# SELECTED INFORMATION ON SCHOOL EDUCATION IN INDIA 1996-97

#### INTRODUCTION

In Pursuance of recommendations of Kothari Commission (1964-66) and the National Policy on Education 1968 and 1986 a uniform structure of school education called 10+2 system has been adopted by all states and Union Territories of India. Wowever within the States and UTs there remains variations on number of classes of Primary, upper Primary, High and Higher Secondary School stages, age for admission to class I, medium of instructions, public examinations, teaching of Hindi and English, number of working days in a year, academic sessions and vacation periods, fee structure, compulsory education etc. The publication is an attempt to provide information on these items for all the states and Union Territories. Wherever an information for a year is not received from a State/UT. the latest avaialable information is repeated. This year reports from Andhra Pradesh (Higher Secondary stage) J&K, and Nagaland have not been received.

2. The items included in this publication are discussed briefly in the following paragraphs;

#### I STAGES OF SCHOOL EDUCATION IN INDIA

- (a) The Primary Stage consists of Classes I-V, i.e., of five years duration in 19 States/UTs.namely Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, A&N Islands, Chandigarh, Delhi, and Karaikal & Yanam regions of Pondicherry. The primary stage consists of classes I-IV in Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, West Bengal, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Lakshdweep and Mahe region of Pondicherry. In Nagaland the Primary Stage consists of Pre-primary, A, B, I-IV classes.
- (b) The Middle Stage of education comprises Classes VI-VIII in as many as 17 States/UTs.viz, Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, A & N Islands, Chandigarh, Delhi and Karaikal region of Pondicherry; Classes V-VII in 11 States/UTs., namely, Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep and Mahe region of Pondicherry and classes VI-VII in Andhra Pradesh, Orissa and Yanam region of Pondicherry. Nagaland and West Bengal have upper primary stage of four years duration in classes V-VIII.

(c) Secondary Stage consists of Classes IX-X in 19 States/UTs., viz., Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, J&K., Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Nagaland, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, A. & N. Islands, Chandigarh, Delhi and Karaikal region of Pondicherry. High School stage comprises of classes VIII to X in 13 states /UTs, viz Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Karanataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Orissa, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep and Mahe & Yanam regions of Pondichery However, Hr. Secondary/Sr. Secondary Stage of school comprising classes XI-XII (10+2 Pattern) is available in all the States/UTs though in some states/UTs these classes are attached to Universities/Colleges.

State/UT-wise details for different stages of School Education are given in Statement - I.

#### II AGE RESTRICTION FOR ADMISSION

Minimum age for admission to Class I of the Primary School stage is generally 5+ or 6+ years. In 20 States/UTs, the minimum age for admission to Class I is 5+ years and in 10 States/UTs the minimum age for admission is 6+ years. There is no age restriction in case of Mizoram. In Gujarat state 5+years is voluntary and 6+years is compulsory. Details for all the States/UTs are given in Statement-II.

#### III MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

Mother tongue or the Regional language is the medium of instruction at the primary stage of education in most of the States/UTs. Facilities for studying in a medium other than regional language vary considerably. State-wise details may be seen in Statement-III.

#### IV <u>TEACHING</u> OF HINDI

Apart from Hindi speaking States, teaching of Hindi is compulsory in most of the non-Hindi speaking States/UTs, though the class from which the teaching of Hindi is compulsory differ from state to state. Teaching of Hindi is not compulsory in the states of Mizoram, Tamilnadu, Tripura and Karaikal region of Pondicherry. Classes in which teaching of Hindi is compulsory or optional for different States are indicated in Statement - IV.

#### V <u>TEACHING OF ENGLISH</u>

Teaching of English is compulsory in all the States/UTs, except Bihar. However, the classes in which teaching of English is compulsory differs from state to state. In general it is compulsory in Classes VI to X in most of the States/UTs. State-wise details may be seen in Statement V.

#### VI PUBLIC EXAMINATIONS

In all the States/UTs Public Examinations are conducted at the end of X and XII Classes by State Boards of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education. The minimum age for Secondary School Examination varies from 14+ to 16+ years in Andhra Pradesh Assam, Bihar, Jammu & Kashmir, Kerala, Maharashtra, Manipur, Orissa, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, A &N Islands, Delhi, Lakshadweep and Pondicherry. Other States/UTs either do not have age restrictionss or the age restriction has not been indicated by such States. The minimum age for Hr. Sec. School Examination varies from 16+to 18+ years in Bihar, J&K, Maharashtra, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, A&N Islands, Delhi, and Pondicherry. In other States/UTs either there is no age restriction prescribed or if it is there, it has not been indicated. In some of the States/UTs., the first Public Examination is also conducted at the middle stage of School Education. State-wise details are given in Statement - VI.

#### VII NUMBER OF WORKING DAYS

The number of working days of School Education are generally more than 200 days in all the States/UTs. Statewise details may be seen in Statement-VII.

#### VIII <u>ACADEMIC TERMS</u>:

Normally, the Academic Year begins from the month of April, or May or June and ends in the month of March or April or May of the following year. In most of the states, long vacation periods are in summer while in some of the hilly States these are in winter. State-wise position is given in Statement-VIII.

#### IX COMPULSORY EDUCATION

Compulsory education has been enforced in four States and Union territories at the primary stage of education while in six States/ UTs there is compulsory education covering the entire elementary stage of education. As many as 22 States/UTs have not introduced any compulsion upto the year 1996-97. The State/UT-wise details are given in Statement IX.

#### X FREE EDUCATION:

Majority of States and Union Territories have introduced free education in classes I to XII in their schools. The State-wise details are available in statement X.

# XI TUITION FEES CHARGED PER CHILD PER ANNUM IN GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS:

All those States/UTs where education is not free in classes IX and above, the annual fee varies considerably from the highest of Rs. 250/- for classes XI and Rs. 360/- for classes XII in case of Daman & Diu to the lowest of Rs.48/- in case of Assam. Details of Tuition Fee charged per annum have been provided in Statement XI.
