

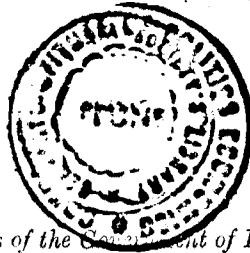

AHMEDNAGAR

Area.—Four villages with an area of 27 square miles were transferred to the Poona Collectorate in 1887 and one village with an area of five square miles was added to this district from Poona. To meet these changes, and to accord with the measurement of the Revision Survey carried out in 1875–1900, the area of the district has been reduced from 6,666 (1882-83), to 6,613 square miles.

The area of the district was 6,628 square miles in 1921-22. The increase being due to error in survey and introduction of survey settlement in unsurveyed alienated villages. The figures in census report are not correct.

Administrative changes.—In 1914 Pathardi Mahal was created for the sake of administrative convenience.

The Mahal was formed of some villages from Sheogaon and Jamkhed Talukas, the latter being reduced to the position of a Mahal. Thus the district has been divided into 10 Talukas and 2 Mahals since 1914.
