NINETEENTH ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

SUPERINTENDING ENGINEER.

Public Health Department (Engineering Branch), Bihar and Orissa, for the year ended 31st March 1931-

Staff.—The post of the Superintending Engineer, Public Health Department, Bihar and Orissa, was held throughout the year by Mr. S. E. Platt and that of his Personal Assistant by Mr. A. P. Jaruhar till 26th September 1930 when Mr. S. B. Dutt, Assistant Engineer, took over charge and held the post till the close of the year.

In addition to his own duties the Superintending Engineer served as Chairman of the Patna-Bankipur Joint Waterworks Committee and Consulting Engineer to the Jharia Water Board.

- Mr. T. S. Soorma held charge of the post of Executive Engineer, 1st Division, Public Health Department, Patna, throughout the year except for the period from 14th October to 1st December 1930 when he was on leave and Mr. A. N. Banerjee, Assistant Engineer, held charge of the division.
- Mr. E. R. Smith held charge of the post of Executive Engineer, 2nd Division, Public Health Department, Ranchi, throughout the year.
- Mr. E. D. MacDonald held charge of the post of Executive Engineer, Mechanical Division, throughout the year.

The office of the Drainage Engineer was abolished with effect from 1st April 1930 and the staff was attached to the office of the Superintending Engineer, Public Health Department, to complete the Patna Main Drainage Scheme. This scheme was submitted to Government in April 1931, when the services of the special staff were dispensed with.

In addition to the above there were employed in the department eight assistant engineers, two engineer improvers, eight supervisors and 47 subordinates and the requisite number of draftsmen, estimators, tracers and clerical staff.

During the year the following places were visited by the Superintending Engineer:—

(1) Arrah, (2) Bhagalpur, (3) Cuttack, (4) Dinapur, (5) Deoghur, (6) Dhanbad, (7) Gaya, (8) Giridih,

(9) Hazaribagh, (10) Itki, (11) Jharia, (12) Kodarma, (13) Madhupur, (14) Muzaffarpur, (15) Netarhat,

(16) Puri, (17) Ranchi and (18) Sonepur.

The Executive Engineer, Mechanical Division, submitted periodical inspection reports of open waterworks and assisted in the preparation of specifications and advising on tenders for pumping plant.

Expenditure.—Work to the value of Rs. 6,85,735 was carried out during the year under review of which Rs. 3,07,791 was expenditure on deposit works on behalf of local authorities. In addition, the expenditure incurred by local authorities on the maintenance of waterworks and sanitary works amounted to Rs. 4,41,326 and Rs. 1,22,258 respectively.

The total value of the work carried out under the supervision of the Superintending Engineer, Public Health Department, was Rs. 12,49,319. Detailed schemes amounting to Rs. 24,92,264 and preliminary and outline schemes amounting to Rs. 13,38,950 were prepared and submitted either to Government or to local bodies. Work is in hand on the preparation of detailed and outline schemes amounting to Rs. 36,44,340 and projects estimated to cost about Rs. 14,55,110 have to be prepared as soon as staff is available.

The expenditure on the establishment of the department during the year was Rs. 3,08,996.

Fees earned for work done on behalf of local authorities amounted to Rs. 44,247.

CONSTRUCTION-ORIGINAL WORKS.

Patna-Bankipur water-supply.—The borehole pumps for the five tube wells at Digha and the University were tested in July 1930 and subsequently taken over from the contractors. They have continued to give good service but require considerable attention. A new borehole pumping set supplied by Messrs.

Sulzer Brothers has been erected at Amlatola and is very satisfactory. The work on the extension scheme amounting to Rs. 3,44,000 and the Amlatola scheme amounting to Rs. 1,00,000 has now been completed and the accounts will be closed shortly.

Bhagalpur water-supply.—Two electrically driven vertical spindle pumping sets have been installed in the old suction well and have maintained the supply during the past year. There has, however, been some trouble due to vibration and the contractors are arranging to provide additional girders to carry the pumps.

Patna Camp Jail water-supply and drainage.—To meet the emergency due to overcrowding of the ordinary jails, a large temporary jail was constructed by the Public Works Department near the Dairy Farm, Phulwari.

In the first instance water was supplied from the Veterinary College installation; subsequently a 5" diameter tube-well was constructed at the jail and two electrically-driven pumping sets installed. One pump is driven by an alternating current motor taking energy from the mains of the Patna Electric Supply Company and the other by a direct current motor to be supplied from the jail emergency generating plant. A service reservoir of 20,000 gallons capacity with the necessary distribution system has been provided.

