-11} = 6-11 age group population of i th District.

P^i = Total population of the i th District.

To get the sex-wise break up of the total population in the various age-groups of the district, first of all the girls population is estimated using the above equation. with the only difference that in the above formula total population is replaced by the girls population. The boys population is obtained by the residual method i.e. Boys Population in the age-group 6-11 = Total Population in the age-group 6-11-Girls Population in the age group 6-11.

Similar formulae are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-groups 11-14 and 14-17 years.

8. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 100.59 lakhs in 1982 (51.67 lakhs boys and 48.92 lakhs girls) which constituted 14.1% of the total populations of the State.

9. Similarly the estimated population in the age-group 11-14 years was 53.31 lakhs in 1982 (27.63 lakhs boys and 25.68 lakhs girls) which constituted 7.5% of the total population of the state.

10. The population in the age-group 14-17 in 1982 estimated was 61.10 lakhs consisting 32.05 lakhs boys and 29.05 lakhs girls. They formed 8.5% of the total population of the state.

Thus out of the total population of 714.82 lakhs of the State, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 215.00 lakhs consisting of 111.34 lakhs boys and 103.66 lakhs girls. The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 30.07% of the total population. The percentage for boys was 30.3% while for girls it formed 29.8%.

III- LITERACY

12. According to the 1981 census the literacy rate for the state as a whole was 26.2%. For males and females it was reported as 38.1% and 13.6% respectively indicating a wide gap between the two sexes. The literacy rate in respect of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes comes to 10.4% and 17.0% respectively at the state level. The district-wise detail of literacy rate in general as well as that of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes is given in Appendix No. 6.

IV- GENERAL VIEW

(a) Institutions:

13. The total number of Educational Institutions in Bihar was 65494 in 1976-77 which increased to 74455 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 13.7% during the period of 5 Years. The district of Santhal Pargana had the largest share of institutions (6.8%) and Khagaria district the lowest share (0.9%) in 1981-82. The district-wise position of Institutions is given in Appendix No. 1.

(b)

ENROLMENT:

14. The total enrolment in all Recognised Educational Institutions in the State increased from 75.24 lakhs in 1976-77 to 92.86 lakhs in 1981-82. The enrolment increased with an average annual rate of 4.7% Ranchi had the largest share in enrolment i.e. 5.3% whereas Khagaria has the lowest share of enrolment i.e. 1.0% during 1981-82. District-wise position of enrolment and their share is given in Appendix No. 1.

15. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was 26.6% in 1976-77 which slightly increased to 28.1% in 1981-82. Among the districts Sinhbhoom had the maximum (36.0%) of girls enrolment to total enrolment whereas West Champaran had the minimum (22.2%) in 1981-82. Out of the 33 District, 19 districts had less percentage of girls enrolment as compared to that of state percentage. Details are shown in Appendix No. 4

(c) Extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes:

16. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes of the co-efficient of equality is defined that:-

17. In Bihar State in 1981-82 the percentage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe students to total number of students was 10.8% (11.7% for boys and 8.3% for girls) and 8.3% (8.0% for boys and 8.8% for girls) respectively. The percentage for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes population to the total population was 14.5% and 8.1% respectively. Therefore, the extent of coverage of co-efficient for the year 1981-82 has been worked out as 74.5% in respect of Scheduled castes and 102.5% in respect of Scheduled Tribes. In case of Scheduled Castes students the highest extent of coverage was in Sinhbhoom (114.6%) and the lowest was in Gaya (55.3%) and in case of Scheduled Tribes the extent of coverage was the highest in Patna (250.0) and the lowest in Nawada (10.0).

The District-wise details are given in Appendices No. 7 & 8

(d) Teachers :

18. The total number of teachers in the State in all the educational institutions increased from 217304 in 1976-77 to 251107 in 1981-82 showing an average annual rate of increase of 3.1% during this period. Santhal Pargana district has the largest share of teachers (5.7%) to the total number of teachers in the state whereas Khagaria district has the lowest share (1.1%). The details may be seen in Appendix No.1.

19. In 1981-82 the total number of teachers upto school level was 238657 (202522 males and 36135 females) out of which 223156 teachers (190366 males and 32800 females) were trained. The percentage of trained teachers to the number of males, females and total teachers in school education was 94.0%, 90.8% and 93.5% respectively. The percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers had minor variations among the districts of the state viz. 96.6% in Nalanda to 83.7% in Giridih district. The details may be seen in Appendix No.5.

PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION :

20. The number of Pre-Primary schools in Bihar reported as 3 in 1976-77 as well as in 1981-82. Similarly the total number of teachers remain unchanged i.e. total number of teachers were 20 in 1976-77 as well as in 1981-82.

21. Among the districts only Patna and Bhojpur have the schooling facility exclusively for Pre-Primary education. However Pre-Primary classes are attached to institutions in six other districts namely Gaya, West Champaran, Monohar, Dhanbad, Singhbhum and Ranchi also. Total enrolment in Pre-Primary classes increased from 1261 (708 boys and 553 girls) in 1976-77 to 1873 (12296 boys and 6410 girls) in 1981-82. Enrolment in these classes for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in 1981-82 was 1313 (852 boys and 456 girls) and 7582 (4575 boys and 3007 girls) respectively as against 47 (23 boys and 24 girls) and 19 (10 boys and 9 girls) only in 1976-77.

The district-wise details are given in Appendices Nos. 9 and 10.

VI. Primary Education :

(a) Institutions and Teachers :

22. The total number of Primary schools in Bihar decreased from 51244 in 1976-77 to 50340 in 1981-82 showing a minor decrease over 5 years i.e. 0.6%. The highest percentage of Primary schools was in Santhal Pargana (8.0%) and the lowest in Khagaria (0.9%).

23. On the average in 1976-77 a Primary school was serving 3.4 sq. kms. Over a period of 5 years also this portion has remained the same i.e. in 1981-82 also it was 3.4 sq. kms. In 1981-82 the average area served by a Primary school was the minimum (1.7 sq. kms.) in cases of Patna and Nalanda and the maximum (7.6 sq. kms.) in Palamu district.

24. The population served by a Primary school in the state registered an increase from 1237 to 1403 during the period of 5 years. Among the districts the population served by a Primary school varied from 930 in Santhal Paraganas to 2319 in Begusarai in 1981-82. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.11.

25. Total number of teachers also increased from 108565 in 1976-77 to 112349 in 1981-82. This shows an average annual increase of 0.7% during five years period. During this period the number of teachers increased in all the districts. The number of women teachers formed 15.4% of the total number of teachers in 1981-82. The highest percentage of teachers was 6.6% in Santhal Paraganas while the lowest percentage i.e. 1.09% was found in Khagaria district. The pupil teacher ratio was 38 in 1976-77 and 41 in 1981-82. The pupil teacher ratio varied from 32 in West Champaran district to 66 in Nalanda district. The detail can be seen from Appendix No.13.

(b) Enrolment :

26. In 1976-77, the total enrolment in Primary schools in Bihar was 41.66 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 46.53 lakhs in 1981-82. In classes I-V, the enrolment increased from 60.89 lakhs (43.47 lakhs boys and 17.42 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 to 69.42 lakhs (48.44 lakhs boys and 20.98 lakhs girls) in 1981-82 showing an average annual exponential growth rate of 2.8% per annum. The enrolment growth rates (compound) in these classes separately for boys and girls were 2.3% and 4.1% respectively, which shows that girls education is getting better deal in the State.

27. The percentage of enrolment in Classes I-V to the total population in the age group 6-11 (also called enrolment ratio) gives the index of the facilities created at the Primary stages of education in Bihar state decreased from 72.8 in 1976-77 to 69.0 in 1981-82 during the period of 5 years. In the case of boys alone the decrease in percentage was from 70.1 in 1976-77 to 69.7 in 1981-82 and in the case of girls this percentage remained the same during the period of five years. Among the various districts, taking boys and girls together, the enrolment ratio in 1981-82 was the highest in Nalanda (89.7%) and the lowest in Saharsa (40.5%). The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.12.

(c) Enrolment of SC and ST

28. Of the total enrolment of 60.89 lakhs in Classes I-V in 1976-77, 5.60 lakhs students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 5.62 lakh students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 9.2% (in both the cases) of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82, the enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes was 7.79 lakhs and 5.98 lakhs respectively forming 11.2% in case of Scheduled Castes and 8.6% in case of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment in Classes I-V. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.14 and 15.

VII. MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) Institutions and teachers

29. The total number of Middle schools in the state increased from 10422 in 1976-77 to 11631 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 11.6% during the period of 5 years. In 1981-82, the highest number of Middle schools was recorded in Santhal Pargana (696) forming 6.0% of the total number of Middle schools in the State.

