PREFACE

THE present edition of the Bombay Code contains Acts passed by the Bombay Legislative Council up to the end of 1922. It was edited and published by the Legislative Department of the Government of India. Since the Reforms the work of publishing the Acts of the Local Legislature has devolved upon the Local Government. Since 1923 the total number of Acts passed by the Bombay Legislative Council has been 132, which include several important Acts such as the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923, and the Bombay Municipal Boroughs Act, 1925. These Acts have also undergone amendments on more than one occasion. The need of publishing all the Acts passed since 1923 in one volume is therefore urgent.

This volume contains all the Acts passed by the Local Legislature from 1923 to the end of 1930. As this volume is intended to be a supplement to the volumes of Bombay Code which have been already published, in editing it the system adopted in the main Code has been adhered to. In order to facilitate ready reference to all the changes carried out in any Act, a table has been inserted at the commencement of each Act setting out the number and year of all amending Acts. Another important feature in this volume is that footnotes contain references to notifications and rules issued under the various provisions of the Acts published in this volume. It is hoped that the innovations introduced in this volume will be useful not only to the departments of Government which have to deal with the various Acts published in the volume, but also to the general public.

In preparing this volume for publication, I have to acknowledge with thanks the assistance I received from Rao Saheb R. V. Sule and other members of the Bombay Legislative Council Office.