To prevent any nuisance occurring from the accumulation of drainage from the flat site of the jail the necessary surface drains with collecting sump and pumping plant have been provided to discharge sullage on to the Agricultural Farm about 200 yards south of the jail enclosure. The water-supply was started on 1st September 1930 and the complete installation worked satisfactorily during the remainder of the year.

Expenditure was Rs. 58,420.

Patna Veterinary College.—The water-supply and drainage system were put into use from 1st June 1930 and worked satisfactorily to the end of the year. The total expenditure on the scheme is Rs. 1,25,914 and expenditure during the year Rs. 5,142.

Patna—Shifting water main in the bazar.—Consequent upon the widening of the main bazar road it was decided to remove the water mains from the side of the road to a position under the footpath of the new road. This has been completed in sections I, III and VI at a cost of Rs. 11,490.

Muzaffarpur water-supply reorganisation.—Duplicate sets of electrically driven pumps have been installed on the new tubo

wells at Chandwara and the Prince of Wales Garden. The plant on test was found satisfactory and has been handed over to the municipality.

The scheme for the reorganisation of the supply was sent to the municipality in 'November 1930 but arrangements to start the work have not yet been made owing to difficulty in providing funds.

Gaya water-supply.—An estimate amounting to Rs. 82,516 has been sanctioned and funds were placed at the disposal of this department towards the close of the year. Arrangements to start the work are in hand.

Cuttack Medical School and Hospital.—Work on the drainage scheme has proceeded slowly during the year. The sewage pumping plant has been erected and was started up in April 1931. The delay which has occurred was due to electric current for the sewage pumps not being available and to delays in the acquisition of additional land for the sewage filters. Experience with the filters of Ravenshaw College has shown that the smell from the filters on the original site causes cocasional slight nuisance at the College quarters near the canal and it was considered undesirable to discharge the Medical School sewage on to filters at the same place. Advantage has therefore been taken of the opportunity offered by the construction of the hospital filters to remove the College filters and construct all the filters on a site at a considerable distance from the College.

Cuttack Ravenshaw College water-supply.—A 5 inch diameter tube-well has been constructed and tested with satisfactory results. Arrangements for the installation of the necessary pumping plant are in hand. Meters have been fixed on all service connections at a cost of Rs. 2,810 and have effected a surprising economy in the demand for water.

Drainge.—The service latrines attached to the main hostels have been converted to water-flushed latrines.

Daltonganj water-supply.—A scheme estimated to cost Rs. 1,05,500 for the improvement of the supply has been sanctioned and a grant of Rs. 60,000 made by Government to the municipality.

The work will be started on receipt of funds from the municipality. The intake and pumping plant, etc., have been taken over by the municipality from the East Indian Railway

and an agreement made under which the municipality has undertaken to supply water to the railway station.

Ithi Sanatorium water-supply.—The yield from the well was found inadequate and an estimate amounting to Rs. 4,995 for an additional well has been prepared and sanctioned. The work is now in hand.

Netarhal water-supply.—An estimate amounting to Rs. 4,488 for improvement of the supply, including provision of steam-driven pumping plant and an intake on the lower lake, has been sanctioned and work is in hand.

Kanke (Mental Hospitals) water-supply and drainage.—An estimate amounting to Rs. 19,600 for extension of the infiltration gallery having been sanctioned arrangements were made to start work in February; due to heavy rain at that time there was a considerable surface flow in the river and work could not be started until early in April.

The installation of bulk meters and house connection meters sanctioned at a cost of Rs. 26,000 has been completed and also the water-supply fittings and drainage of additional buildings at a cost of about Rs. 15,015.

Two estimates totalling Rs. 23,400 for improvement of the arrangements for disposal of the sewage discharging at outfalls nos. 2 and 3 have been sanctioned but work cannot be started owing to shortage of funds.

When completed the effluent from both outfalls will be conveyed across the Agricultural farm and subsequently discharged into the Jumar river.

Ranchi-Government House water-supply.—A well 15 feet diameter and 40 feet deep on the race course and a well 12 feet diameter and 50 feet deep in the Radium Institute compound were successfully completed before the rains of 1930. When tested the minimum combined yield was found to be about 15,000 gallons per day.

An estimate amounting to Rs. 34,000 for the two wells and for the necessary pumping plant and rising mains, etc., has been sanctioned for the supply of water to Government House and the neighbouring official residences.

