# Central Provinces Administration

## LOCAL AND MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT

*Nagpur, the 23rd January 1920.*

### READ—

Annual Reports of the Municipal Committees of the Central Provinces and Berar for the year 1918-19.

Divisional Reviews on the above.

### READ ALSO—

This Administration's Resolution, Local and Municipal Department, No. 54—VIII, dated the 28th January 1919.

### R E S O L U T I O N:

The Divisional Reviews were due on the 15th September 1919, but none of them were received punctually, the one for Berar being nearly two and half months late.

2. There were two more municipalities than in the previous year, two Number of municipalities, notified areas (Drug and Katol) having been raised to their constitution and meetings. the status of a municipality. The Hinganghat Municipal Committee was reconstituted by the addition of one nominated and two elected members, and the constitution of the Warora Municipal Committee was revised so as to extend the franchise and obtain a more equal representation of the various classes and interests affected. All the Committees except Gadarwara, Pachmarhi and Murwara held the prescribed number of meetings. Attendance at meetings was generally satisfactory except at Hinganghat, Burhanpur and Dhamtari, where it was only 38, 39 and 45 per cent respectively. The fall in the percentage at Dhamtari from 99 in the previous year to 45 in the year under report is attributed to the apathetic attitude of most of the elected members, of whom six resigned in order to bring to notice certain alleged grievances against the Tahsildar who was President of the Committee. An enquiry made by the Deputy Commissioner showed that the charges were unfounded. The attendance of official members was poor in Nagpur, Bhandara, Jubbulpore, Hoshangabad and Chhindwara; while Hinganghat, Burhanpur, Dhamtari, Amraoti town and Akola show the worst results in regard to the attendance of non-officials. There is still a tendency to hold unnecessary meetings in some municipalities, particularly in Wardha and Akola.

3. General triennial elections were held in nearly all the municipalities in the Central Provinces, and there was keen competition almost everywhere. In some municipalities in the Nerbudda Division personation is reported to have been freely alleged, and in some cases proved. The Commissioner, Nagpur Division, remarks that the

proportion of electors actually recording votes does not seem to be high or to argue any general interest, while the Commissioner, Jubbulpore Division, expresses a fear that in certain cases the motives of the candidates seeking election were not entirely centred in the welfare of the town. In Berar under the new election rules general elections were held in all municipalities except Ellichpur City and Camp and Amraoti Camp, which have not been granted the privilege of election. The right of electing members was conferred on the municipalities of Katol and Khapa, and those of Tumsar and Saugor were authorised to elect their President and Vice-President. The number of elected non-official Presidents was 25 against 15 in the previous year.

4. The total Municipal income excluding extraordinary and debt heads Income. rose from Rs. 39,77,866 to Rs. 44,54,566; but excluding Government contributions, which amounted to Rs. 6,51,631,

the real Municipal income was Rs. 38,02,935 against Rs. 31,09,534 in the previous year. The increase was under all heads of revenue. The net receipts from octroi rose from Rs. 9,01,286 to Rs. 10,02,641 and refunds amounted to Rs. 3,97,622 against Rs. 4,04,570 in the previous year. The increase in the income from octroi is due partly to the partial relaxation of the restrictions on Railway traffic and partly to the abnormal rise in the prices of cloth and other articles on which the tax is levied at *ad valorem* rates.

