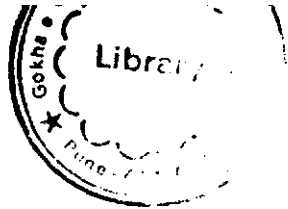

This volume on District-wise educational Statistics for the state of Rajasthan is the fourteenth in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the States and Union Territories. The main aim is to highlight the Inter-District variations in a State by giving educational data at District levels with the help of some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentage of trained teachers, pupil teacher ratio and area served by a school etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have widened or narrowed down with time, the data for the year 1981-82 have been analysed and compared with that of 1976-77.

I would like to take this opportunity to place on record my appreciation of the cooperation received from the Director Public Instruction, Rajasthan and the project staff of the Planning, Monitoring and Statistics Division who have prepared this report.

INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of educational development just as in urbanisation, industrilism, distribution of income and wealth etc. With a view to highlight the regional imbalances in the educational sector, the Ministry of Human Resource Development brought out the publication "Educational Statistics - District-wise quinquennially.

2. Volume of this nature was first published by the National Council of Educational Research & Training in 1960-61. Thereafter, it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each State, every five years by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out for all the States and Union Territories with legislature.

3. For making inter district comparision possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratio, percentage of trained teachers and teachers pupil ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and are of much need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

II - AREA AND POPULATION

4. The area of the Rajasthan State was reported as 342214 Sq.Kms in 1971 census and 342239 Sq.Kms in 1981 census. The number of districts in the State remained the same

during the period of 1976-77 to 1981-82. Among the district the area varies from as high as 38401 Sq.Kms in case of Jaisalmer to as low as 3770 Sq.Kms of Dungarpur.

5. The estimated population of Rajasthan State was 300.21 lakhs (156.63 lakhs males and 143.58 lakhs females) in 1977, which increased to 352.49 lakhs (183.51 lakhs males and 168.98 lakhs females) in 1982. The annual growth of the population work out to be 3.5 % during the period under consideration.

6. The overall density of population per Sq.Km was 87 in 1977 which is estimated to have increased to 103 in 1982. The density of population per Sq.Km. also varies widely among the districts viz. from the highest of 250 in Jaipur to only 32 in Bikaner in 1982. The area, total population and density of population for different districts for the year 1976-77 and 1981-82 are given in appendix No. 2. Table No. 1 gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and density of population in 1982.

7. The total population of the State as well as population of different districts in different age-groups for the year 1977 and 1982 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 1st March of the year) available from the office of the Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 are based on the following formula :-

8. To get the sex-wise break up of total population in the various age-groups of the district, first of all the girls population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in above formula total population is replaced by the girls population. The boys population is obtained simply by subtraction of girls population from total population.

9. Similar formulae are used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-group 11-14 and 14-17 years.

10. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 48.61 lakhs in 1982 (25.14 lakhs boys and 23.47 lakhs girls) which constituted 13.8 % of the total population.

11. The population in the age-group 11-14 years in 1982 was 26.28 lakhs (13.66 boys and 12.62 lakhs girls). This formed 7.5 % of the total population.

12. Similarly, the estimated population in the age-group 14-17 years was 30.90 lakhs (16.14 lakhs boys and 14.76 lakhs girls). This formed 8.8 % of the total population.

13. Thus, out of the total population of 352.49 lakhs of the State, the school going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 105.78 lakhs (54.94 lakhs boys and 50.84 lakhs girls). The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 30.0 % of the total population. This percentage for boys and girls were 29.94 % and 30.1 % respectively.

The district-wise details may be seen in Appendix No.3.

III - LITERACY

14. According to the 1981 census the effective literacy rate i.e. total number of literates per one hundred of population (excluding 0-4 age-group) was 23.7 for the State as a whole. The literacy rate for males was 35.3 whereas for females it was quite low i.e. only 11.1 at the State level. Number of literates per hundred in case of S.C & S.T. were 14.0 and 10.3 respectively. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No. 6

IV. GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS

15. The total number of educational institutions of school level in Rajasthan was 26,152 in 1976-77 which increased to 37,627 in 1981-82, showing an increase of 43.9 % during the period under review. In 1981-82, Jaipur had the highest share of

Institutions (8.5 %) and Sirohi the smallest share (1.4 %). The district-wise position of Educational Institutions is given in Appendix No. 1.

