## THE INDIAN LIBERAL CLUB.


Founded at Bombay on 30th March 1917.

1. The Clab shall be called the "Indian Liberal Name. Clab."
2. The sims and objects of the Clab shall be:-

Aims and
Objects.
(1) To promote a systematic study of politics in general and Indian politics in particular in all their aspocts.
(2) To organise free and well-informed discassions on current political topica as well as on abstract political questions.
(3) To provide facilities for collecting information on questions arising, or necessary to be raised, in the Imperial and Provincial Legislative Councils.
(4) To form and maintain a library for the promom tion of the above objects.
(5) To adopt anch other measures as may be deemed advisable for the furtherance of the above objects.

4. No porson shall be eligible as a member of the Clab Hiligblility for unless he has attained the age of 21 . Mermersalit of the Clib.
5. A person desiring to be a member of the Clab shall Admission of apply in writing to the secretaries on the Menners. printed form to be obtained from them and the application shall be accompanied by his nominstion duly seconded in that behalf, the proposer and seconder being members of the club. Such application shall be placed before the Managing Committee who shall dispose of the same. In the ovent of election the applicant shall be so informed by the secretaries.
6. There shall be held in the month of march, every Gcareal Meeting. Year, a General Meeting of the Club to transact the following business:-
(1) To receive and adopt the annual report and the andited statement of accounts,
(2) To elect the Managing Oommittee and the Auditor for the ensuing year.
7. The Managing Commiltee may, at any time, of their Spectal Gene. own motion and shall, on a written requisition ral Meeting. of not less than 15 members, call a Special General Meeting of the Olab to consider such questions as the Managing Committee may deem fit to place before the meeting or such as may have been mentioned in the requisition referred to above. Meetings called on such requisition, shall be convened within 15 days from the receipt of the said requisition.
8. Seven days clear notice of every General Meeting shall

9. At all General Meetings ten mombers shall form a quorum.

10. The affairs of the Club shall be conducted by a Manasing Com. Managing Committeo consisting of:mittee.

The President, Vice-Presidents (not more than six), Secretaries (not more than three), Tressurers (not more than two) and other Members (not more than fifteen).
11. A meeting of the Managing Committee shall be held at least once a month. A special meeting Memiline of the of the Managing Committee shall be called on a written requisition of not less than five Members of the Committe日, within a fortnight of the receipt of such requisition.
12. All vacancies in the Managing Oommittee occarring vacancles in during the year, shall be filled up by the the commilter, Oommittee.
13. At all Meetings of the Managing Committee 5 Onorimm members shall form a quoram. at Committeo Meetings.
14. No quorom shall be neceesary at any Meeting gornum at adjourned for want of quorum. adopraed Meetiags.
15. There shall be at least two meetings of the Club in a - Meetngs ot the month which shall be held on alternate SaturClab. days for disenssisons on appointed subjects.
16. The President shall preside at all Meetings of the Club or of the Managing Committee. Who will prec: In his absence, one of the Vice-Presidents and ings? in the absence of all Vice-Presidents, any of the Members present, shall be elected to take the chair,
17. All questions before General Meetings or meetings of the Managing Committee shall be decided
 tore Meetings. time being, haring a casting vote in case of equality of votes.
18. Distinguished gentlemen may be olected as HonoHooorary rary Members of the Olab by a Generel Meeting nemberi. of the Clab on a recommendation of the Managing Oommittee.
19. The Treasurer, or Treasarers shall collect all subscriptions and dues owing to the Clab, subject to suoh directions as the Managing Committee Treaboreft. may from time to time issue, and shall keep
regular accounts. It shall be the duty of the Treasarer or Treasurers to bring to the notice of the Managing Committee ell defanlts in the payments to be made to the Olab.
20. The Managing Committee shall cause the minutes minate-Book. of the proceedings of all meetings to be regularly recorded.
21. The Managing Committee shall cause accounts of Acconarts of the Clab to be kept. The funds of the Clab the cluband in. shall be disposed or invested se the Managing
pering of Fund.
22. A Member of the Clab intending to resign shall Reulgation give notice, in writing, of his intention to the ot hembers. Secretaries and shall also pay up all sums due by him to the Club and return any books etc, belonging to the Club in his possession.
23. If the subcription of a member be in arrears for Disgallitica. over six months, the Secretaries shall give him Hion of Members notice to pay, and if he fails to pay within a month after auch notice he shall be liable to have his name removed from the list of Members by a resolation to that effect by the Managing Committee.
24. A member of the Club, on a recommendation of the Explaston of Managing Committee, may be expelled, for members. gross misconduct, from the Club by a resolution passed to that effect at a General meeting of the Club by a majority of not less than fonr-fifths of the members present; provided that the momber has been given a full opportanity by the Managing Oommittee to explain his oonduct.
25. The Clab shall have the power of appointing Trusappolotment tees and deciding from time to time what proutrulles. perties of the Clab shall be vested in them.