5. The income from taxes other than octroi was Rs. 13,44,796 as compared with Rs. 11,73,899 in the previous year, the principal increase being under water-rate (Rs. 65,105), conservancy cess (Rs. 23,304) and terminal tax (Rs. 67,295). The increase under water-rate is attributed partly to large collections of arrears at Nagpur and Jubbulpore, partly to the large quantity of water consumed at the latter place by the various military institutions, and partly to the collection of the tax at Arvi for the first time during the year. The increase under conservancy is due, as in the case of water-rate, to the large collection of arrears. The bulk of the increase under the terminal tax occurred at Amraoti, where the income from the tax rose from Rs. 70,400 to Rs. 1,04,135. The tax was introduced in the Damoh Municipality during the year, and the proposal of the Mandla Municipality to adopt it has recently been sanctioned. The imposition of the tax in Saugor and Khandwa was postponed in view of the restrictions on railway traffic and unfavourable local conditions. The income from the tax on professions and trades fell from Rs. 72,366 to Rs. 57,522 and that from the tax on the registration of cattle was Rs. 35,420 against Rs. 40,659 in the previous year. A tax on vehicles and animals was introduced in Yeotmal during the year. The taxes collected at Khamgaon represented only 54·2 of the total demand, while the results at Yeotmal, Akot and Ellichpur Town Municipalities were unsatisfactory. The Khamgaon Committee has been given formal warning that it will be superseded if substantial improvement is not effected by the 31st March 1920.

6. Realizations under special acts were Rs. 1,54,394 against Rs. 1,38,907 in the previous year. At the close of the year the Income from nazul and Municipal Committee, Nagpur, took over the management of hackney carriages from the District Superintendent of Police.

In Jubbulpore the cattle-pound income rose by Rs. 2,354, owing to the large number of cattle impounded by the special gang employed throughout the year. In Berar there was a fall of Rs. 4,649 in the surplus cotton market receipts, which was, however, made up to a considerable extent by the increased income from pounds. The decrease in the surplus from the cotton market is attributed to a comparatively poor cotton crop. The revenue derived from Municipal property and powers apart from taxation rose from Rs. 5,99,702 to Rs. 6,26,390. The increase is shared by all Municipal Committees except those in the Nerbudda Division, and is attributed to various causes, including the increase of income in Nagpur from nazul ground rent, the sale of plots on the Walker and Craddock roads and the realization of arrears of the sale-proceeds of grass in the Ambajheri and Gorewara catchment areas.

**7. Government contributions** amounted to Rs. 6,51,631 against Rs. 8,68,332 in the previous year. A sum of Rs. 3,33,510 represents a grant for sanitary purposes. Indirect expenditure on Sanitation amounted to Rs. 7,872, which included expenditure on the training at Bombay of candidates for the posts of Secretary and Sanitary Inspector. The Nagpur Municipal Committee received Government contributions amounting to Rs. 2,37,340 for the surface drainage scheme, the improvement of the Sitabaldi main road, city drainage, school buildings, the settlement of Indora basti, on account of the acquisition of a site for the University, and repairs to the Ambajheri dam. Grants aggregating Rs. 95,000 were given to Chanda, Warora, Wardha, Arvi, Jubbulpore, Murwara, Seoni, Burhanpur, Harda, Dhamtari, Bilaspur, Drug, Akola and Buldana for sanitary improvements, such as the removal of congestion, the draining of insanitary nullahs, and the filling up of moats. Rs. 10,000 was paid to Jubbulpore for plague expenditure and a special contribution of Rs. 1,000 was made to the Chhindwara Municipal Committee towards the cheap grain shop. The Pachmarhi Municipal Committee received an additional grant of Rs. 1,087 for the play-ground near the public garden. A grant of Rs. 15,822 was paid to the Amraoti Camp Municipality to meet the cost of pumping a supply of water to the camp as the Wadali tank failed. The Akola Municipality received Rs. 22,312 to cover the excess over the estimated expenditure on the Kapsi tank and Rs. 3,000 towards the construction of a submerged bridge over the Morna river. Buldana was given a grant of Rs. 9,000 for the construction of drains for carrying off storm water. Several Municipalities received pecuniary assistance from Government to meet expenditure incurred in connection with the influenza epidemic. Educational grants, recurring and non-recurring, fell from Rs. 2,69,714 to Rs. 1,84,691, the special grants for expenditure on primary school buildings amounting to Rs. 13,770.