(b) ENROLMENT

16. The total enrolment in all the recognised educational institution (School level) in the State was 33.15 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 45.51 lakhs in 1981-82. Jaipur had the largest share of enrolment i.e. 11.9 % whereas Jaisalmer had the lowest share i.e. 0.5 % during 1981-82. An annual growth rate in enrolment is 7.5 % during the period under review.

17. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was 22.9 % in 1976-77 which slightly increased to 23.2 % in 1981-82. Percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was higher in 12 districts than that for the State as a whole but no district had higher percentage than that for All India viz. 36.6%. Sex-wise breakup of enrolment figures for different districts is given in Appendix No. 4.

(c) TEACHER

18. Total number of teachers in schools increased from 115030 in 1976-77 to 145257 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 26.3 % during the period under review. The increase has been observed in all the districts. In 1981-82 the total of 145257 school teachers 30853 or 21.2 % were female teachers in the State. Of the total of 145257 teachers, 129274 were trained forming 89.0 % of the total strength of teachers. Percentage of

trained teachers for male & female separately were 91.5 % & 79.5 % respectively in 1981-82. Taking male & female together the percentage was the highest in Ajmer (94.7) and the lowest in Jaisalmer (77.6). The percentage was better in 13 districts than the State average and in 21 districts better than India's of 85.9 %. District-wise details are in Appendix No.5.

(d) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES
EXTENT OF COVERAGE IS DEFINED AS :

19. Of the total enrolment in school education 603073 belonged to Scheduled Caste which comes out to 13.3 % of the total enrolment in the State. Among the districts the percentage of scheduled caste varies from 17.6 % in Ajmer to 4.5 % in Ban swara. Percentage of S.C. population to total population is 16.6 % in 1981-82 for the State as a whole. The extent of coverage for Scheduled Castes in School education comes to 79.5 % at State level. It varies from 120.4 % in Dungarpur to 50.6 % in Bikaner. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 7.

20. Enrolment percentage of Scheduled Tribes in school education is 9.4 % (10.3 % for boys and 6.4 % for girls) in 1981-82. The percentage is the highest in Banswara(55.3 %) and the lowest in Bikaner (0.5 %). Percentage population of S.T. to total population is 11.9 % for the state as a whole. Extent of coverage for this community therefore works

out to be 79.0 % at the state level. It varies from 600.0 % in Ganganagar to lowest in Sirohi (46.4 %). District-wise details can be seen from Appendix No. 8.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) Pre-Primary Schools

21. The number of Pre-Primary schools in Rajasthan increased from 28 in 1976-77 to 32 in 1981-82. Showing an annual increase ratio of 2.9 %.

(b) Teachers

22. Number of teachers also increased from 102 in 1976-77 to 177 in 1981-82.

There were 138 females teachers in Pre-Primary Schools in 1981-82. There were only 9 districts which had Pre-Primary Schools, however the classes were held in 22 districts.

(c) ENROLMENT

23. Enrolment in Pre-Primary schools which was 3033 in 1976-77 increased to 4,786 in 1981-82. Enrolment in Pre-Primary and Nursery classes was 27,352 (15,976 boys & 11,376 girls) in 1976-77 and it increased 61,272 (32923 boys & 28,349 girls) by 1981-82, showing an increase of 24.8 % per annum. In 1976-77 there were 1602 students (960 boys and 642 girls) belonging to scheduled castes and 491 students (342 boys & 149 girls) belonging to scheduled tribes in these classes. In 1981-82 there were 4729 students (2655 boys & 2074 girls) belonging to Scheduled Castes and 1128 students (708 boys & 420 girls)

belonging to Scheduled Tribes studying in Pre-Primary classes. District-wise details are given in Appendix No. 9.

(d) EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

24. In 1981-82 of the total 32 Pre-Primary schools in the State only 4 were in Rural Areas having an enrolment of 254 (129 boys & 125 girls). All Pre-Primary Schools in Rural Areas were located in two districts, Ajmer and Nagaur in 1981-82.

VI - PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS

25. The total number of Primary schools in Rajasthan increased from 19574 in 1976-77 to 23219 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 18.62 % over the period of 5 years.