Ranchi—Water-supply to residence of Hon'ble Member.— An estimate amounting to Rs. 4,178 has been sanctioned to cover the cost of a 2-inch diameter supply main and a small electrically-driven pump. The work has been completed.

Puri water-supply.—Based on the promising results of the exploratory work carried out during 1928 and 1929 a preliminary scheme amounting to Rs. 12,05,000 has been prepared and after approval by the recently-formed Joint Waterworks Committee, was sanctioned by Government in December 1930.

In compliance with the orders of Government, a detailed scheme amounting to Rs. 11,84,500 was submitted to the Puri Joint Waterworks Committee in January 1931 and work was started on the construction of six 9-inch diameter tube-wells with the object of completing and testing them before the rains of 1931.

To the end of March four tube-wells (nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4) had been completed and two accepted. The results obtained being no. 1 tube-well yield 220 gallons per minute with a depression of 11 feet, no. 3 tube-well yield 175 gallons per minute with a depression of 11 feet. Work on the construction of nos. 5 and 6 and the testing of nos. 2, 4, 5 and 6 is now in hand.

In addition to the main tube-wells, six 3-inch diameter indicator tube wells, four near the sea and two on the inland border of the land to be acquired for the headworks, have been completed, sixty-seven indicator tubes to ascertain the effects of pumping on the level of the subsoil water table and the six lines of piping to discharge the water pumped from the tube-wells near the sea have also been completed.

In order to maintain accurate records of the quantity of water pumped six venturi meters have been provided to measure the discharge from each tube well.

Expenditure during the year was Rs. 49,452.

New Capital Sewage Pumping Plant.—An estimate amounting to Rs. 25,083 has been sanctioned to cover the cost of providing electrically driven pumping plant for the following pumping stations maintained by the Patna Administration Committee:—

- (a) Gardanibagh.—Three sets of a total capacity of about 950 gallons per minute.
- (b) Government House.—Two sets each of a capacity of 30 gallons per minute.
- (c) "R" Block.—Two sets each of a capacity of 50 gallons per minute.

The plant for Gardanibagh has been delivered and erection is now in hand. A decision regarding the sizes of these sets proved to be a matter of considerable difficulty owing to the necessity for providing adequate power to deal with storm flows and the limitation imposed by the length of the 9 inch diameter cast iron rising main (8,335 feet long).

Small tube-wells.—The two sets of boring plant purchased last year have been employed during the year in the construction of the indicator tubes for Puri water-supply and the following 3-inch diameter tube-wells:—

- (a) Residence of Hon'ble Member, Finance Department, Patna;
- (b) Residence of Inspector-General of Prisons, Bihar and Orissa;
- (c) Ashram, Muzaffarpur.

Funds are now available for 17 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " and 3" diameter tube-wells and in order to complete them within a reasonable period arrangements are being made to construct 12 of them by contract.

In compliance with recent orders all tube-well and boring work, and the supply and maintenance of hand pumps done by the Public Works Department in the past, has been handed over to this department and some difficulty is being experienced in dealing with it in a satisfactory manner owing to want of staff.

PREPARATION OF PROJECTS.

Patna Drainage Scheme.—This scheme estimated to cost Rs. 15,53,765 has been completed and submitted to Government.

Arrah Drain Flushing Scheme.—Work on the preparation of a scheme for the improvement of the water-supply and of the drainage of the town is in hand but is making slow progress due to staff being employed on more urgent schemes for which funds are available.

Bhagalpur water-supply—Reorganisation Scheme.—A detailed scheme amounting to Rs. 7,79,059 was submitted to the municipality in September 1930 and subsequently approved but on further examination it was decided by Government that the Municipal Board would be unable to meet the recurring charges and a note was submitted in March 1931 for a modified scheme estimated to cost about Rs. 4.5 lakhs. The matter is still under consideration but in view of the state of the filtered water pumping plant a very early decision is desirable.

Patna water-supply extension.—A grant of Rs. 6,14,000 was given by Government to the Patna City Municipality in March 1930 to meet the major portion of the cost of extending the supply to the remainder of the area of Patna City Municipality. The preparation of the scheme is in hand and it is expected that it will be submitted to the Joint Waterworks Committee very shortly.

In addition to the scheme for the extension of the area of supply, a preliminary estimate amounting to Rs. 32,000 has been approved by the Joint Waterworks Committee for the provision of an additional tube-well and pumping plant within the area of the Patna Administration Committee. Rs. 16,000 has already been deposited to the credit of this department and it is hoped to start work shortly.