**8. The amount advanced during the year was Rs. 62,500 against Loans.** Rs. 1,74,400 in the previous year. The whole of the loan was paid to the Nagpur Municipal Committee for repairing the dam of the Ambajheri tank. The Bhandara Municipal Committee paid the last instalment of the water-works loan amounting to Rs. 1,852. Eighteen municipalities are now indebted to Government on account of loans for various purposes. The loans outstanding at the close of the year amounted to Rs. 28,01,515, of which Nagpur was responsible for Rs. 15,30,407 and Jubbulpore for Rs. 2,81,009. The finances of the Nagpur Municipality improved with the non-appearance of plague; and to improve them still further the Municipal Committee has recently proposed to raise the rates of octroi and the vehicle tax. The financial condition of Harda continues to be unsatisfactory and the Municipal Committee proposes to raise the rates of the terminal tax on certain commodities. The finances of all other towns which have taken loans from Government are satisfactory.

**9. The total opening balance was Rs. 13,58,346.** Receipts amounted to General financial results. Rs. 52,44,746 and expenditure to Rs. 49,88,727, leaving a closing balance of Rs. 16,14,365 or Rs. 2,76,415 more than in the previous year. The closing balances of all municipalities, except Puigaon, were well over the prescribed minimum. In most cases the large balances are due to the unspent balances of Government grants or sums earmarked for special objects. The Wardha Municipality was obliged to dispose of all its Post Office cash certificates in order to meet unforeseen expenditure. The Commissioner, Jubbulpore Division, draws a very gloomy picture of the general finances of the Municipal Committees in his Division; they are unable to carry out important improvements or to provide the necessary recurring expenditure on ordinary recognised objects. This, he considers, is a serious matter which must materially affect the final verdict as to whether the policy of Government in developing the spirit of self-government in Municipal areas has up to the present attained reasonable success. The Commissioner deprecates the present system of giving grants from Provincial revenues to Municipal Committees as it fails to engender in the members any sense of responsibility to the electorate. The Commissioner, Nagpur, also writes in the same strain about the finances of the Municipal Committees in his Division; and he suggests the revision of the schemes of octroi or terminal tax with a view to improving Municipal finances.

10. The capital outlay on water-supply fell from Rs. 2,79,445 to Water-supply. Rs. 1,61,805. The repairs and strengthening of the embankment of the Ambajheri tank at Nagpur are estimated to cost Rs. 2,20,827 of which the Municipal share is Rs. 62,500, the balance being met by Government. The Panchdhara gravitation scheme for Wardha has been abandoned on account of its prohibitive cost, and it has been decided to examine in detail the scheme drawn up by the late Major Oldham for improving the existing pump-supply; and until this is done, to hold in abeyance the proposed extension of the existing pipe line to the Malguzaripura quarter of the town. In Hinganghat the supply of water is inadequate, and the immediate necessity for the filtration of the supply at Bhandara is keenly felt. The Robertson water-works at Damoh were completed during the year. The Moghat tank at Khandwa requires improvement and a grant of Rs. 51,860 has been sanctioned for it. The improvement of the Raipur water-works is also under contemplation. The supply of water to the town of Akola from the Kapsi tank, which was completed in 1917-18, had to be cut off as the water was declared to be unfit for human consumption, the tank not having filled on account of the short rainfall and the water being therefore contaminated by vegetable and other refuse. The Kalapani and Wadali tanks at Amraoti went dry, and the town and camp were supplied with drinking water by means of pumping from wells. The Masod gravitation scheme has been abandoned, and a project for obtaining an adequate water-supply for both the town and camp by means of pumping from the Pedhi river is under investigation.