26. In 1976-77 a Primary school in the state was serving an area of 17.5 Sq.Kms. In five years the position improved and a Primary School was available for every 14.7 Sq.Kms in 1981-82. In 1981-82 the average area served by a Primary School was minimum in case of Bharatpur (5.3 Sq.Kms) where as maximum area served by a Primary School was in Jaisalmer (128.4 Sq.Kms).

27. The average population served by Primary School in the State was 1534 in 1976-77 and the position improved slightly in 1981-82 and a school was then available for the population of 1518 persons. In 1981-82 population served by a Primary School was

minimum in Jaisalmer 836 and Mazimum in Jodhpur viz. 1968. The district-wise details may be seen in the Appendix No. 11.

(b) TEACHERS :

28. Total numbers of teachers in Primary School education in the State increased from 42,141 in 1976-77 to 49363 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 3.44 % per annum. In 1981-82 Primary teachers in different districts varied from the highest of 4698 in Jaipur to the lowest of 322 in Jaisalmer district. Pupil teacher ratio in Primary schools in 1976-77 was 38 which increased to 42 in 1981-82. The ratio in 1981-82 was better in 10 districts than the States' ratio and in 8 districts it was better than that of India's viz.39. In 1981-82 the percentage of trained teachers in Primary Schools was 90.8 (95.5 for males and 74.7 for females). The percentage of trained teachers for males and females together was the highest in Jaisalmer (99.7) and was the lowest in Banswara (78.2). Percentage was higher in 15 districts than States average and was higher in 21 districts than that of India's percentage viz. 86.6 %. District-wise details can be seen from Appendix No.13.

(c) ENROLMENT

29. The total enrolment in Primary Schools in Rajasthan during 1976-77 was 16.02 lakhs which increased to 20.75 lakhs in 1981-82. In classes I-V, the total enrolment in 1976-77 was 23.68 lakhs (17.93 lakhs boys and 5.75 lakhs girls) which increased to 29.93 lakhs

(22.50 lakhs boys and 7.35 lakhs girls) in 1931-82 showing an annual growth rate of 5.3 % during the period under review. The growth rate for boys and girls comes to 5.2 % and 5.6 % respectively.

30. The enrolment ratio in classes I-V to the corresponding population in the age group 6-11 gives an index of facilities created at primary stage of education. For Rajasthan this ratio increased from 55.6 to 61.6 during the period 1976-77 to 1981-82. The corresponding enrolment ratio for boys increased from 81.2 to 89.8 and for girls from 28.1 to 31.3 during this period. Taking both boys and girls together this enrolment ratio among the districts varied from the highest of 80.8 in Kota followed by Jhunjhunu 79.9 and lowest 41.8 in Barmer in 1981-82. In 12 districts the enrolment ratio was more than that of the state, but no district had better percentage than that of India's viz. 83.1 %. District-wise details are given in Appendix No.12.

(d) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

31. Of the total enrolment of 23.63 lakhs in classes I-V in 1976-77. 2.92 lakhs students belonged to scheduled caste and 1.31 lakhs belonged to scheduled tribes forming 12.33 % and 7.64 % respectively of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82 out of total enrolment of 29.93 lakhs, 4.23 lakhs students belonged to S.C. & 2.78 lakhs students belonged to S.T. in these classes. Thus the percentage of enrolment of S.C. & S.T.

students to total enrolment workout to be 14.1 % and 9.31 % respectively. The district-wise details are given in Appendix No.14 & 15.

(e) EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS :

32. Of the total number of Primary schools viz 23219 in the state, 20666 (89.0 %) were located in Rural Areas. Out of total enrolment (29.93 lakhs) in primary schools 15.85 lakhs were in Rural Areas. Percentage of Pucca Primary School & enrolment in classes I-V is not available at basic school. District-wise details of primary schools & their enrolment are given in Appendix No.16.

VII - MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

33. The total number of middle schools in the state increased from 4928 in 1976-77 to 5487 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 11.3 % during the period of 5 years. In 1981-82 the highest percentage of Middle schools was observed in Jaipur (9.6 %) and the lowest in Jaisalmer (0.9 %).

34. On an average in 1976-77, a Middle school served an area of 69.4 sq.kms. In 1981-82 the position improved slightly and a Middle school was available within an area of 62.4 Sq.Kms. The area served by a Middle school, less than the state average, in as many as 16 districts in 1981-82. The area served by a middle school was minimum in Jaipur(26.7)Sq.Kms and maximum in Jaisalmer(733.7 Sq.Kms.) in 1981-82.