Puri—Improvement of Narendra Tank.—An estimate amounting to Rs. 14,524 was prepared to cover the cost of providing a drain to introduce fresh water from the Athara Nala into the tank at the south-east corner where nearly all bathing is done. The scheme has been abandoned as there is some doubt whether the advantage to be gained by the introduction of this water would not be more than counterbalanced by the difficulty produced by increased deposit of silt.

Jharia water-supply.—Due to the steadily increasing demand and to the considerable leakage which still occurs it has proved increasingly difficult to obtain a sufficient output of filtered water. The type of filter to be adopted in extending the filtration plant was under the consideration of the Board and the advice of the writer to provide additional filter area of the same general design as the existing slow sand filters has now been approved and an estimate for the work is being prepared by the Board's Engineer. The reduction of leakage from the supply line and service reservoir at Tilatand has also received attention. Tests on the reservoir have shown that there is a daily loss of between 150,000 and 200,000 gallons and alternative proposals to make the reservoir water-tight are under consideration.

Due to unsatisfactory maintenance, the two venturi meters on the supply mains from Tilatand Reservoir were found to be in a very bad condition and as the cost of repairing them was more than half the cost of purchasing new meters of an improved type, it was decided to obtain new meters and the order was placed with Messrs. Glenfield and Kennedy, Ltd.

Monghyr Jail water-supply.—Due to shortage of water the Inspector-General of Prisons asked for an estimate to cover the

cost of improving the supply. An outline scheme amounting to Rs. 12,600 was prepared and submitted.

Hinoo water-supply.—An estimate amounting to Rs. 5,613 for a submerged weir across the river has been prepared and submitted to Government.

Hinoo and Doranda Drainage.—An estimate amounting to Rs. 30,400 has been prepared for improving and completing the surface drainage of both Hinoo and Doranda.

MAINTENANCE OF OPEN WATERWORKS.

Arrah.—The unfiltered and filtered water pumps were maintained in fair order. The plant being old, needs special care to guard against breakdowns. The quality of the filtered water is unsatisfactory.

Bhagalpur.—The electrically driven pumping sets installed in the suction well developed trouble and are being realigned and assembled by the suppliers. The Diesel engine driven pump for the filtered water-supply has been overhauled and is now in working order. The essential repairs required to keep the steam-driven pumps in working order have been done but the condition of this plant is unsatisfactory and serious trouble may develop at any time. The mechanical filters and slow sand filters require complete overhauling.

Daltonganj.—The old steam-driven pumping sets were taken over from the East Indian Railway Administration and are now being maintained by the municipal authorities. Recent inspection indicated that the boilers have been subjected to undue stresses due to bad stoking. The Board has been advised to insist on this practice being stopped and in addition to purchase coal of good quality.

Gaya.—The plant is being run about twenty-two hours daily and is in need of a thorough overhaul as early as possible. The yield from the galleries and wells is not sufficient to meet the demand in the hot weather and the construction of two additional wells is included in the scheme recently sanctioned. One of the boilers has been partially dismantled in order that necessary repairs can be carried out. This should be done and the boiler bricked up ready for duty as soon as possible. A new boiler feed water pump is being installed to replace an old horizontal duplex Worthington pump. The size of the present work-shop is insufficient to accommodate the tools and staff and early steps should be taken to extend it. The workshop engine is in bad condition and requires a complete overhaul.

Monghyr.—The plant has been kept in fair order, but the additional filter on which work was started several years ago is still incomplete.

Muzoffarpur.—The steam pumping plant at Chandwara has been maintained in a satisfactory condition. For the greater part of the year the water-supply available from the old tube-wells has been augmented by a supply from the new tube-wells pumped by air lift. The compressor was lent by this department.

The electrically driven pumping sets installed on the new tube-wells at Chandwara and Prince of Wales Garden have been started and this has greatly increased the supply of water. The condition of the oil-driven pumping set at Kachisarai tube-well is very unsatisfactory; it requires immediate overhaul to ensure the continuity of the water-supply to the area supplied from this tube-well. To provide standby plant at this station the Board has been advised to install an electrically driven pumping set.

Patna-Bankipur waterworks.—The pumping plant has been maintained in a satisfactory condition and during the latter part of the year the new set at Amlatola pumping station was started up and has proved very satisfactory.

Sonepur water-supply.—The water-supply during the fair was, as usual, augmented by installing temporary portable pumping sets on surface wells. Temporary extensions of the supply to the area occupied by the police and military camps were carried out. The usual limited supply has been maintained throughout the year.