11. The capital outlay on drainage fell from Rs. 2,80,680 to Rs. 1,36,696 Drainage. of which Rs. 96,624 was spent in the Nagpur Municipality. An estimate for providing water-flushed latrines in connection with the Nagpur sewage scheme is under preparation. It has now been decided that, as in the case of Wardha, the Nagpur drainage system should be maintained by Messrs. Lane-Brown and Hewlett for a period of five years, Government defraying the supervision charges and the Municipal Committee bearing the cost of the subordinate staff. In Jubbulpore a sum of Rs. 16,650 was spent on the improvement of drains; it has been decided to proceed with the extension of surface drains instead of undertaking the expensive underground scheme. New drains were constructed and existing drains repaired in Khandwa, Burhanpur and Narsinghpur. A scheme for drainage improvement in the northern portion of Burhanpur is being prepared and the Khandwa drainage scheme is under revision. The Bilaspur drainage scheme, which is estimated to cost Rs. 5,24,042 and for which a Government grant of Rs. 50,000 is asked, is being recast with a view to making it simpler and cheaper.

12. The expenditure on conservancy and sanitation rose from Rs. 6,71,196 Sanitary and Medical. to Rs. 7,93,695. The increase was mainly due to the payment of war and scarcity allowance to the conservancy staff and to the rise in the prices of conservancy requisites. In Murwara a whole-time Sanitary Inspector has been appointed, and it is hoped that this will lead to an improvement in the sanitation of the town. The Amraoti Town Municipality spent the whole of the Government grant of Rs. 15,000 and Rs. 4,500 more in the acquisition of houses for the widening of streets. The expenditure on hospitals and dispensaries rose from Rs. 1,14,344 to Rs. 1,38,208, and plague charges fell from Rs. 60,058 to Rs. 50,991. A grant of Rs. 10,000 was paid to the Jubbulpore Municipal Committee for expenditure in connection with plague. Influenza broke out in all Municipalities and caused a heavy mortality. The Municipalities did their best to help the people by distributing medicines, and everywhere volunteers in the work of relief were forthcoming in large numbers. Cholera outbreaks occurred during the year in Murwara, Seoni and Mandla. All the Municipalities in Berar have revised their rules for the registration of births and deaths, but inspecting officers continue to comment adversely on the manner in which the rules are administered.

13. The expenditure on education was Rs. 6,14,502 as compared with Education. Rs. 5,35,005 in the previous year. The increase is partly due to the payment of war and scarcity allowance to teachers. New school buildings were constructed at Nagpur, Chanda, Jubbulpore, Raipur, Dhamtari, Bilaspur and Drug, and the High School building

at Hinganghat was extended. It is interesting to note that in some of the schools in the Wardha Municipalities caste prejudice in the matter of "untouchable" castes is now said to be disregarded. The Chanda Municipal Committee propose to construct a new school building for depressed classes. A school for the children of the backward classes was opened in Burhanpur during the year, but the daily average attendance was poor.

14. The number of small towns administered as notified areas fell from 12 to 10, Drug and Katol having been raised to the status of Notified Areas. of a municipality during the year. The total income of notified areas amounted to Rs. 1,84,705, and expenditure to Rs. 1,38,610, against Rs. 2,24,133 and Rs. 1,56,859. The income of the Gondia Notified Area fell by Rs. 3,281 owing to the outbreak of influenza during the working season of the grain market, and the expenditure rose by Rs. 9,916 in consequence of the construction of school buildings and the payment of war and scarcity allowances to the staff. The income of the Etawah Notified Area from *haisiyat* tax rose by Rs. 500 as a result of the extension of the notified area round the railway settlement. The income of all the notified areas in the Nerbudda Division increased during the year. The large surplus balance at the credit of the Itarsi Notified Area Committee is earmarked for a drainage scheme which was held in abeyance owing to the war and has since the close of the year been taken up for consideration. The Anglo-Vernacular school building at Sohagpur was completed during the year; a bund was also constructed by the Committee to prevent the town being inundated by the overflow of a nullah running through the town.

15. The relations between the Municipalities and the officers of Government continued to be good except at Dhamtari, where there Notice of services. was a marked lack of cordiality in the relations between certain members of the Municipal Committee and their President. The electorate manifested its disapproval of their conduct by refusing to re-elect three of these gentlemen. The reports bring to notice the names of a number of gentlemen who have rendered good service on Municipal Committees, and the Chief Commissioner's thanks will be conveyed to them separately.