35. The average population served by a Middle school in 1976-77 in Rajasthan was 6092 which increased marginally in 1981-82 to 6424. Among the districts the population served by a middle school varied from as low as Jaisalmer(5102) to as high as (6078) in Pali district in 1981-82.

36. The total number of teachers in Middle school was 44,265 in 1976-77 which increased to 45,948 in 1981-82 with an annual growth rate of 0.8 % during the period under review. Teacher pupil ratio in 1976-77 was 25 which increased to 28 in 1981-82. It varies from as low as 14 in Jaisalmer to the highest of 37 in Jhunjhunu. The ratio was higher in 12 districts than the states ratio & almost in all districts it was lower than India's viz.34. Percentage of trained teacher to total no. of teachers were 97.3 (97.5 for male & 86.4 for female). All the districts in Rajasthan had higher percentage of trained teachers, when compared to that of India's viz. 89.8. District-wise details can be seen from Appendix No.17 & 19.

(b) ENROLMENT :

37. Total enrolment in Middle school was 11.15 lakhs which increased to 13.05 lakhs by the year 1981-82 at state level. The enrolment in Middle classes for the state as a whole was 5.89 lakhs (4.77 lakhs boys and 1.12 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 which increased to 8.28 lakhs (6.67 lakhs boys and 1.61 lakhs girls) by 1981-82 showing an annual growth rate of 8.12 % during the period under review. Among the districts, the highest enrolment was

98.5 thousands in Jaipur followed by 54.1 thousands in Alwar and the lowest in case of Jaisalmer (2.8 thousands).

38. The enrolment ratio at the Middle stage which is defined as the percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age-group 11-14 years gives an index of facilities created at the Middle stage education. For the state as a whole the enrolment ratio was 25.1 % (33.4 % for boys and 10.1 % for girls) in 1976-77. In 1981-82 the enrolment ratio increased to 31.5 % (43.3 % for boys and 12.3 % for girls). Among the districts the percentage of enrolment was the highest in case of Jhunjhunu (45.9 %) followed by Kota (39.4 %) and the lowest of 16.1 % in Barmer. In 1981-82 the enrolment ratio was higher for boys and girls combined in 11 districts than that of states ratio & higher only in Jhunjhunu than that of India's ratio viz. 43.3. District-wise details of enrolment in middle education are given in Appendix No.18.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTE AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

39. Of the total enrolment of 5,88,964 in classes VI-VIII, 50773 and 28,822 students belonged to scheduled caste & Scheduled Tribes forming 8.6 % and 4.9 % respectively in 1976-77. In 1981-82, out of 828200 enrolment in classes VI-VIII, 88397 and 87895 students belonged to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes respectively. The percentage of S.C. & S.T. enrolment to total enrolment in these classes works out to be 10.7 % & 10.6 % respectively. District-wise details may be seen in Appendix No.20 & 21.

(d) MIDDLE EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

40. Out of 5487 middle schools in the state 4398 (80.2 %) were in Rural Areas in 1981-82. and in these schools the enrolment was 884836, which forms 67.78 % of the total enrolment in all middle schools. Percentage of pucca Middle schools in the Rural Areas & enrolment in classes VI-VIII is not available.

VII - ENROLMENT BY STANDARD

41. Appendix No.23 depicts standard-wise enrolment from class I to VIII. At state level the percentage enrolment of class V to that of class I worked out to be 37.5 % and of class VIII to the class I as 22.8 %. The percentage of enrolment in classes II and above declined in comparison to class I except in class VI which remained same as that in class V.

VIII HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

42. Rajasthan had 1451 High/Higher secondary schools in 1976-77 and the number increased to 2542 by 1981-82 showing an increase of 75.19 % during the period of 5 years. The largest share of High/Higher secondary schools was in Jaipur district (10.1 %) and the lowest being in Jalora district (1.46 %).

43. On an average, there was a High/Higher secondary school for every 235.8 Sq.Kms. in 1976-77. The position improved by 1981-82 and a High/Higher secondary school was

available for every 134.6 sq.kms at the state level. In 1931-82, among the districts, this area varies from as high as 4800.1 Sq.Kms in case of Jaisalmer to as low as 65.2 Sq.Kms in case of Jhunjhunu.