From a comparison of appendix I with the corresponding appendix in the reports for 1928-29 and 1929-30, it will be seen that the improvement in receipts and reduction in expenditure hoped for as a result of the appointment of a Mechanical Engineer have not yet materialised.

From appendix IV it will be seen that the standard of purity of the supplies from tube-wells at Patna, both the public supply and the supply to the hospital, has been very satisfactory and the filter effluent at both Jharia and Kanke is, after chlorination, also of a high standard. The results obtained at Gaya are surprisingly good.

The standard of purity of the water supplied at Arrah, Bhagalpur and Daltonganj is not satisfactory.


The results of the examination of the water supplied at Muzaffarpur are affected by the contamination of the tubewell at Kachisarai. In spite of a thorough search and examination the source of this contamination has not been ascertained and the Board has been advised to install plant to add a small dose of chlorine to the water.

General.—The writer desires to thank the staff of the department for the work done during the year. With one or two exceptions the work done has been satisfactory.







# GOVERNMENT OF BIHAR AND ORISSA. (MINISTRY OF LOCAL SELF-GOVERNMENT.)

#### RESOLUTION.

#### Dated the 18th September 1931.

#### READ-

The annual report of the Public Health Engineering Department for 1930-31.

- 2. The expenditure on Government works decreased (in thousands of rupees) from 6,70 to 3,78. Expenditure on deposit works carried out on behalf of local bodies increased from 1,75 to 3,08. The total expenditure on works decreased from 8,45 to 6,86 and on works carried out under the supervision of the Department from 13,36 to 12,49.
- 3. The estimated cost of projects for which detailed schemes were prepared increased from 9,95 to 24,92 and the estimated cost of projects for which preliminary and outline schemes were prepared decreased from 19,81 to 13,39. There was an increase in the total estimated cost of schemes under preparation from 30,68 to 36,44 while the preparation of schemes estimated to cost 14,55 as compared with 31,91 in the previous year had to be kept pending for lack of staff. The establishment charges of the Department rose from 2,76 to 3,09 and the increase seems to be justified by the very large increase in the cost of schemes for which estimates were prepared. The fees earned by the Department for work done on behalf of local bodies amounted to 44 against 28 of the previous year.
- 4. The most important Government project carried out during the year was the water-supply project to the overflow jail at l'hulwari costing Rs. 55,420. Other works of importance, though of lesser magnitude, were (1) completion of the two large diameter wells for water-supply to the Government House at

Ranchi, (2) provision of meters at the Indian Mental Hospital buildings at Kanke and water-supply and drainage for the additional buildings recently constructed at the same institution.

5. Of the works taken up on behalf of local bodies the most noteworthy is the project for water-supply at Puri which is of first-rate importance, from the public health point of view. not only to this province but to other provinces as well. Puri is a place whereto pilgrims from all parts of India resort throughout the year and in particular seasons in very large numbers. It is a danger spot from which cholera spreads and a source of supply of uncontaminated water is expected to go a long way in preventing spread of cholera. A detailed scheme amounting to Rs. 11,84,500 was completed and work was started on the construction of six nine-inch diameter tube-wells with the object of completing and testing them before the rains of 1931. Up to the end of March 1931 four tube-wells had been completed and two accepted by the Department after test. scheme for the extension of the Patna-Bankipur watersupply to the eastern half of the Patna City municipality for which a grant of Rs. 6,14,000 was sanctioned by Government last year was under preparation. Another important scheme for which plans and estimates have been prepared and which is now under the consideration of Government is the drainage and sewerage scheme of the Patna City at an estimated cost of Rs. 15,53,765.

Electrically-driven pumping sets have been installed at Bhagalpur and Muzaffarpur in connection with the schemes for improvement of water-supply at those places. A grant of Rs. 60,000 was made by Government to the Daltonganj municipality during the year for the improvement of water-supply at the station.

The policy inaugurated by the Ministry last year for popularizing a cheap form of safe water-supply amongst smaller municipalities which cannot afford a pipe water system by making a grant of Rs. 2,000 to each for the construction of tube-wells with overhead tanks and taps was continued during the year under report and similar grants were made to 12 municipalities.

6. The Department continued to pay the same care and attention as in previous years to the inspection and supervision of municipal waterworks in the province. Sixteen Government pumping stations were maintained by the Department during the year.

7. Mr. Platt continued to hold charge of the Department throughout the year and the thanks of Government are due to him for the energetic and efficient way in which he carried out his duties. Government are also pleased to record their appreciation of the general satisfactory work of the Department during the year.
