Co-operators like Horace Plunkett sought to bring order into agricultural business by voluntary association. Now, in almost every country the State is stepping in to control, subsidize and regiment. In Great Britain the new policy has at least a democratic basis. Whether or not Marketing Boards are a new name for co-operation, can they be judged successful by economic standards? In this book, an attempt is made to survey the existing evidence.

Effects on Trade; VI. Effects on Saving; VII. Applicability and Working; VIII. Conclusion.

THE INTERNATIONAL BANKS.

A short study of the history and present position of the important and well-defined group of London banks operating mainly in foreign countries. The investigation is specially concerned with the past activities of these banks as a channel for British Capital exports, both on long and short term, and it considers the prospects for international banking in the future, in face of the growth of economic nationalism since the War. This book is intended to supplement *The Imperial Banks* by the same author, and to offer jointly with it a comprehensive general account of the work of the British Overseas Banks.