44. On an average, at the state level, there was a High/Hr.Secondary School for every 20690 persons in 1976-77. The position improved during the period under review in 1981-82 and a High/Hr. Secondary School was available for every 13867 persons. Among the district the average population served by a High/Hr.Secondary school varied from 8904 in Jhunjhunu to 25114 in case of Jalora district.

45. The total number of teachers in High/Hr.Secondary schools in 1976-77 was 26994 which increased to 41798 in 1981-82 showing average annual increase of 10.9 % during the period. Pupil teacher ratio in High/Hr.Sec. schools in 1976-77 was 21 which increased to 23 in 1981-82, highest being 28 in Alwar & Sawai-madhopur and lowest being 12 in Jaisalmer. Pupil teacher ratio for All India in these schools was 27 in 1981-82 and 11 districts except two had better Teacher Pupil ratio than the corresponding figure for India. Percentage of trained teachers to total no. of teachers in these schools was 97.1 (97.6 for male & 95.1 for female). The district-wise statistics of High/Hr.secondary schools, teachers, area and population served by High/Hr. Secondary school are given in Appendix No. 24 & 26.

(b) ENROLMENT

- 18 -

46. The total enrolment in High/Hr. secondary schools in the state in 1976-77 was 5.60 lakhs which increased to 9.47 lakhs in 1981-82. In 1976-77, the enrolment in classes IX-XI/XII was 2.92 lakh (2.42 lakh boys and 0.50 lakh girls) and the same increased to 4.47 lakhs (3.72 lakhs boys and 0.75 lakhs girls) by 1981-82. This shows an average annual growth rate of 10.62 % (10.74 % for boys and 10.0 % for girls).

47. The enrolment ratio/classes IX to XII in Rajasthan state was 13.9 % in 1976-77 which marginally increased to 14.5 % by 1981-82. In the case of girls this percentage is constant on 5.1 % whereas this increased for boys from 21.8 % to 23.1 %. Among the districts in 1981-82, the enrolment ratio varied from 20.8 % in Jaipur to 4.4 % in Jalora District. The enrolment ratio was found to be higher in 11 districts than the states ratio and was higher in only 5 districts than that of India's viz. 18.0. District-wise details of enrolment are given in Appendix No. 24 & 25.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SC & ST

48. In 1976-77 the percentage of SC & ST students to total enrolment was 7.3 % & 3.8 % respectively. In 1981-82, out of 946766 students in these classes, there were 41366 students belonging to Scheduled Caste and 25638 students belonging to scheduled tribes forming 9.4 % and 5.7 % respectively of the total enrolment.

(d) HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS :

49. Out of 2542 High/Hr.Secondary schools in the state 1773 (68.3 %) were located in Rural Areas. Among the Rural Areas of different districts maximum number viz.167 existed in Rural Areas of Jaipur. The enrolment in High/Hr. Secondary schools in the state was 464795 or 49.1 % in Rural Areas. District-wise position is given in Appendix No.29.

IX. PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTION AND TEACHERS

50. The number of schools for professional, vocational, special and other(School) Education in the state increased from 171 in 1976-77 to 6347 in 1981-82 showing an annual increase of 722.4 % during the period under review, this abnormal increase is because of inclusion of Adult Education schools. The highest percentage share of schools of these type of institutions in 1981-82 was in Jaipur (8.9 %) and the lowest in Bikaner (0.04 %). The number of teachers in these schools increased from 1538 in 1976-77 to 7951 in 1981-82.

(b) ENROLMENT

51. Total enrolment in professional, Vocational, special and other (Schools) Education also increased from 38711 in 1976-77 to 218573 (38711 boys and 164570 girls) in 1981-82

showing an average annual increase of 92.9 %. In 1976-77 out of the total enrolment 2439 belonged to scheduled caste and 867 students belonged to scheduled tribes forming 6.3 % and 2.2 % respectively of the total enrolment. In 1981-82 out of the total enrolment of 218573 students in these schools 44751 (39638 boys and 5113 girls) students belonged to scheduled castes and 33369 (27123 boys and 6746 girls) students belonged to scheduled tribes forming 20.5 % and 15.5 % respectively. District-wise details are given in Appendix No.30.
