## INTRODUCTORY.

This report for the year 1936-37 is issued in a revised form approved by the Central Board of Revenue, the object being to give information in a clearer and more acceptable form than has hitherto been the case. It is divided into two parts. Part I contains a general review of the trade of the Presidency. Commodities have been dealt with on the basis of their importance and value in the trade of the Presidency. A general paragraph has been devoted to articles of lesser value in each class of trade.

Part II contains statistical tables to which have been added the reasons for variations and explanations. A comparison has been made only with the figures for the four previous years and in the table showing the percentage variations in the prices of certain principal articles, the year 1927-28 has been taken as the base year.
