PREFACE

I have read them very carefully but as it is not uncommon, though similarity in spirit does exist there are many sections which are not quite similar and hence it will only be wise to request the learned Advocate friends to refer to them for comparative study at a proper time, as the provisions of this Act are not Pari Materia with those of the other acts.