30. On an average in 1976-77 a Middle school served an area of 16.7 sq. kms. This improved considerably in 1981-82 and a Middle school was then available for every 14.9 sq. kms. area. In 1981-82 the area served by a Middle school was less than that in 1976-77. The area served by a Middle school was the lowest in Patna district

(5.9 sq. kms.) and the highest in Hazaribagh District (33.7 sq. kms.) in 1981-82.

31. The population served by a Middle school in this state increased from 6081 in 1976-77 to 6146 in 1981-82. Among the districts the population served by a Middle School in 1981-82 varied from 3882 in Palamu District to 8835 in West Champaran district. The details are given in Appendix No. 18. The number of teachers in Middle schools also increased from 71918 in 1976-77 to 87369 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 21.5% during the period of 5 years i.e. an annual growth rate of 4.3%. In 1976-77 pupil teacher ratio was 32 which increased to 35 in 1981-82. Among the districts the teacher pupil ratio varied from 21 in Nalanda district to 43 in Gopalganj and Begusarai districts. The details can be seen in Appendix No. 20.

(b) Enrolment :

32. The total enrolment in Middle schools was 22.99 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 30.51 lakhs in 1981-82 showing an average annual growth rate of 6.5%. The enrolment at the middle stage i.e. in classes VI-VIII increased from 9.67 lakhs (7.80 lakhs boys and 1.87 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 to 14.30 lakhs (11.14 lakhs boys and 3.16 lakhs girls) in 1981-82. This shows an annual growth rate of 9.6% (8.6% for boys and 13.8% for girls) during the period under consideration.

33. The percentage of enrolment in Classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age-group 11-14 years i.e. enrolment ratio gives an index of the facilities at the Middle stage of education. In Bihar this percentage was 21.2% in 1976-77 which increased to 26.8% in 1981-82. In case of boys enrolment ratio was 33.1% in 1976-77 and 40.3% in 1981-82 and that of girls was 8.5% in 1976-77 and 12.3% in 1981-82. Taking boys and girls together, the percentage enrolment in case of 25 districts was more than the corresponding states percentage in 1981-82. At the Middle stage this percentage indicates a wide disparity between the two sexes in all the districts. However the position of girls improved slightly during the period of 1976-77 to 1981-82. In 1981-82 the highest enrolment was in Patna for boys and girls together (43.2) and the lowest was in case of Purnea (13.4). The details may be seen in Appendix No. 19.

(c) Enrolment of SC/ST

34. Of the total enrolment of 966901 in Classes VI-VIII, 66445 students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 57424 students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 6.9% and 5.9% respectively in 1976-77 of the total enrolment. Out of the total enrolment of 1430483, the number of students belonged to Scheduled Castes was 115356 and that of Scheduled Tribes was 95316 in 1981-82 forming 8.1% and 6.7% of the total enrolment in Classes VI-VIII respectively.

Middle School Education In Rural Areas

located

35. Out of the 11631 Middle schools in the State, 10097 were in Rural Areas. Santhal Pargana district covers the highest number (627) of Rural Area Middle schools and Kharagpur has the lowest (12) in the state during 1981-82. Enrolment of Middle schools in Rural Areas was 24.77 lakhs in 1981-82. District-wise position of the Rural area education at Middle level has been depicted in Appendix No. 20.

Enrolment by Standard:

36. Appendix No. 25 depicts the standard-wise enrolment from Class I to VIII. At state level, the decreasing trend of enrolment in each class over the previous class has been observed. Percentage enrolment of Class V to that of Class I worked out to 29.1% and of Class VIII to Class I as 15.0% only.

VIII. High/Higer Secondary Education

INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

37. There were 2972 High/Higer secondary schools in 1976-77 which increased to 3398 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 14.3% during the period of 5 years. These schools in 1981-82 included 3378 High and only 20 Higher secondary 10+2 Pattern schools. Among the

districts during 1981-82 the largest number of High/Higher secondary schools (195) existed in Patna and the lowest (44) in Maghepura district.

38. On an average there was a High/Higher secondary school for every 58.5 sq. kms. in 1976-77. By 1981-82 the position improved considerably and a school was then available for 51.2 sq. kms. In 1981-82, in Patna district a High/Higher secondary school was available in 16.4 sq. kms. whereas in Palamu a High/Higher secondary school was available in 161.4 sq. kms.

