I.—THE AGRICULTURAL CONDITIONS OF THE YEAR.

2. Character of the seasons.—The monsoon, upon which depended the statement A. character of the crops in the season under report, was one of the most peculiar in recent years. The rains commenced a month behind time; and up to the end of June practically no rain had fallen throughout the Provinces. This delayed considerably the sowings for the kharif crop. During July and August rain fell without remission, but in the latter month the showers were light though continuous. In September there was an extraordinarily heavy downpour which in Chanda and Narsinghpur caused destructive floods. During this month no less than 61 inches were registered in Narsinghpur as compared with
