## KOLHAPUR PRINCIPALITY.

### NOTES FOR THE REVISION OF VOLUME XXIV.

**Area.**—The area has been increased from 2,493 square miles to 3,165 square miles to accord with the measurements of the revised Survey in progress since 1895. The variations in the case of each State are given below :—

**Land Revenue and Agriculture.**—The Survey Settlement was first introduced into Kolhāpur territory about the year 1867. The revised settlement was commenced in 1895 and has now reached completion with the exception of a few *Pethas* in Kolhāpur proper and some feudatory estates. By the new rates, introduced up to the year 1903, the total assessment has been enhanced by Rs. 4,28,093 or 21·6 per cent. as under :—

**Trade and Manufacture.**— The principal exports from Kolhapur are cotton, tobacco, hemp, gram, jagri, raw hides, earthen-pots, rough blankets, &c. valued at nearly Rs. 10 lakhs. The chief imports are salt, cocoanut, cloth, jowari, iron and glassware, oils, &c., valued at about Rs. 3 lakhs. There are 16 trade centres or market towns in the whole territory. The principal manufactures are cotton weaving, oil pressing, blankets weaving, pottery, and the preparation of sugar and jagri. The details in approximate value of these articles are given below :—

## SOUTHERN MARATHA JAGHIRS.

### NOTES FOR THE REVISION OF VOLUME XXIV.

**Area.**—The Southern Marātha Jāghirs include 8 States under the Political Agent, Kolbāpur and Southern Marātha Country. In 1891-92 Jath and Daflāpur were placed under this Agency. But since 1901-02, they have been transferred to the Bijāpur Agency. The area, 2,919 square miles, of the whole territory has now been corrected to 3,021 square miles to accord with the results of the Survey measurements, which are as follows :—

**Survey.**—The original Survey settlement in the Sāngli State was commenced in 1864 and completed in 1893. The settlement first guaranteed for 15 years has been extended from time to time and no Revision Survey falls due until 1910-11. Of the 40 Inām and sub-Saranjam villages, 11 have not yet been brought under the Survey settlement for want of the consent of the holders of the villages. By the Survey settlement the total assessment on land was raised by Rs. 40,326 from Rs. 5,91,943 to 6,32,269.

**Miraj.**—In 1884-85 Survey operations were carried on in Miraj Junior, but the Survey rates were introduced in only one tāluka (Gudgeri) out of the three that form the State. In the remaining two tālukas, Kuroli and Kavathe, new Survey rates were introduced in 1895-96 and 1891-92 respectively. The revised rates of assessment were introduced in the Gudgeri Tāluka in 1900-01. By the Survey settlement the total assessment was raised by Rs. 12,128 from Rs. 1,35,591 to Rs. 1,47,719.

**Mudhol.**—The Survey settlement was introduced in the State with exception of 12 Inām villages in 1868-69. Revised Survey operations

were completed and the revised rates introduced in 1894-95 throughout the State of Mudhol, including the Inām villages. The average rate of assessment on occupied land of all kinds was Re. 0-11-6 per acre by the original Survey and Re. 0-15-2 by the revised settlement. The revenue of the revised settlement has increased by Rs. 71,213, the total assessment now being Rs. 99,854.

**Kurundwād (Junior).**—The Survey settlement in the Kurundwād State was introduced in 1886 and completed in 1898. The Dumalz villages are still assessed according to the old rates, the Akarbunds being prepared by the Survey Department. This settlement enhanced the total assessment by Rs. 10,235 from Rs. 1,01,325 to Rs. 1,11,560.

**Miraj (Senior).**—The Survey settlement introduced in 1867-68 in the Miraj Senior State is still in force. Some villages belonging to the sub-Saranjāmdārs were surveyed and classified but have not yet been assessed. Rople Khurd and Ghante are still unsurveyed. About 340 acres of land are lying waste.

**Jamkhandi.**—All the villages in the Jamkhandi State, with the exception of an Inām village in Vidri Tāluka, have been surveyed. Of the three tālukas, the term of settlement of Kandgol, the first to be surveyed, expired in 1891-92, but has been extended for 20 years till 1911-12 without change in the assessment rates. In the other tālukas and outlying thanas survey rates were introduced in 1894-95. By the Survey settlement the total assessment was raised by Rs. 42,880 from Rs. 3,52,992 to Rs. 3,95,872.

**Kurundwād (Senior).**—A Survey settlement was introduced in 1896-97 into the Kurundwād and Angol Tālukas of the Kurundwād Senior State. Nearly 5,000 acres of land are lying waste.

**Ramdurg.**—The period of settlement guaranteed for 12 years in the Rāmdurg State expired in 1902; it is however intended to continue the settlement.

**Trade and Manufacture.**—Cotton, jagri, turmeric, tobacco are the chief articles of export. In Jamkhāndi dyeing and weaving are carried on. Check cloth and sārīs as well as rough blankets and khādi cloth are made and are exported for sale. Sāngli is known for the manufacture of cotton and silk sārīs and the dyeing of yarn. Copper and brass wares are also manufactured. In 1902-03 a gold mining lease was issued for a mine situated in Jelligery, a village in Shirhātti Tāluka. The area leased was 1,826 acres and the permanent rent to be paid is Rs. 480 per annum in addition to a royalty of Rs. 7½ per cent. on net profits derived from the gold extracted. A prospecting license for manganese ore was also issued for the villages of Kelur in the same tāluka. There are two factories in the Miraj Senior State. A leather tanning factory has been working in the Kurundwād Junior State since 1875.