39. At the state level there was a High/Higher secondary school available for every 21325 persons in 1976-77. By 1981-82 a High/Higher secondary school was available for every 21037 persons. Among the districts in 1981-82, the average population served by a High/Higher secondary school varied from 13839 persons in Nalanda district to 37750 persons in Saharsa District. District-wise details of High/Higher secondary schools, area and population served by a High/Higher secondary school is depicted in Appendix No. 26.

40. The total number of teachers in High/Higher secondary schools in Bihar increased from 32601 in 1976-77 to 38919 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 19.4% during the period under consideration. The increase in teachers was observed in all the districts except West Champaran and Saharsa Districts. The women teachers formed 11.08% of the total number of teachers in High/Higher secondary schools. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 28.

Enrolment

41. The total enrolment in High/Higher secondary schools of the state was 971092 in 1976-77 which increased to 1243134 in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 5.7%. The enrolment in Classes IX-XI in 1976-77 was 370188 (326389 boys and 52799 girls). In 1981-82 the enrolment in Classes IX-XI increased to 556734 (464722 boys and 92012 girls) showing an average annual increase of 9.4%. The average annual increase in enrolment of boys and girls separately works out to be 8.5% and 14.9% respectively.

42. Enrolment ratio for Bihar state at the High/Higher secondary stage i.e. in Classes IX-XI remained the same i.e. 9.1% (15% for boys and 2.6% for girls) in 1976-77 and 9.1%

(14.5% for boys and 3.2% for girls) in 1981-82. Among the districts in 1981-82 the enrolment ratio varied from 16.6% in Patna to 4.6% in case of Palamu district. Details are given in Appendix No. 28.

Enrolment of SC/ST :

43. Of the total enrolment of 379188 in Classes IX to XI 24097 students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 22094 students belonged to Scheduled Tribes in 1976-77 which formed 6.3% and 5.8% respectively. In 1981-82 out of the total enrolment of 556734 in Classes IX-XI 36250 belonged to Scheduled Castes and 33011 students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 6.5% and 5.9% to the total enrolment respectively. The details of enrolment and percentage are given in Appendix No.29 and 30.

High/Higer Secondary Education in Rural Areas :

44. Out of the 3398 High/Higer secondary schools in 1981-82 in the State, 2733 were in Rural Areas. Among the Rural Areas of different districts, the largest number was in Gaya (149) and the minimum were in Khagaria district (32). The total enrolment of 1246134 students in High/Higer secondary schools in the state 840009 or 67.4% was of institutions in Rural Areas. The detail district-wise particulars are given in Appendix No.31.

INTERMEDIATE/PRE-DEGREE/JUNIOR COLLEGE EDUCATION

45. It has been observed that there are 9 Intermediate/Pre-Degree/Junior Colleges of Old Pattern in the State in 1981-82 whereas their number was 45 in 1976-77. In accordance with the enrolment of these institutions declined from 9475 (8700 boys and 775 girls) in 1976-77 to 2329 (1882 boys and 447 girls) in 1981-82. Among the districts, the highest enrolment is reported by Katihar (764) and the lowest by Nawada (44) in 1981-82.

46. In Intermediate/Pre-Degree/Junior Colleges, there were 662 teachers in 1976-77, which also declined to 110 (75 males and 35 females) teachers in 1981-82. District-wise position of Institutions, enrolment and teachers is given in Appendix No.32.

47. Out of 9 Intermediate/Pre-degree/Junior Colleges in 1981-82., 3 have been reported in Rural areas of the State. Enrolment of these institutions in rural areas is reported as

719. The highest enrolment is reported in rural areas of Falamu (446) and the lowest in Ranchi (273). District-wise details can be seen from Appendix No. 32.

Professional, Vocational, Special and Other (School) Education:

48. The number of schools for Professional, Vocational, Special and other (School level) Education in 1976-77 were 808 which rose to 8474 in 1981-82 may be due to inclusion of Social (Adult) Education centres. The total enrolment in Professional, Vocational, Special and other (School) Education schools increased from 35179 in 1976-77 to 333405 (22632 boys and 97013 girls) in 1981-82. During 1976-77 the enrolment belonging to Scheduled Castes was 956 and of Scheduled Tribes was 970. In 1981-82 it has been reported as 67516 (47872 boys and 19676 girls) students belonging to Scheduled Castes and 32510 (23046 boys and 9462 girls) students belonging to Scheduled Tribes. Total number of teachers in these institutions which were reported 3538 in 1976-77 increased to 12340 (10156 males and 2184 females) in 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 33.
